The Firearms Transaction Record: ATF Form 4473 (5300.9) which included the Important Notice to all Federal Firearms Licensees, The Notices, Instructions, and Definitions Section which included that a buyer who is unable to read and/or write, the answers (other than the signature), Section A of the ATF Form 4473 may be completed by another person, excluding the transferor/seller. That two persons (other than the transferor/seller) must then sign as witnesses to the transferee's/buyer's answers and signature/certification in question 14. How items 3, 12a, 18a, 18b, 18c, and 25 on the ATF Form 4473 are required to be completed, how to properly record Military Identification and PCS Orders, how to properly record the model of a firearm if there is no visible information per the instructions on the ATF Form 4473 and not record a line or dash, how to properly record only U.S. Postal abbreviations for states and not cities, and the overall completion of the form which included initialing and dating corrections made by either the transferee or transferor during the transaction. The licensee was further advised that if the binding of the ATF Form 4473 comes apart they are to retain the form in a manner which ensures no pages are lost, to not mark "Denied" across the form, and to not conduct an electronic NICS background check prior to the completion of the ATF Form 4473 and unless associated with a firearms transaction and not in the anticipation of one.

The proper procedures on correcting the ATF Form 4473 which are detailed on page 3 of the form were additionally reviewed and discussed with the licensee.

There were no transfers to other licensees or law enforcement officers.

The FFL audit log verification was conducted on 27 National Instant Criminal Background Check (NICS) Transaction Number (NTN) with 11255 (125) discrepancies. In 11255 (125) discrepancies. instances the licensee failed to retain ATF Forms 4473 for denied transactions.



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For the above violation, the licensee was cited for failure to retain for a period of not less than five years, an ATF Form 4473, where a licensee has initiated a NICS check for a proposed firearms transaction, but the sale, delivery, or transfer of the firearm did not take place in a violation of 27 CFR 478.129(b).

The licensee was associated with ultiple sale transactions involving during the inspection period.

There were untimely reported multiple sales involving irearms discovered during the inspection. The licensee was cited with failure to timely or correctly report the sale of two or more pistols, or revolvers, or a combination thereof, on the same day or within five consecutive business days in instances involving violation of 27 CFR 478.126a.

Computerized criminal history checks were conducted on the suspicious purchasers, which revealed one purchaser with possible prohibiting information. Investigative Analyst (IA(b)(6)) conducted additional inquiries for (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)



8 - Trace Activity

A query was sent to the Violent Crime Analysis Branch; the response received on October 31, 2017, returned the following results:

The licensee was associated with uccessfully completed firearm trace requests and no unsuccessful firearms trace requests.

The ATF NTC Division: Information for Industry Members (ATF Publication 3312.10) which included a brief review of the purpose and function of the ATF NTC, what a firearms trace is, and the time frame for the submission of the requested information was reviewed and discussed with the licensee.

Secondary Market Analysis was conducted on four used firearms with negative results.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The licensee does not conduct business in NFA Firearms or as a manufacture, importer, or collector.

10 - Referrals

There was one referral generated by this inspection.



11 - Other

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IOI(b) (6) observed that the licensee had the Youth Handgun Safety Act poster properly displayed, and possessed a sufficient amount of pamphlets available for handgun transfers.

The licensee also maintains secure gun storage and safety devices that are available to customers for firearms that do not have secure gun storage or a safety device.

IOI (b) (6) observed the Federal Firearms License displayed.

IOI(b) (6) conducted queries of the NFORCE, TECS, Accurint and Open Fox databases on the licensee and found no prohibiting information. ATF Senior Intelligence Research Specialist (b) (6) conducted further deconfliction with negative results.

12 - Closing Actions

On December 11, 2017, a Closing Conference was conducted with Gary Wayne Hickey, Member/RP. The Federal Regulatory Requirements, which included Required Records & Reports, Conduct of Business, Licenses, Miscellaneous Provisions, State Laws & Local Ordinances, and General Questions and Answers, were discussed and reviewed with Mr. Hickey. Mr. Hickey indicated that he understood all the information by signing and dating the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations. A signed copy of the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations was provided to Mr. Hickey. A copy of the signed Acknowledgement is maintained in the area office file. On December 11, 2017, IOI (b) (6) reviewed and verified with Mr. Hickey at the business premises, that all corrections in the A&D Record and ATF Forms 4473 had been completed.

On December 13, 2017, a revised ROV; Page 5, Violation 6, was issued to Gary Wayne Hickey via email. The ROV was revised to accurately reflect the information on the worksheet, specificall firearms in inventory that were logged out of the A&D Record and failure to record the acquisition for one firearm.

