REVIEW COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation: Violations DIO (or Delegate) Held WC ILO Revocation.

According to the Administrative Action Policy, ATF O 5370.1B, paragraph 6(e)(4)(a), the Licensee would merit revocation for the transfer of a firearm to a person knowing or having reason to believe that the transferee is a prohibited. In accordance with ATF O 5370.1B, paragraph 9(a)(2). However, a warning conference in lieu of revocation based on the following reasons.

Violation for 27 CFR 478.99(c) merits revocation. Three (3) violations merit a report of violations only (27 CFR 478.21(a), 478.124(c)(1), & 478.124(c)(3)(iv); three (3) merits a warning letter only (27 CFR 478.102(a)(1), 478.124(c)(3)(i) & 478.126a); and one (1) merits a warning conference (478.99(a)). Two of three that merits a warning letter would merit a warning conference based on Repeat violations.

The Licensee is a large volume dealer who conducted approximately transactions on ATF Forms 4473 in the 12-month inspection period, a total of Mathematical ATF Forms 4473 were cited among the eight violations; an error rate of 0.3%.

he Licensee timely reported an estimated we multiple sale transactions involving 636 firearms over the last 12-months.

The Licensee accounted for all inventory and acquisition and disposition entries during the inspection period. There were approximately 3,826 firearms in inventory, (b)(4) acquisitions and (b)(4) dispositions over the last 12-months.

The Licensee responded successfully to irrearms trace requests during the 12-month inspection period.



1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

A query of the Federal Licensing System (FLS) disclosed two Special Attention Flags (SAF) - "Demand Letter 2 (U) and Recall Inspection Recommended (P)". Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) queried N-Force for active investigations associated with the Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL) and/or the address which disclosed none.

On June 6, 2016, IOI (b)(6) initiated a Recall Disposition Emphasis (DE) firearms compliance inspection on Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc, d/b/a Ed's Public Safety at 4431 N. Henry Blvd., Stockbridge, Georgia 30281 (referred to herein as the "Licensee"). IOI (b)(6) inspection team participants and their onsite dates included IOI (b)(6) 2016), IOI (b)(6) (June ((June 6-8, 2016), IOI (b) (6) (June 6-8, (June 6 & 8, 2016), IOI (b)(6) (June 6-7, 2016), IOI (b)(6) (June 6, 2016) and Intern (b) (6) (June 6-9, 14, 2016). Grady Edward (Ed) Turner, CEO/responsible person; Lisa Patrick, Controller/responsible person; (b) (6) , Pawn Manager; (b) (6) General Manager were available during the inspection. The inspection period focused on the last 12-months covering the dates June 6, 2015 to June 6, 2016. IOI (b) (6) conducted the onsite inspection on June 6-9, 13-15, 20-23, 27-28, 30, 2016 and concluded the onsite inspection on July 19, 2016 with the closing conference held with the Licensee.

Business Profile:

The Licensee holds a Type 02 license as a dealer, including pawnbroker, in firearms other than destructive devices. The Licensee has held this license since January 27, 1996. The license is suitable for the type of business conducted. The Licensee also has a current 2016 Special Tax Stamp as a National Firearms Act (NFA) firearms dealer under control number

The Licensee is located in a retail/urban area within the City limits of Stockbridge, Georgia. The Licensee has a City of Stockbridge Occupational Tax Certificate #0002 for the period January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016. On July 20, 2016, IOI (b)(6) met with (b)(6), Planner/GIS Specialist and (b)(6), Administration & Community Service Director for the City of Stockbridge. Director Hall advised that there are three commercial zones – C1, C2 and C2 and any retail business is permitted in any of those commercial

During the inspection period, the Licensee acquired approximately (b)(4)firearms consisting of approximately (b)(4) (b)(4) handguns & other firearms, and (b)(4) (b)(4) long guns. Of the firearms acquired, approximately (b)(4)(b)(4) were new firearms and (b)(4) (b)(4) were used firearms. The Licensee's primary suppliers of new firearms include (b)(4)

. Secondary market firearms are

acquired through the general public, pawn, and trade-ins from law enforcement agencies.

