1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

ATF Industry Operations Senior (IO) Investigator (b)(6) initiated a firearms compliance inspection on June 6, 2017, at the above rural commercial site, within the city limits of Susanville, within the County of Lassen. Mr. Jeffrey Mark Cagle, owner, was interviewed and assisted with the inspection at the above location. IOI (b)(6) assisted from June 7-8, 2017.

The licensee is a sole proprietorship with the DBA name of Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service. The period for the inspection covered was June 6, 2016 through June 5, 2017. No other participants, e.g., other Federal, State, or local agencies were present or assisted.

ATF Senior IO Investigator (SIOI) (b)(6) verified the identity of the licensee through his California Drivers' licenses; #(b)(6), expiring 02/28/2020. Advance notification provided with supervisory approval, since the licensee is the sole responsible person and assurances were necessary for this onsite full firearms compliance inspection. This assignment called for a full DE compliance inspection, and was the licensee's first.

The completion and submission of this report and assignment was delayed by the licensee; with the details listed accordingly:

- Copies of ATF Forms 4473 were pending for the issuance of the licensee's Report of Violations (ROV) Statement;
- 2. On June 20, 2017, Investigator (b)(6) forwarded an email message, reminding Mr. Cagle of this matter;
- 3. On June 21, 2017, Mr. Cagle's (b)(6) as told via an email sent by Mr. Cagle to SIOI(b)(6) on June 24, 2017;
- 4. Subsequent emails were exchanged after SIO (b) (6) provided a few weeks to the licensee to handle details under the circumstances; whereby some of the copies were obtained;
- 5. On September 19, 2017, Mr. Cagle was able to forward all of the information requested; thus prompting the issuance of his ROV Statement, via email, on September 22, 2017; and
- The issuance of an amended ROV Statement via email on October 30, 2017, and was returned and signed on November 25, 2017.

Business Profile:

Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service is a medium volume dealer of firearms at the owned commercial, rural address. Mr. Cagle sells firearms to the public; local law enforcement and correctional officers (two prisons in the area) and friends/acquaintances, with approximately (b)(4) of them known and (b)(4) via FFL transfers (b)(4) per year). The primary firearm suppliers for the licensee are (b)(4)

The licensee also sells ammunition and therefore Investigator (b)(6) ensured that he was aware of the age restrictions concerning the purchase of ammunition. He has sold black powder firearms in the past, but not any black powder. SIOI (b)(6) informed Mr. Cagle that he would need to obtain an ATF Explosives Permit should he decide to sell black powder in the future.

The licensee acquired approximately (b)(4) firearms and disposed approximately firearms. These figures were for a 12-month period (June 6, 2016 through June 5, 2017). The licensee advertises via the local newspaper, radio and Facebook. Mr. Cagle also has a website; www.honeylakefirearms.com but does not utilize any online brokers (gunbroker.com, gunsamerica.com, etc.). Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service's sales of firearms breaks down to the following:

- \checkmark (b)(4) retail; an (b)(4) holesale;

- ✓ (b)(4) oward gunsmithing services and (b)(4) nanufacturing activities;
- ✓ (b)(4) via internet sales (transfers) are conducted; and
- No offsite storage of firearms discovered.

- Mr. Cagle has not conducted any gunsmithing but does offer the service via (b)(6), who runs the local gunsmith class at the Lassen Community College.
- No manufacturing activities with firearms, ammunition, or any other related items conducted.
- ♦ Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service does not anticipate any such sales (80% receivers); as Mr. Cagle has not conducted any such sales in the past; or wishes to in the future.
- The licensee has not converted any 80% receivers into completed receivers in the past; nor anticipates such activities in the future.
- The licensee is aware of the difference between an 80% receiver and a 100% one, as confirmed by SIOI (b)(6) and by Mr. Jeffrey Cagle by signing the "Acknowledgment of Federal Firearms Regulations" on June 9, 2017.

A full interview (FFL Compliance–Gunsmith) consisting of all related 80% & 100% receivers and manufacturing is included with this report. No further action is required at this time. (See Exhibit 1).

