

1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On February 5, 2018, Industry Operations Investigators (IOIs) (6) initiated an unannounced firearms compliance inspection at the licensed premises of Schick Sales Inc., t/a All Pawn. The licensee holds a Type 02 – Pawnbroker in Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices Federal Firearm License (FFL). During the inspection, the IOI (b)(6) interviewed Mr. Dennis K. Cohen, Secretary and responsible person (RP) on the license. Mr. Cohen presented his Maryland Driver's Licenses for identification. The inspection period was February 5, 2017 to February 5, 2018. On February 28, 2018, IOI (b)(6) held a closing conference with Mr. Cohen. Also present during the , ATF Public Affairs Specialist, who requested inspection was (b)(6) to attend a firearms compliance inspection to experience how the process works. The licensee assigned his two managers (6) (6) manager and (b)(6)assistant manager, to assist during the inventory portion of the inspection.

Business Profile:

Schick Sales Inc., doing business as All Pawn owns and operates a storefront pawnshop, offering loans for pawned items such as tools, electronics, jewelry, lawn equipment, firearms and other items of value. Items lost in pawn are offered for sale in the shop. In addition, the licensee offers new and used pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns, suppressors, short barreled rifles (sbr's), short barreled shotguns (sbs's), ammunition and firearms accessories. The licensee also conducts occasional gunsmithing on-site.

The premises is a commercially zoned storefront in a small strip shopping center in a urban part of Charles County.

In the last 12 months, the licensee acquired (b)(4) firearms, and disposed of during the same period. A breakdown of handguns verses long guns is as follows:

- Handguns: approximately (b)(4) acquired and (b)(4) disposed.
- Long guns: approximately (b)(4) acquired and (b)(4) disposed.

Approximately (b)(4) of the firearms transferred by the licensee were new and approximately (b)(4) were used. (b)(4) of the licensee's sales activity is retail

sales. The licensee's primary suppliers are (b) (4) and private individuals.

Schick Sales Inc. has been an industry member under the current license since April 5, 2007. The licensee did not conduct business at guns shows during the inspection period, and does not intend to do so in the future. Schick Sales Inc. advertises the business through the company website at www.allpawnandguns.com; however, does not offer firearms for sale on-line. No unrelated business is conducted by the licensee or at the licensed premises. The business is in compliance with state and local law, including zoning.

Schick Sales Inc. does not hold any other ATF licenses or permits. The company holds the following State and local licenses:

- Maryland Regulated Dealer's License
- Maryland Sales & Use Certificate
- Maryland State Trader's License
- Secondhand Precious Metals Objects Dealers License
- Pawnbrokers License

The licensee occasionally utilizes (b)(6)
for offsite storage of firearms.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

At the time of inspection, the licensee's physical inventory consisted of 614 firearms, and the number of open dispositions in the acquisition and disposition (A&D) records was . There was a difference of firearms. A full inventory was conducted by IOIs (b)(6) . (b)(6) , ATF Public Affairs Specialist assisted IOIs in the effort. As a result of the full inventory audit, the following discrepancies were disclosed.

The licensee failed to record the disposition of a firearm in the Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record Book not later than the seventh day following the date of the transaction in instances. **Reference Violation 6 and Worksheet 1**.

The licensee recorded the disposition of the each of the firearms that had been previously sold or otherwise transferred during the inspection, and referenced available records, i.e. ATF Forms 4473 in this effort. No thefts or losses occurred during the inspection period. The licensee maintains bound paper records as its official record. The company also enters all of its store items, including firearms into its PawnMaster database and considers the electronic records as backup to the bound paper records. The A&D records were in the proper format. The entries were found to be accurate; however, not timely made as referenced in above violation. IOIs did not trace any firearms through the required records. No firearms with obliterated serial numbers and no illegal firearms were discovered. No indication of trafficking was found.