The Licensee's customers are the general public, law enforcement, and other FFL's. The Licensee sells new and used firearms. For the period of inspection, the licensee disposed of approximately (b)(4) firearms. Of the firearms disposed, approximately (b)(4) of the firearms business involved wholesale transfers to other licensees and law enforcement departments, (b)(4) percent were retail ATF Form 4473 transactions, and (b)(4) percent were ATF Form 4473 pawn redemptions. Transactions involving NFA firearms accounts for approximately (b)(4) of the Licensee's business.

The Licensee is (b)(4) . The Licensee buys used service weapons from law enforcement agencies and provides these agencies credit to buy new service firearms to include NFA firearms. The License will also buy police department seized weapons and provide these departments credit for new firearms and equipment. As a service for these law enforcement agencies, the Licensee destroys any unserviceable weapons (unsafe or altered serial numbers) received from law enforcement agencies through the seizure and condemnation process.

The Licensee conducts internet sales and has two websites, <u>www.edspawn.com</u> and <u>www.edspublicsafety.com</u>. The latter website is used for the sales of firearms to law enforcement agencies and the general public. The licensee also uses <u>www.gunbroker.com</u> for firearm sales. The Licensee makes internet transfers for their customer's.

The Licensee does not conduct business at gun shows. The Licensee does not conduct any manufacturing, importing or gunsmith activity. The Licensee does not sell black powder. No other business is conducted on the premises.

The Licensee has two (2) offsite storage locations. (b)(6)

Mr. Turner stated that he has them securely stored at this location. He stated that he also has a firearm range at this location to conduct demonstrations for his law enforcement customers. The Licensee also has a warehouse located at 110 Rock Quarry Rd., Stockbridge, GA 30281, which is within walking distance of the Licensee's business premises.

Ownership and Control:

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. d/b/a Ed's Public Safety operates as a Domestic For-Profit Corporation in the State of Georgia. The effective date of registration for Ed's Pawn Shop was June 5, 1992. The Licensee was found to be in active compliance with the Georgia Secretary of State's Office. The most recent annual registration (2016) shows Grady E. Turner, III as the CEO, CFO and Secretary of the corporation. Mr. Turner stated that he is the only corporate officer for Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. and that he owns all of the stock. He further stated that there have been no changes to the corporation in regards to business structure or ownership.

A review of FLS shows Grady Edward Turner, Lisa Patrick, and Danny Burkett as the responsible persons for Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. Mr. Turner stated that there were no other responsible persons for this FFL. No hidden ownership is suspected. No responsible persons were added or removed from the license.

Variance:

Ed's Pawn Shop does not have any active variances and did not request a variance during the inspection. The Licensee was provided with a copy of ATF Ruling 2016-1 which provides the conditions for maintaining computerized acquisition and disposition records. The Licensee uses the Pawn Master computer software.

2 - <u>Recommendation</u>

Viols DIO Held WC ILO Revocation

According to the Administrative Action Policy, ATF O 5370.1B, paragraph 6(e)(4)(a), the Licensee would merit revocation for the transfer of a firearm to a person knowing or having reason to believe that the transferee is a prohibited. In accordance with ATF O 5370.1B, paragraph 9(a)(2), IOI(b)(6) recommends a warning conference in lieu of revocation based on the following reasons.

• The Licensee was cited for (8) eight violations. The violation for 27 CFR 478.99(c) merits revocation. Of the remaining seven (7) violations, three (3)

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violations merit a report of violations only (27 CFR 478.21(a), 478.124(c)(1), & 478.124(c)(3)(iv); three (3) would merit a warning letter only (27 CFR 478.102(a)(1), 478.124(c)(3)(i) & 478.126a); and one (1) would merit a warning conference (478.99(a)). Two of three that merit warning letter would merit a warning conference based on repeat violations.

