1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On 1.8.2018, ATF Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b) (6) initiated an on-site compliance inspection on Type 01, Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL) DSG, Inc. d/b/a Dance's Sporting Goods. DSG is a Demand Letter 2 FFL. DSG is a NFA dealer. The inspection inclusive dates were 1.8.2017- 1.8.2018. Assisting IOIs were (b) (6)

DSG's 2014 inspection resulted in Viols ROV ONLY and No Recall Inspection. IOI (b)(6) primary contacts during this inspection were Co-owner and Responsible Person, Mr. Walter "Forrest" Dance; Store Manager, (b) (6) ; and Assistant Store Manager, (b) (6) . IOI (b)(6) gave the licensee no advanced notification of this inspection and no other governments participated in this inspection.

The scope of the inspection was to conduct a DE inspection to determine if the FFL was compliant with ATF laws and regulations.

Closing Conference conducted 2.1.2018.

Business Profile:

Dance's Sporting Goods owners, Forrest and Marlon Dance, along with their father, opened Dance's Sporting Goods in 1976, in a small location in Petersburg, VA. Over the past 33 years DSG's premises has grown to over 20,000 sq. feet of retail space, located in Colonial Heights, VA. DSG boasts "We offer the finest quality hunting and fishing supplies available."

IOI(b)(6) determined DSG is a hunting, and fishing mecca that retails new and used handguns, long guns, ammunition, hunting gear, fishing bait and tackle, archery and crossbow gear, an archery shooting range, hunting apparel, footwear, air guns, paintball accessories, and NRA firearms classes. DSG offers a limited service firearms repair shop. DSG also sells firearms on the internet using Guns America, Gun Broker.com, and Guns International. Occasionally, DSG sponsors a firearms auction inside the store. DSG does not sell receivers, but will transfer receivers.

During the operational period, DSG acquired (b)(4) firearms; (b)(4) handguns, (b)(4) long guns, and NFA weapons; DSG disposed (b)(4) firearms; (b)(4) handguns, (b)(4) long guns, and NFA weapons. On 1.8.2018, DSG possessed

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(b)(4) firearms in inventory (that included provided prov

The licensee's main suppliers of new firearms are (b) (4)

to name a few, and numerous firearms manufacturers. The licensee has the required State and local licenses and permits and does not maintain off-site storage. DSG's EIN is (b)(3) 26 USC 6103, DIN is 1181. DSG's web site is www.dancessportinggoods.net. DSG has a Facebook page.

Ownership and Control:

IOI (b)(6) determined President, Mr. Jon Marlon Dance and Secretary/Treasurer, Mr. Walter Forrest Dance equally possess 50% of the corporate shares. Mr. Marlon Dance and Mr. Forrest Dance equally share corporate control, policy and decision making (NCIC/NLETS/NForce negative). There are no other directors or stock holders of the corporation. IOI (b)(6) does not suspect hidden ownership.

DSG employs approximately 54 personnel; of which, 82% are part-time employees. DSG employs 17 personnel who possess a State Seller ID.

The Virginia State Corporation Commission reports DSG, Inc. "Active" and in good standing; SCC ID (5)(3) - 28 USC 6103

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

On 1.8.2018, DSG's ARS (point-of-sale) automated A&D Record system query revealed open entries. DSG's inventory consisted of 3,689 firearms.

At DSG, ARS compartmentalizes sales, repair, and NFA A&D Records. IOI's (b)(6) and (b)(6) used DSG's mobile scanners to take a 100% inventory. Post inventory, IOI (b)(6) reconciled all ARS's "variance query" or "not counted" anomalies. DSG's variance query revealed late dispositions in the repair area of DSG that were not entered into the A&D Record, they are as follows:

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(b)(3) 112 PL 55 125 STAT 552

As part of the inspection process, IOI (b)(6) directed DSG to immediately enter the dispositions into the A&D Record. The disposition dates are documented on Worksheet 1, "Inventory A&D." IOI (b)(6) cited the licensee for the late entries (Violation 7, Worksheet 1 and ROV).

DSG's gunsmithing operation amounts to minor repairs such as bore sighting, scope mounting, minor adjustments, etc. and returning firearms to manufacturers. Firearms that are not recovered by their owner, within a specified time, will be transferred within ARS as a retail sale item.