IOI (b)(6) reviewed the licensee's standard operating procedures relevant to A&D records and inventory with Mr. Cohen and his managers. According to Mr. Cohen, firearms generally entered into the A & D Records on the date received, not later that the next morning by one of his managers (b)(6). Firearms are tagged with an internal number assigned by the stores Master Pawn system, which is how all items in the store are tagged. Each tag has firearms identifying information; however, tags do not generally reference a book, page and line number. Because of that, employees generally have to enter the information into the computer to identify the date a particular firearm was received in order to find it in the A&D records. IOI (b)(6)

suggested that the licensee hand write the book, page and line number on each tag attached to the firearm for ease of locating it quickly, which would also eliminate the need to use the computer to locate a firearm in the A&D record. Because of the current system, the inventory verification took twice as long as expected. Mr. Cohen indicated that he will ensure that the staff begins handwriting the book, page and line number on each tag moving forward. IOI (b)(6) witnessed that the new step was added to all the firearms in inventory immediately after the suggestion was made. The licensee had not been conducting full inventories periodically, so IOI (b)(6) suggested that the licensee begin conducting full inventories at least once a year to minimize discrepancies and reconcile them immediately. Mr. Cohen indicated that after going through the compliance inspection, he realizes that periodic inventories will be necessary and he will implement an annual inventory moving forward. The licensed premises is equipped with an alarm system with motion sensors, locked cages and gun safes to secure firearms.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

The licensee maintains the ATF Forms 4473 in chronological order by disposition date. A separate file is maintained for denials. The licensee had approximately ATF Forms 4473 on file for the inspection period. IOIs (b)(6) examined 100% of the forms. During the review of the forms, the following was discovered:

- The licensee failed to ensure proper completion of forms as prescribed by the headings on the ATF F 4473 and the instructions on or pertaining to the form. This occurred in instances. **Reference Violation 1, Attachment 1 and Worksheet 2**.
- The licensee failed to ensure proper completion of ATF Forms 4473 prior to making an over-the-counter transfer of a firearm to a nonlicensee. This occurred in instances. **Reference Violation 2, Attachment 2 and Worksheet 2**.
- The licensee failed to verify identity of the transferee by examining a valid identification document presented, and noting on the Form 4473 the type of identification used. This occurred in instances. Reference Violation 3, Attachment 3 and Worksheet 2.
- The licensee failed to record on the ATF Form 4473 initial responses provided by the NICS system (or appropriate State agency), or responses after delayed response was initially provided. This occurred in instances. **Reference**Violation 4 and Worksheet 2.

• The licensee failed to sign and/or date the Form 4473 in box #35 and/or #37 at the time a firearm is sold or otherwise disposed of. This occurred in instances. **Reference Violation 5 and Worksheet 2**.

Forms indicating denials were reviewed by IOIs and found to be filed properly. The licensee frequently transfers firearms to other licensees and IOIs determined that such transfers were conducted properly. The licensee sold a small number of firearms to police officers for official use during the inspection period and such transfers were determined to be properly executed.

An FFL Audit Log Report for transactions involving (Maryland) non-regulated firearms and regulated firearms was requested for a 60-day time period. A total of 227 responses were provided. Of the 227 responses, 208 were proceed/not-disapproved and the remaining 19 were denied/disapproved responses. IOI (b)(6) compared the NICS Transaction Numbers (NTNs) on the audit log to the NTNs recorded on the corresponding ATF Forms 4473 and no discrepancies found.

IOIs reviewed the standard operating procedures relative to ATF Form 4473 completion and other dispositions with the licensee. Mr. Cohen indicated that his staff is trained to be able to execute the ATF Form 4473, including the background check with customers to complete over-the-counter transfers of firearms. The licensee indicated that staff members will review the completed form with customers during a transaction to ensure proper completion, then once again before filing the forms. IOIs reminded the licensee to pay closer attention to the forms to ensure errors found during the inspection are not repeated. IOI (b)(6) suggested that the licensee or one of his managers conduct a second review of the forms they are files. After seeing the number of mistakes identified during the inspection, Mr. Cohen made changes to procedures, such as indicated that he generally conducts a second review of the completed forms before he files them away.

