1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

A full field recall inspection was initiated on March 12-14, 2018 by IO Investigators (b)(6) at the licensed premises of Ray O'Herron Company Inc. President Michael O'Herron, Responsible Person Joshua Christensen, and Human Resources Manager (b)(6) were interviewed during the course of the inspection. Ray O'Herron Company Inc. holds a Type 01, dealer of firearms license. The inspection covered the period of March 12, 2017, through March 12, 2018. No advance notice was provided to the licensee.

The initial onsite dates of the inspection are as follows:

- March 12, 2018 Inventory was conducted and reconciliation was initiated.
- March 13, 2018 Inventory reconciliation was continued and ATF Form 4473 review was conducted.
- March 14, 2018 Inventory reconciliation with the licensee being provided a list of all discrepancies.

Subsequent visits were made on the following dates:

- April 9, 2018 Verified disposition corrections in the bound book record
- May 3, 2018 Verified acquisition corrections in the bound book record
- May 17, 2018 Closing conference was held

Business Profile:

The licensee has held a Type 01 dealer of firearms license since the mid 1960's. The business is operated from a commercial storefront located in Danville, IL. No zoning restrictions apply to the location. During the noted 12 month inspection period, Ray O'Herron Company Inc. has acquired ^{(b) (4)} firearms and disposed of approximately ^{(b) (4)} firearms.

The ratio of new firearms versus used firearms in roughly $^{(b)}(4)$ new versus $^{(b)}(4)$ used. Approximately $^{(b)}(4)$ of firearms sold/transferred are handguns versus $^{(b)}(4)$ long guns. Around $^{(b)}(4)$ of the licensee's current inventory consisted of used firearms. Of these used firearms, $^{(b)}(4)$ were handguns while $^{(b)}(4)$ were long guns.

The Federal firearms license of is primarily used for firearm sales/transfers to police departments and law enforcement officers. In addition to firearms sales, they also offer various law enforcement products such as clothing, holsters, ammunition, etc. Ray O'Herron Company, Inc. also maintains a separate licensed location in Downers Grove, IL (3-36-04346).

Gun shows are not attended as a licensed dealer; however, firearm repair is conducted. The licensee is properly enrolled in the Illinois State Police Firearm Transfer Inquiry Program and is properly registered with the Illinois Department of Revenue.

Ownership and Control:

Federal firearms license 3-37-183-01-8J-04268 is an active corporation that is properly licensed with the Illinois Secretary of State (See Exhibit #1). The Federal Licensing System (FLS) database lists Josh Christensen, Justin Fredericks, (b)(6), Michael O'Herron, and Raymond O'Herron as responsible persons for FFL #3-37-04268. It was disclosed during the course of the inspection that (b)(6) is no longer with the company and will be removed as a responsible person at the time of renewal. All noted responsible persons possess a valid IL FOID cards. No hidden ownership was disclosed. In addition, current listed responsible persons were queried in the Illinois LEADS database with no disabling information disclosed.

Variance:

Licensee maintains no variances and none were requested.

2 - Recommendation

A Warning Letter and Recall Inspection are recommended.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

Ray O'Herron Company Inc. utilizes the EZ Arms Keeper software to maintain their acquisition and disposition record. At the onset of the inspection, a list of all of the licensee's open dispositions was requested. The open disposition list contained a total of firearms. A full inventory of firearms was subsequently taken on March 12-13, 2018. After the inventory was completed, it was determined that Ray O'Herron Company Inc. had firearms in inventory.

The review disclosed that firearms in the physical inventory did not have a correlating entry in the bound book records. A total of firearms on the open disposition list did not have a firearm in the physical inventory. As a result of the inspection, the following violation resulted from the inventory/bound book review.

On instances, the licensee had inventory/acquisition and disposition record discrepancies which resulted in the violation of 27 CFR 478.125(e). These instances have been documented on Worksheet #1. Further details can be found in Section 13 – Violations, Violation #1.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

Ray O'Herron Company Inc. had forms on file for noted 12 month inspection period of March 12, 2017, through March 12, 2018. The forms are filed in chronological order further separated on a monthly basis. All forms for the inspection period were reviewed and 21 forms were traced back to the licensee's bound book. The ATF Form 4473 review disclosed the following discrepancies.

On instances, licensee was in violation of 27 CFR 478.21(a). These inaccuracies have been documented on Worksheet #2. Further details can be found in Section 13 - Violations, Violation #2. The firearm purchasers in these noted instances were run in the Illinois LEADS database and no disabling information was disclosed.