Ownership and Control:

Mr. Jeffrey Mark Cagle, owner of Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service, is the sole responsible person for the above license; and correctly reflected in the Federal Licensing System (FLS) "License Registration Report", with no changes required and there have not been any unreported changes to ownership. The business is a sole proprietorship and no signs of hidden ownership. (See Exhibit 1).

Variance:

The licensee does not have any approved variances. Investigator (b)(6) discussed the request process, for any future submissions and no requests made at the time of inspection.



The 166 firearms compared against the licensee's manual A & D records; revealing open dispositions. The total results disclosed discrepancies; listed:

All of the records maintained in the proper format and with the above exceptions; all other entries made timely. Zero (0) firearms were traced during the inspection period of (June 2, 2016 through June 2, 2017) per the VCAB Query Report. No evidence or signs of trafficking firearms discovered, albeit SIOI (b)(6) did target five (5) firearms and two (2) individuals as possibly suspicious. An additional check conducted on the licensee, Mr. Jeffrey Mark Cagle. The results on all of these checks resulted in no "hits". No discovery of any obliterated serial numbers discovered. There was no evidence of any illegal firearms discovered during the period.

On September 28, 2017, (b)(6) , Contractor, Stolen Firearm Program, ATF National Tracing Center, emailed Investigator (b)(6) with an update on the associated theft; listing the (D)(5)-112-Public Law 55-123-State 5522 that recovered; confirming what Mr. Cagle stated during the interview of this inspection.

With respect to the licensee's standard operating procedures relevant to the A & D record and inventory; the licensee had issues with his maintenance of the manual A & D records. The licensee conducts physical inventories of their firearms on a monthly basis, however, does not maintain any written record of the physical inventories conducted. Because of the discrepancies and violations noted, Investigator (b)(6) recommended to Mr. Cagle to record all acquisitions and dispositions of firearms; on the same day instead of the regulated allowance of "close of business the next day (acquisition) or seven (7) days (disposition)". Mr. Cagle stated to SIOI (b)(6) that he would.

Finally, Investigator (b)(6) conducted 25 crosschecks from ATF Forms 4473 to the disposition record to verify the purchaser, date of transfer and the make/model and description of the firearm, with no discrepancies discovered. (See Exhibits 1, 3 – 5 and Worksheet 1 – Inventory, A & D Review).

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service completed (b)(4) ATF Forms 4473 accounting for approximately (b)(4) firearm dispositions during the inspection period (June 6, 2016 through June 5, 2017). IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) reviewed (b)(4) ATF Forms 4473, for 10 months, during the inspection period. Due to time constraints, the months of April and May of 2017 not reviewed. Therefore, (b)(4) ATF Forms 4473 on hand reviewed. Investigator (b)(6) received approval via an email from acting supervisor (b)(6); "as long as the entire period was sampled". With the first nine (9) months and the last month (12) being reviewed; the sample was covered.

approximately 12% of the licensee's ATF Forms 4473 (reviewed) for the inspection period (total forms for period were following to resolve all of the discrepancies for the previously listed violations:

Zero (0) "denied" ATF Forms 4473 occurred during the inspection period and confirmed by the CA DOJ DROS report. SIOI (b)(6) ensured the licensee understands to maintain such forms separately, and Mr. Cagle stated as such. Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service files ATF Forms 4473 alphabetically per month; for example, Forms 4473 contained monthly within a folder, and then alphabetized.

All transfers to other licensees conducted properly. The licensee obtained copies of other FFL dealers transactions) and is maintaining them. There were transfers to law enforcement officers on an official capacity; and likewise, the licensee was already aware to maintain the letters with the required information.

With respect to the licensee's standard operating procedures relevant to the ATF Forms 4473 – NICS (DROS) and other dispositions, Mr. Jeffrey Cagle had several issues, already highlighted and addressed. Because of these concerns, Investigator (b)(6) highly recommended the following internal control systems for Mr. Cagle to employ, regarding multiple checks for the review of all ATF Forms 4473:

- 1. Mr. Cagle to review the ATF Form 4473 upon the initial purchase; and
- 2. Mr. Cagle to review the ATF Form 4473 at the customer pick-up. [Prior to this ATF inspection, Mr. Cagle did not conduct multiple reviews of all forms.]