IOI (b)(6) determined the licensee incorporates segregation of functions within the organization and provides widespread authority to execute a transaction, record a transaction, and responsibility for custody of the assets. Two people normally acquire all the new firearms from the receiving area of the store. These two individuals use bar codes and a scanner device for automated serial number acquisition and then manually enters the remaining firearm nomenclature into ARS. Traded firearms required manual input into ARS. Any employee may place new or used firearms on the sales floor.

By scanning the buyer's license, ARS will automatically populate the address window. The licensee has no written sound system of practices or policies demonstrating a consistent application of formal or informal procedures to ensure the accuracy of the record keeping system. A cross-check of firearm nomenclature is not accomplished with DSG's semi-annual inventory. DSG reported their last inventory as October 2017 that reconciled.

Sales personnel verify the buyers ID at the gun counter. DSG completes State POC/NICS transactions using V-Check. Once the sale transaction is complete (paperwork/money) the buyer carries the firearm unescorted out of the store.

IOI (b)(6) verified that a situation still occurs, caused by the processing of a sold firearm, when ARS automatically makes the disposition entry. Occasionally, a buyer will not physically take the firearm with him/her after the sale transaction is completed. The conundrum is, ARS makes a disposition entry when the firearm is sold and the bar code is scanned, and if the firearm remains in the store for a period, and should a disaster happen and the firearm is lost, this situation would make it potentially difficult to track the firearm. The licensee agreed during the last inspection that at the end of the day, they will purge the system of transfer dates on firearms that remain overnight.

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The licensee did not file a theft/loss report during the past year or as a result of this inspection.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

During the reporting period, DSG Inc. executed ATF Forms (enied). IOI's reviewed 100% of the Fs 4473 for errors. IOI's determined forms were in error (eniod), 2014- 9, 2011- 9, 2011- 9, 2011- 9, 2011- 9, 2011- 2011- 9, 2011- 201

In Section A, Items 11a-1, the licensee transferred firearms with "blank" answers (Violation 3, Worksheet 2 and ROV), NCIC/NLETS negative.

DSG transferred receivers to out-of-state residents (Exhibit 1, Violation 2, Worksheet 2 and ROV). DSG stated that it was not aware that it could not transfer a handgun to an out-of-state resident. DSG stated it will immediately inform and train the individuals who generated this violation.

Numerous Fs 4473 appeared corrected in Section A by someone other than the buyer. This was evident by mixed "Xs" and " \sqrt{s} ", different colored ink, different penmanship, etc. IOI (b)(6) discussed this item at the closing conference with the attendees. Mr. Dance explained that sometime with older people the spouse will help fill out the form.

IOI (b)(6) consulted with ATF Counsel (b) (6) about DSG using wide, general terms for "issuing authority" on Item 18a "Identification" e.g. DOD ID, DMV ID, MIL ID. (b) (6) 's response was to encourage DSG to use as specific terms as possible, but not issue a violation. IOI (b)(6) discussed this item at the closing conference with the attendees.

IOI(b)(6) traced 31 disposition entries in the A&D Record and verified that the licensee obtained and completed an ATF Form 4473 for each entry. IOI(b)(6) chose the month of December 2017 to compare within the A&D Record. IOI (b)(6) determined DSG executed all required Fs4473 without error for that time period; however, suspicious purchases were made. IOI (b)(6) discovered these by using the denied Fs 4473; they appear to be straw purchases. These purchases are documented in Section 10 "Referrals."

All employees with Virginia State Seller ID's may process Fs 4473 and make sales. DSG completes monetary transactions before initiating a NICS check. Employees scan firearm tag bar codes when processing a purchased firearm; this makes an automated disposition entry into ARS.

Forms 4473 receive three reviews prior to the buyer receiving the firearm. Both reviewers initial the F4473 on the reverse side of the form. A fourth person, whose only job is to review Fs 4473, reviews the Form 4473 prior to filing the form.

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The licensee files ATF Forms 4473 in numerical order via an assigned ARS number. IOI (b)(6) determined that the licensee properly records transfers with other FFLs, maintains a file of FFL's licenses and utilized FFL EZCheck.

IOI (b)(6) contacted the Virginia State Police, Firearms Transaction Program, for the FFL Audit Log for the months of January and February 2017. A comparison of 149 inquiries against forms yielded no discrepancies.

6 - Multiple Sales

The Violent Crimes Analysis Branch FFL Master Query listed multiple handgun sales, involving firearms, during the inspection period.