An Illinois State Police FTIP printout was requested for a 12 month period. The printout was verified against 32 ATF Forms 4473 for that period with no discrepancies resulting.

6 - Multiple Sales

The licensee's trace history and multiple sale record were obtained from the Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB). The information received from VCAB revealed that the licensee was reporting multiple handgun sale transactions. However, a review of the licensee's ATF Forms 4473 disclosed other instances in which a multiple sale report was warranted which resulted in the violation of 27 CFR 478.126a. These oversights have been documented on Worksheet #2. Further details can be found in Section 13 – Violations, Violation #3. The licensee was reminded that a multiple sale report must be completed when a firearm purchaser acquires two or more handguns within five business days.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

Five firearm purchasers that failed to accurately complete ATF Form 4473, specifically for Question #11(a) were run through the Illinois LEADS database. In addition, Responsible Persons Josh Christensen, Justin Fredericks, Michael O'Herron, and Raymond O'Herron were also run through the Illinois LEADS database and queried in NSPECT. No prohibiting or disabling information was disclosed.

8 - Trace Activity

The information received from the e-trace database showed that Ray O'Herron Company Inc. (FFL# 3-37-04268) was associated with firearm trace requests, including duplicate, that were not completed an individual purchaser and that are pending completion (OPEN). do the incomplete traces had a sales date of greater than 20 years while the other was not received by the licensee. do the open traces was completed during the course of the inspection and the licensee did not receive the other. The information was forwarded to the National Tracing Center. In addition, the licensee had one FFL Theft report involving firearms, none of which have been recovered. These firearms were the result of the October 2016 compliance inspection.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The Ray O'Herron Company Inc. does not import or manufacture firearms. In addition the licensee does not possess a collector's license. However, the licensee holds a valid Special Occupational Tax (SOT). At the onset of the inspection, the licensee had two NFA rifles in inventory for repair. During the closing conference, these NFA firearms had been returned to the police department from which they were obtained.

10 - Referrals

No referrals were generated as a result of the inspection.

11 - <u>Other</u>

No other noteworthy findings were disclosed.

12 - Closing Actions

A closing conference was conducted on May 17, 2018. A review of the inspection findings was discussed with President Michael O'Herron, Responsible Person Joshua Christensen, and Human Resources Manager (b)(6) and the discrepancies were documented on ATF Form 5030.5, Report of Violations. The three violations were thoroughly reviewed. Michael O'Herron signed ATF 5030.5 indicating that he has received a copy of the report.

All of the licensee's Federal regulatory responsibilities were stressed. An Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations was reviewed and signed by Michael O'Herron (See Exhibit #6). IOI (b)(6) verbalized the Acknowledgement's summary statement indicating that the licensee understood all of their requirements. Furthermore, Mr. O'Herron was instructed on how to obtain an electronic version of the regulations reference guide. Also, information regarding FFL Security and Private Sales was discussed the licensee with handouts for each being provided.

13 - Violations

1. 27 CFR 478.125(e) – THIS IS A REPEAT VIOLATION FROM THE OCTOBER 2016, JUNE 2000, AND MARCH 1994 COMPLIANCE INSPECTIONS

Nature of Violation: On tistances, licensee was in violation of 27 CFR 478.125(e) as follows. It was disclosed that firearms in the physical inventory did not have a correlating entry in the bound book records. A total of firearms on the open disposition list did not have a firearm in the physical inventory. Out of the firearms, it was determined that Ray O'Herron Company Inc. never received firearms were sequential pistols

(^{(b)(3)} 112 Public Law 55 125 STAT 552). (^(b) (4) was contacted directly and said that those particular firearms were never shipped to Ray O'Herron Company Inc.

Licensee Response: The licensee understood and agreed with the noted violation. During the course of the closing conference, Ray O'Herron Company Inc. explained that it has implemented several new policies to rectify the inventory shortcomings. According to the licensee, each month an inventory of one particular firearm manufacturer will be conducted with a full inventory being conducted on a more regular basis.

The most prominent reason for the inaccuracies occurred as a result of the licensee transferring firearms to and from the Ray O'Herron location in Downers Grove with no correlating entries. A new procedure has be employed in which a mandatory e-mail is exchanged whenever any store to store transfer occurs.