The licensee was advised that if there are errors on the ATF Form 4473; per the instructions on page 3, if supporting information is available to substantiate the correction, make a copy of the page needing correction, initial and date the correction on the copy, and attach the corrected copy to the original ATF Form 4473. The licensee was further advised that per Section A instructions of the form, if the transferee is unable to read and/or write, the answers (other than the signature) may be completed by another person, excluding the transferor/seller. That two persons (other than the

Licensee's response: On December 11, 2017, when IOI (b) (6) reviewed with the licensee all of the ATF Forms 4473 in which multiple sales reports either had not been submitted and/or were not timely submitted, Mr. Hickey stated, "Under the impression, fill out form within five days from sale and mail it." When asked by IOI(b) (6) what Mr. Hickey would implement to ensure that similar errors are not made, Mr. Hickey stated, "File the form same day, Now that I know."

Corrective action: On all future ATF Forms 4473 in which two or more handguns are sold to the same person at one time or within five consecutive business days, the licensee will ensure that a Report of Multiple Sales or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers (ATF Form 3310.4) is completed and submitted as required by the regulations.

8. 27 CFR 478.129(b)

Nature of violation: Failure to retain for a period of not less than five years, an ATF Form 4473, where a licensee has initiated a NICS check for a proposed firearms transaction, but the sale, delivery, or transfer of the firearm did not take place in instances.

Licensee's response: On December 11, 2017, when IOI (b) (6) asked why the licensee did not retain ATF Forms 4473 for a period of not less than five years, Mr. Hickey stated, "Because running online, computer issues. Strictly NICS." Froze up, blocked and stopped. Bailed on it. Called NICS, got NTN's." When asked by IOI (b) (6) what Mr. Hickey would implement to ensure that this similar error did not occur, Mr. Hickey stated, "Use one or the other. Have an issue with computer. Jot down NTN and cancel it out. Done with computer. Then I can just call."

Corrective action: The licensee was advised that as required per the regulation, all ATF Forms 4473 where the licensee initiated a NICS check for the proposed firearms transaction, but the sale, delivery, or transfer of the firearm is not made, the licensee shall retain the ATF Form 4473 for a period of not less than five years separately from all ATF Forms 4473 that resulted in a transfer, sale, or delivery in alphabetical (by name of Transferee) or chronological (by date of Transferee's certification) order. FFLANIFIOX 115/18

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9. 18 U.S.C. 923(g)(5)(A)

Nature of violation: Failure to timely or correctly report the sale of two or more semiautomatic rifles, larger than .22 caliber with the ability to accept detachable magazines, on the same day or within five consecutive business days in stance involving firearms.

<u>Licensee's response</u>: On December 11, 2017, when IOI (6) reviewed with the licensee the ATF Form 4473 in which a multiple sales report either had not been submitted and/or was not timely submitted, Mr. Hickey stated, "Under the impression, fill out form within five days from sale and mail it." When asked by IOI (b) (6) what Mr. Hickey would implement to ensure that similar errors are not made, Mr. Hickey stated, "File the form same day, Now that I know."

Corrective action: On all future ATF Forms 4473 in which two or more semiautomatic rifles, larger than a .22 caliber with the ability to accept detachable magazines, are sold to the same person at one time or within five consecutive business days, the licensee will ensure that a Report of Multiple Sales or Other Disposition of Certain Rifles (ATF Form 3310.12) is completed and submitted as required by the regulations.

10. 27 CFR 478.128(c)

Nature of violation: Knowingly making false statements or representation with respect to any required information in instance. The licensee knowingly conducted a straw purchase. Specifically,(b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552, (b)(6) 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552, (b)(6)

Licensee's response: On November 6, 2017, when IOI (6) reviewed the ATF Forms for (b) (6) and asked the licensee to explain what had occurred, Mr. Hickey stated, (b) (6) came in to purchase guns. He was delayed and eventually, 20 days later, Denied. Ran his background check first. When

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
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he was delayed, his wife then said she was going to get the gun he wanted. It was a colored gun; we only had one like it. He had first dibs between the two of them and when he got delayed she got it instead, since that was the one she originally wanted anyway. On December 11, 2017, when IOI (b) (c) eviewed the ATF Forms for (b) (d) and asked the licensee to explain what had occurred, Mr. (b) (6) Hickey stated, "Both were looking at the same gun in the same color (b) (6) said he was going to get the gun. It came back a delayed. I told him (b) (6) can't do it.' (b) (6) said, 'Ha! I can get it and you can wait to resolve it.' Kind of when you were kid's kind of thing. Sucks to be you. Have first dibs." When asked by IOI (b) (6) what Mr. Hickey would implement to ensure that similar errors are not made, Mr. Hickey stated, "Document. Not do this. Have customer write a statement so it doesn't look like I'm trying to pull some shenanigans."

Corrective action: The licensee was advised that any licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, licensed dealer, or licensed collector who knowingly makes any false statement or representation with respect to any information required by the provisions of the Act or this part to be kept in the records of a person licensed under the Act or this part shall be fined not more than \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.