- The Licensee conducted approximately transactions on ATF Forms 4473 in the 12-month inspection period, a total of ATF Forms 4473 were cited among the eight violations. That is an error rate of 0.3%!
- The Licensee has many standard operating procedures (SOP) in place, such as quarterly inventories and triple reviews of the ATF Form 4473 transactions, designed to promote compliance by reducing the number of errors. The Licensee employs approximately 18 employees, any of which can make a human mistake. At a 0.3% error rate, the Licensee's SOPs work. The 27 CFR 478.99(c) violations occurred due the failure of two (2) long time employees not not following the Licensee's SOPs.
- The Licensee timely reported an estimated multiple sale transactions involving firearms over the last 12-months.
- The Licensee accounted for all inventory and acquisition and disposition entries during the inspection period. There were approximately firearms in inventory, (b)(4) acquisitions and (b)(4) dispositions over the last 12-months.
- The Licensee responded successfully to the firearms trace requests during the 12-month inspection period.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

The Licensee uses the Pawn Master program for their computerized acquisition and disposition (A&D) records. The A&D record was found to be in the proper format. The Licensee was found to be maintaining their computerized A&D records in

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accordance with the criteria provided in ATF Ruling 2016-1. The Licensee generated an A&D record report in PDF format and saved it on a USB flash drive for use during the inspection.

Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) IOI (b)(6) IOI (b)(6) IOI (b)(6) IOI (b)(6) IOI (b)(6) IOI (b)(6) and ATF Intern (b) (6) conducted a full inventory of firearms which included 3,826 firearms, of which (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103 IOI (b)(6) traced the firearms to the Acquisition and Disposition (A&D) records disclosing no discrepancies.

IOI (b)(6) did not trace a sample of firearms through the records from their acquisition to their disposition due to the unsearchable nature of the PDF format in which the A&D record was received for review during the inspection.

The Licensee's standard operating procedures (SOP) relevant to the A&D record and inventory includes the following measures. The Licensee maintains computerized A&D records, but also maintains A&D record books for the NFA firearms as a backup record. There are approximately 18 employees who are responsible for making entries in the A&D record. The Licensee uses a computer generated inventory control number which is printed on a tag and attached to the firearm. The Licensee takes inventory on a quarterly basis. The inventory is conducted on a Sunday when the store is closed. The inventory is conducted by scanning the bar code on each firearm identification tag. The Pawn Master program compares the data scanned with the A&D record and then generates a discrepancy report. All discrepancies are then immediately reconciled. The Licensee's last inventory was conducted the week prior to the start of this inspection. All handguns are in a locked gun cabinet and the long guns are behind the counter on gun racks. Surplus firearm stock is kept in a large vault in the back of the store and/or at the off-site warehouse. The business security includes cameras, a barred gate in front of the main door, and an alarm system monitored by Stockbridge Police Department.

The Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB) FFL history received for the 3-year period covering February 1, 2013 to February 5, 2016 reported zero (0) theft or loss reports. IOI(b)(6) did not identify any trafficking issues, obliterated serial numbers, or illegal firearms.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

There were approximately ATF Forms 4473 on file and reviewed for the inspection period. Following is the breakdown by Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) of the approximate number or forms each reviewed - IOI (b)(6) reviewed (b)(6) rev

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law enforcement agency transactions were properly conducted and recorded in the A&D record. The inspection team identified the following violations resulting from the ATF Form 4473 review.

The Licensee failed to obtain the re-certification in Section C required when the transfer of the firearm takes place on a different day from the day the transferee completed Section A of ATF Forms 4473, in violation of 27 CFR 478.21(a). IOI (b)(6) conducted NCIC criminal records checks on the purchases disclosing no prohibiting criminal records. (Report of Violations-Violation 1, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 1)

The Licensee failed to obtain the required transferee (buyer) information and/or complete certification on ATF Forms 4473, in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1). IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) conducted NCIC criminal records checks on the purchasers disclosing prohibited purchaser. (Report of Violations-violation 2, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 2, Referral of Information, Number: 2016-0029)

The Licensee failed to verify the identity of the transferee by examining the identification document (as defined in section 478.11) presented, and note on the Form 4473 the type of identification used in ATF Form 4473 transaction, in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(i). IOI (b)(6) identified this individual as a prohibited person. (Report of Violations-violation 3, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 3, Referral of Information Number 2016-0029)

The Licensee failed to record the NICS contact Date, the NICS response(s) and/or the NICS transaction number (NTN) on ATF Form 4473 transactions, in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(iv). IOI(b)(6) conducted an NCIC query on the purchasers disclosing prohibiting criminal record. (Report of Violations-violation 4, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 4, Referral Number: 2016-0037)