IOIs discovered numerous multiple sale purchases that were neither listed in ATFs two month query nor did DSG have a hard copy of ATF Form 3310.4, Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers available as directed in CFR 478.126(a). However, at some point in 2017, DSG started electronically sending the multiple sale eform to ATF. Therefore, DSG was able to show a completed copy of each form that IOIs could not otherwise locate. During the next inspection, the lack of a hard copy multiple sale form should become a violation; previously this was not an issue as DSG was not electronically forwarding multiple sale forms to ATF; therefore, filed hard copies. IOI (b)(6) showed Mr. Forrest Dance 478.126(a) where it clearly directs the above action.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

IOI (b)(6) requested an analysis of firearms traces, theft or loss reports, and multiple sale information from the Violent Crimes Analysis Branch. IOI (b)(6) analyzed the trace history of the licensee for the past year.

IOI(b)(6) examined the licensee's records to determine if trafficking or straw purchase indicators were present. After analyzing the data, IOI (b)(6) comprised a list of individuals and checked some individual's criminal history record in NCIC and eTrace to determine any prohibiting factors which may prevent them from possessing a firearm.

IOI (b)(6) investigated many individuals, bu individuals for possible involvement with trafficking or straw purchases.

8 - Trace Activity

The Violent Crimes Analysis Branch (VCAB) FFL Master Query reported traces in from 1.8. 2017 - 1.8.2018 (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552 There were with a time-to-crime (TTC)(b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

Dances Sporting Goods acquired approximately (b)(4) used firearms and disposed of approximately (b)(4) firearms during the reporting period.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

DSG, Inc. does not Import, Collect or Manufacture firearms.

DSG is a dealer in NFA weapons. DSG's (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103

On 1.8.2018, DSG's NFA A&D Record system query revealed open entries. IOI (b)(6) completed a 100% inventory by firearm nomenclature and compared it against the A&D Record. The inventory consisted of 45 weapons.

IOI (b)(6) downloaded the National Firearm Registration and Transfer Record (NFRTR) that listed (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103, (b)(6)


Embedded within ARS, and separate from the Title I sales and Repair A&D Record, is the NFA A&D Record. DSG has no manual A&D Record(s). (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103 Forms 4473 were individually filed by transferee and available. IOI (b)(6) showed the store manager §479.131 where each dealer shall maintain NFA records in chronological order. The store manager files NFA forms in a separate folder by buyer's name.

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
10 - Referrals

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11 - Other

The Violent Crime Analysis Branch has processed IOI (b)(6) request to provide FFL history query for DSG, Inc. (FFL #1-54-09538). The activity for DSG, Inc. (FFL #1-54-09538) for the time period of January 1, 2017 to January 2, 2018. The results are as follows: DSG, Inc. (FFL #1-54-09538) was associated with firearm trace requests, including duplicates. This FFL was also associated with multiple sale transactions involving firearms.

The Violent Crime Analysis Branch has also processed IOI (b)(6) request to provide Individual/Address history queries for Jon Marlon DANCE (DOB: (b) (6) and Walter Forrest DANCE (DOB: (b) (6)) address listed as (b) (6)

12 - Closing Actions

On 2.1.2018, IOI (b)(6) held a Closing Conference with DSG, Inc. owners Mr.'s Forrest and Marlon Dance with FFL Guard Representative, (b) (6) on speaker phone.

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IOI (b)(6) summarized each item on the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations to the licensee's satisfaction and answered all questions. Mr. Forrest Dance signed the Acknowledgement verifying the information was explained and received a signed copy for DSG's files (Exhibit 10).

IOI (b)(6) issued a Report of Violations (ROV) to DSG on 2.1.2018. IOI (b)(6) discussed the violations and explained all violations found during this inspection. IOI (b)(6) explained why they were violations, how to correct the violations and how to keep proper records in the future to avoid the violations from reoccurring. Mr. Dance signed the ROV verifying that IOI (b)(6) explained the violations to him. Mr. Dance stated that he understood the ROV. IOI (b)(6) provided Mr. Dance an original copy of the ROV for DSG's records.

Mr. Forrest Dance stated, "We need more employee education."

Corrective Action:

Licensee shall verify the identity of the buyer by examining the identification document and shall note on the ATF Form 4473 the type of identification used.

Question 19d (Later NICS response) was answered in error times and blank times

Licensees Response:

Again, we need more employee training and Axis should eliminate these errors.

Corrective Action:

Licensee shall obtain and enter the missing NICS information; obtain missing Form 4473 NICS information by referring to the NICS information on the corresponding SP-65. Make Forms 4473 corrections on a copy of the affected Form 4473; make no corrections to the original Form 4473.