6 - Multiple Sales

During the inspection period, IOIs (b)(6)

conducted multiple handgun sales involving handguns; however, according to ATF Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB), no multiple sales were reported by the licensee. Upon discovery, IOIs asked the licensee why no multiple sales were reported as required and both managers (b)(6) indicated that they were not aware of the requirement. Mr. Cohen stated that he was aware of the requirement and was very surprised and disappointed that his staff was not reporting multiple handgun sales. As a result of these finding, IOIs determined that the licensee failed to report the multiple sale of a handgun in instances, involving handguns. Reference Violation 7 and Worksheet 2

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

During the ATF Form 4473 examination, IOIs selected 40 individuals based on possible traffickers, straw purchasers and other suspicious purchasers such as repeat purchasers and forms showing background checks indicating no resolution during the inspection period. The individuals were queried through various databases including OpenFox, Accurint and Electronic Tracing System (eTrace) database and CCH hit resulted in these efforts. A review of the licensee's 19 denied/disapproved ATF Form 4473 during the review period was conducted. Firearms from denied forms were checked against forms indicating subject firearms were sold or otherwise transferred and no individuals were found to be suspected of a straw purchase.

8 - Trace Activity

In the last 12 months, the licensee was associated with traces of firearms. In each instance the firearm was successfully traced through the licensee's records. The licensee acquired and sold approximately (b)(4) used firearms in the last 12 months. IOIs (b)(6) chose 50 used firearms in the NCIC database through Open Fox, yielding negative results.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The licensee is not an importer, a collector or manufacturer. The licensee holds a current Special Occupational Tax stamp to deal in NFA firearms. The records contain all of the required information, are accurate and appear to be timely recorded. There was no evidence of acquisitions and transfers being unlawful. NFA forms were filed properly as required.

The inventory was reconciled against the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record (NFRTR). The NFRTR revealed 11 NFA firearms, including nine silencers and two short barreled rifles (sbrs); however, the physical inventory disclosed NFA firearms on-site. IOI (b)(6) compared 100% of the NFA firearms in physical inventory against the NFRTR and A&D Record, and the following discrepancy was disclosed:

The manager of (b) (4) (b)(6) provided IOI (b)(6) with proof that the matter is currently being resolved and stated that the NFA Branch is in the process of voiding the approved form 5, dated November 11, 2017 for the transfer of said silencer. Reference Exhibit 1.

To follow-up with resolving the matter IOI (b)(6) contacted the NFA Branch via email to inform them that he discovered the discrepancy during a firearms compliance inspection for Schick Sales Inc., and requested an update with regards to voiding the registration and transfer of the item in question, then offered any assistance if needed. **Reference Exhibit 2**.

10 - Referrals

12 - Closing Actions

On February 28, 2018, IOI (b)(6) conducted a closing conference with Mr. Cohen, Secretary. At that time, a regulatory review was conducted, which included a review the Acknowledgement of the Federal Firearms Regulations form that was signed by IOI (b)(6) and Mr. Cohen. Reference Exhibit 3. On that date, IOI (b)(6) issued a Report of Violations, which was also signed by IOI (b)(6) and Mr. Cohen. Also present during the closing conference was store manager, (b)(6)

All materials referenced during the review were provided to the licensee, along with a list of ATF phone numbers and instructions on how to access the 2014 Federal Firearms Regulations Reference Guide electronically. In addition, IOI (b)(6) provided the licensee a thumb drive with additional pertinent materials for industry members. The licensee has not yet attended an ATF held seminar in the past year; however, intends to attend the next seminar sometime in 2018.

13 - Violations

1. 27 CFR 478.21(a)

Nature of Violation:

Failure to ensure proper completion of forms as prescribed by the headings on the ATF F 4473 and the instructions on or pertaining to the form. This occurred in instances. Refer to the ROV attachment.

Licensee's Response:

The licensee stated that he intends to have a meeting to go over all the violations so that the shop can improve on these errors.

Corrective Action:

Ensure proper completion of forms as prescribed, specifically the ATF Forms 4473 for all future transactions.

Corrective Action:

Verify the identity of the transferee by examining a valid identification document or combination of valid identification documents presented, then accurately note on the Form 4473 the type of identification used, including a valid expiration date for all future transactions.

The licensee search through all of this records and was able to locate paperwork as verification that a transaction occurred, then recorded the disposition of all book entries referenced in the violation.