Concerning the multiple sales of handguns and/or certain rifles; Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service's handling of all such transactions; also has issues with the completion and submission of ATF Form 3310.4 (Multiple Sales of Handguns Report) and ATF Form 3310.12 (Report of Multiple Sale of Certain Rifles). The licensee failed to complete and submit ATF Forms 3310.4 and 15 ATF Forms 3310.12. Upon review of the ATF Forms 4473 for the inspection period; the licensee properly completed and submitted ATF Forms 3310.4 and ATF Forms 3310.12 (multiple reports), properly, and timely.

Additionally, SIOI (b)(6) verified 63 DROS/NICS checks with no discrepancies found. No evidence or signs of trafficking relating to the licensee's acquisition and disposition of firearms discovered. Finally, Investigator (b)(6) conducted 25 crosschecks from the disposition record to the ATF Forms 4473 to verify the purchaser, date of transfer and the make/model and description of the firearm, with no discrepancies discovered.

Computerized criminal history checks conducted on five (5) firearms and two (2) individuals. An additional check conducted on Mr. Jeffrey Cagle, licensee. The outcome resulted in no "hits". No further action taken or warranted. No discovery of any obliterated serial numbers discovered, likewise with any illegal firearms during the inspection period. There was a theft of firearms, with recovered. The two (2) individuals (not including licensee) forwarded selected as possible suspicious purchasers, possible traffickers and/or prohibited persons identified during this inspection. No further action necessary.

8 - Trace Activity

An FFL history query conducted for the period of June 2, 2014 to June 2, 2017. The query revealed the licensee associated with firearm trace requests; however, none within the inspection period (June 6, 2016 through June 5, 2017), with FFL Theft report involving firearms, none recovered. As stated earlier firearms recovered, as informed by the licensee and email confirmation from the ATF National Tracing Center (b)(6) Contractor, Stolen Firearm Program). No new or any additional "Open" and/or unsuccessful/unresolved trace requests discovered. Investigator (b)(6) reminded Mr. Cagle of the 24-hour requirement for future ATF trace requests, which he understood.

Secondary market analysis conducted on six (6) firearms with no "hits" resulting. Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service retails approximately (b)(4) firearms, and the approximate number of used firearms sales in the last 12 months was the review of ATF Forms 4473, confirmed the licensee's non-completion and un-reporting of several multiple sales transactions and its associated forms; accounting for ATF Form 3310.4, resulting handguns; and on ATF form 3310.12; resulting "certain" rifles.

Computerized criminal history checks conducted on five (5) firearms and three (3) individuals (includes licensee), resulting in no "hits". The individuals forwarded selected as possibly suspicious purchasers, possible traffickers and/or prohibited persons identified during this inspection. No further field action warranted at this time.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

Mr. Jeffrey Cagle DBA Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service is conducting activities of a firearms dealer, with no activities under NFA, as an Importer or Collector. The licensee does offer gunsmithing services, through a local gunsmith; but no operations involving manufacturing; likewise, as a manufacturer of ammunition or the transfer of any assault weapons.

Deconfliction verified by the Lead IOI, Senior Industry Operations Investigator (b)(6) and completed by IA(b)(6), through NFORCE, NCIC and ATF CE and Intel with negative results. No other findings to report at this time.

12 - Closing Actions

A closing conference held on June 9, 2017, with ATF Senior Industry Operations Investigator (b)(6) and Mr. Jeffrey Mark Cagle, owner of Honey Lake Firearms & Guide Service. The findings of the inspection discussed and the licensee advised of the ATF regulations and Acknowledgment of Federal Firearms Regulations, and informed of the pending ATF Form 5030.5 (Report of Violations Statement). Furthermore, in keeping with the highlighted discrepancies and violations previously noted; emphasis discussed with the licensee on the following recordkeeping requirements:

- 1. the completion of ATF Form 4473; including instilling multiple checks;
- 2. the completion and submission of ATF Form 3310.4 (Multiple Sales of Handguns Report); and
- 3. the completion and submission of ATF Form 3310.12 (Report of Multiple Sale of Certain Rifles).
