1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On April 3, 2018, Industry Operations Investigator's (IOI's) (b)(6) initiated a firearms compliance inspection of Good Life Guns, LLC Type 01 Dealer of Firearms license. Present for the inspection was Christine and James Muise. The period of inspection covered April 3, 2017 to April 2, 2018. Advance notice was not given for the inspection.

Business Profile:

The business is a retail firearms dealership selling both long guns and handguns, hunting accessories and fishing supplies. Licensee acquired (b)(4) firearms and disposed of approximately (b)(4) firearms in the last 12 months. Licensee conducts retail transactions of both new and used firearms (b)(4) of sales are long guns and (b)(4) of firearms sales are handguns. Additionally, licensee conducts gunsmithing services for firearms. The primary suppliers for the business are (b) (4).

No other businesses are conducted on the premise. Licensee does not conduct business at gun shows but does sell firearms utilizing Gunbroker.com

Licensee sells ammunition but does not sell black powder. Licensee does not deal in NFA firearms.

No other ATF licenses/permits are held or required. The type 01 license is appropriate for the proposed activity.

Zoning was verified during the licensee's February 2017 application inspection.

Licensee does utilize off-site storage.

Ownership and Control:

Good Life Guns operates as a Limited Liability Company. The business is listed in the Maine State Corporate Database as a Domestic LLC in Good Standing. No indications of hidden ownership were discovered. James Muise is the only member of the LLC. James Muise and Christine Muise are both listed as responsible persons for the license. No responsible persons were added or removed from the license.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

During the inspection, a complete inventory was conducted by IOI's (b)(6). There were a total of 65 firearms identified in physical inventory and open dispositions. firearms were located in repair inventory that were not logged into the A&D record book (**Violation 9, Worksheet 1 and ROV**).

Licensee did not submit any theft or loss reports during the inspection period or as a result of the inspection. The A&D record is in the proper format, all the required information is accurate and the entries are timely made. 40 firearms were traced through licensee's records from acquisition to disposition with no discrepancies. Christine Muise stated that all acquisition information is entered immediately and dispositions information is normally recorded by the end of the next day. No illegal firearms were identified.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

There were ATF Form 4473 on file for the previous 12 months. IOI (b)(6) reviewed licensee's ATF Forms 4473 back to April 3, 2017. There were a total of forms reviewed and were cited for a violations (**Violations 1-8, Exhibit 1, Worksheet 2 and ROV**).

Licensee does not conduct law enforcement sales. Transfers to other licensees appeared to have been conducted properly. Prior to the inspection, IOI (b)(6) obtained the FFL audit log for licensee. There were 120 transactions contained on the audit log. Licensee stated that it is his standard practice to review all ATF Forms 4473 at the time of transfer to ensure that all forms are accurate and complete.

6 – Multiple Sales

There were (b)(6) multiple sales reported during the inspection period on the Violent Crime Analysis Branch FFL Master Query and (b)(6) unreported multiple sale (**Violation 10, Worksheet 2 and ROV**).

7 – Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

There were no possible traffickers, prohibited persons or straw purchasers identified during the inspection. (b)(6) transferee completed the ATF Form 4473 and checked “yes” on question 12.b. NCIC/NLETS checks on this individual revealed no prohibiting information. Licensee was educated on the importance of a thorough Form 4473 review to prevent firearms transfers to potentially prohibited persons.

(b)(6) firearm was transferred prior to the elapse of the three day NICS response window. NCIC/NLETS checks on this individual did not reveal any prohibiting information.

IOI (b)(6) conducted Accurant checks in five instances to verify Maine residency.

Additionally, 17 NCIC/NLETS checks were conducted in connection with ATF F 4473 19.d violations (no follow up response from NCIS indicated). Of those, (b)(6) ATF F 4473 forms with 19.d violations were forwarded to the Boston V IA for further review after NCIC/NLETS checks revealed potentially prohibiting information.

8 – Trace Activity

There were no traces in the last 12 months for licensee and zero unsuccessful trances. Secondary market analysis was conducted on three firearms with no hits.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

Licensee does not conduct any activity as an importer or collector of firearms. Licensee does not deal in NFA firearms. Licensee does not conduct any manufacturing.

10 - Referrals

No referrals were generated as a result of this inspection.

11 - Other

Licensee is in compliance with the Youth Handgun Safety Act, including poster and notice regulations. Licensee is in compliance with secure gun storage/safety device regulations.

On March 27, 2018, computerized criminal history checks (NCIC/NLETS) were conducted on James and Christine Muise. These checks did not reveal any prohibiting information.

IOI (b)(6) also contacted Resident Agent in Charge (b)(6) to inquire if there were any pending investigations related to the licensee. On March 27, 2018, RAC (b)(6) replied there were no concerns with the licensee.

12 - Closing Actions

A closing conference was held at the licensee's premises on April 4, 2018. Present at the closing conference were James and Christine Muise. IOI (b)(6) reviewed the violations that were cited for the licensee. IOI (b)(6) also reviewed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations with both the Muises, who signed the acknowledgement (**Exhibit 2**), and a copy was provided for their records. IOI (b)(6) answered the licensee's questions and provided James Muise with his contact information for future questions.