Furthermore, the Ray O'Herron Company Inc. has a computerized system for all products in their store, including firearms, known as MASS. Now on a weekly basis, this system is reviewed for all firearm serial numbers and compared to the EZ Arms Keeper acquisition and disposition record to ensure that the primary record keeper, (b)(6), received all invoices needed.

Corrective Action: Return visits were made to Ray O'Herron Company Inc. on April 9, 2018 and May 3, 2018 to verify corrections. The firearms in inventory with no correlating bound book entry were properly entered into the EZ Arms Keeper system. An acquisition printout for each of the firearms was obtained to verify the corrections (See Exhibit #2).

Disposition documentation was obtained for the fire open dispositions which had no firearm in inventory. It was determined that firearms were transferred to the Ray O'Herron Company Inc. location in Downers Grove, IL. firearms were transferred to other FFL's. A total of firearms were law enforcement transfers. firearms were determined to be sold on an ATF Form 4473. firearm was reported missing as the result of the 2016 compliance inspection and never logged out of the records. Disposition documentation for the firearms is attached (See Exhibit #3).

As noted, were inaccurately entered into the bound book record of Ray O'Herron Company Inc. After confirmation with (b)(4), the licensee amended the EZ Arms Keeper record to detail that the firearms were never received.

2. 27 CFR 478.21(a) – THIS IS A REPEAT VIOLATION FROM THE OCTOBER 2016 COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

Nature of Violation: On instances, licensee was in violation of 27 CFR 478.21(a). ATF Form 4473's, Firearms Transaction Records, had an incorrect "no" answer for Questions #11(a) (actual buyer of the firearm listed on the form) (See Exhibit #4).

Licensee Response: The licensee understood and agreed with the noted violation. With regards to the ATF Form 4473 discrepancies, the licensee said that he had no excuse and just missed the errors. The licensee agreed that a more thorough review of completed ATF Forms 4473 was needed.

Corrective Action: The proper method for completing and obtaining an ATF Form 4473 was reviewed with the licensee. The firearm purchasers in these noted instances were run in the Illinois LEADS database and no disabling information was disclosed.

3. 27 CFR 478.126a – THIS IS A REPEAT VIOLATION FROM THE OCTOBER 2016 AND MARCH 1994 COMPLIANCE INSPECTIONS

Nature of Violation: On instances, licensee was in violation of 27 CFR 478.126a. Ray O'Herron Company Inc. failed to report two multiple handgun sales which involved firearms.

Licensee Response: The licensee understood and agreed with the noted violation. As with the ATF Form 4473 discrepancies, the licensee said that the multiple sale oversight was just missed. Again, the licensee agreed that a more thorough review of completed ATF Forms 4473 was needed.

Corrective Action: Ray O'Herron Company Inc. completed ATF Form 3310.4, Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers, and forwarded the forms appropriately (See Exhibit #5). The licensee was reminded that a multiple sale report must be completed when a firearm purchaser acquires two or more handguns within five business days.

An examination of your premises, records and operations has disclosed the following violations which have been explained to you:

Nuture of Violation:

On instances, licensee was in violation of 27 CFR 478,125(e) as follows. It was disclosed that the firearms in the physical inventory did not have a correlating entry in the bound book records. A total of firearms on the open disposition list did not have a firearm in the physical inventory. Out of the Inc. never received **and** of these firearms and made inaccurate acquisition entries. The noted fincurms were sequential (2331127 pistols ((b)(3) 112 Public Law 55 125 STAT 552 (b) (4) was contacted directly and said that those particular firearms were never shipped to Ray O'Herron Company inc.

Corrective Action to be Taken: The minimum in inventory with no correlating bound book entry were properly entered into the EZ Arms Kggper system. An acquisition printout for each of the firearms was obtained to verify the corrections. Disposition documentation was obtained for the dispositions which had no firearm in inventory. It was determined that firearms were transferred to the Ray O'Herron Company Inc. location in Downers Grove, IL. firearms were transferred to other FFL's. A total of firearms were law enforcement transfers. fincorms were determined to be sold on an ATF Form 4473. firearm was reported missing as the result of the 2016compliance inspection and never logged out of the records. The EZ Arms, Keeper system was updated accordingly. As noted, Glock pistols (^{(D)(3)} 112 Public Law 55 125 STAT 552 were inaccurately entered into the bound book record of Ray O'Herron Company Inc. After confirmation with (9)(4) the licensee amended the EZ Arms Keeper necord to detail that the firearms were never received.