The Licensee failed to contact the NICS system before the completion of the transfer of the firearm when the licensee accepted a permit that did not qualify as an exception to the NICS in instance, in violation of 27 CFR 478.102(a)(1). IOI(b)(6) conducted an NCIC query on the purchaser disclosing no prohibiting criminal record. (Report of Violations-violation 5, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 5)

The Licensee failed to submit an ATF F 3310.4 for multiple handguns sales, in violation of 27 CFR 478.126a. (Report of Violations-violation 6, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 6)

The Licensee sold a handgun to an unlicensed out-of-State resident, where the purchaser presented military orders which did not satisfy the residency requirement in instances, in violation of 27 CFR 478.99(a). IOI(b)(6) conducted NCIC criminal

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records checks disclosing no prohibiting criminal records. (Report of Violationsviolation 7, worksheet 2, Exhibit 7).

The licensee transferred firearms to persons who the licensee had reasonable cause to believe were prohibited when the Licensee transferred a firearm to a person after the Licensee received a denied response from the NICS system in instances, in violation of 27 478.99(c). IOI (b)(6) conducted NCIC criminal records queries disclosing prohibiting criminal records. IOI (b)(6) submitted Referrals of Information on the prohibited persons. (Report of Violations-violation 8, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 8, Referral of Information, Numbers 2016-0028 & 2016-0029)

IOI (b)(6) received the NICS Audit Log received listing denied status transactions for the period 11/30/98 to 02/04/16 and non-denied status transactions for the 60-day period 12/06/15 to 02/04/16. IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) verified the 722 non-denied transactions reported for the requested period. IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) verified the 39 denied transactions on file for the inspection period. IOI (b)(6) disclosed that the Licensee transferred a firearm to the purchaser after the Licensee received a denied response from the NICS system in the system instances, in violation of 27 CFR 478.99(c). (Report of Violations-violation 8, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 8, Referral of Information, Numbers 2016-0028 & 2016-0029).

The Licensee's standard operating procedures (SOP) relevant to the ATF Forms 4473 completion and other dispositions includes the following measures. The Licensee has approximately 18 employees that handle the firearms transactions. The Licensee files the forms numerically. The Licensee also assigns a transaction number to the dealer and law enforcement department transactions which are filed among the ATF Forms 4473. The Licensee has a triple check review of the ATF Forms 4473. The ATF Form 4473 is reviewed at the time the transaction occurs, at the end of the day, and a final review before the ATF Forms 4473 are filed. After each review, the Licensee's employee conducting the review initials and dates the forms. The Licensee attaches copies of the transferee's identification document(s) and, if applicable, their Georgia firearms carry permit. The Licensee's computer program is designed to "Flag" any multiple sale of a firearm (handgun or long gun) to the same customer within five (5)days. The employee will complete a multiple sale form immediately for a multiple handgun transaction and submit the form to ATF. At the end of the night, the manager will verify that all multiple sales were submitted. The License will begin to create a report of all firearm sales for the last five (5) days to double check that no multiple sales of handguns to the same purchaser were missed. The Licensee will start printing and attaching the e-NICS responses to the ATF Form 4473, especially when the firearm will be transferred when no response is received from the NICS system within the three (3) business days.

6 - Multiple Sales

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The Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB) FFL history received for the 3-year period covering February 1, 2013 to February 5, 2016 reported multiple handgun sales. IOI (b)(6) identified multiple handgun sales involving firearms that the Licensee did not report, in violation of 27 CFR 478.126a. (Report of Violations-violation 6, Worksheet 2, Exhibit 6)

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) conducted NCIC/e-Trace queries on the two (2) NICS denied transferees confirming their prohibited status. (Referral of Information, Numbers (b)(3) 112 PL 55 125 STAT 552). IOI (b)(6) conducted NCIC/e-Trace queries on 52 transferees disclosing prohibiting criminal record. IOI (b)(6) queried the purchaser and the firearm in the e-Trace system disclosing no other traces to this individual. However, the firearm was the subject of a firearm trace subsequent to the purchase. (Referral of Information, Number: 2016-0037). IOI (b)(6) also identified a suspicious transaction which (b)(7)(E).

8 - Trace Activity

The Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB) FFL history received for the 3-year period covering February 1, 2013 to February 5, 2016 reported the Licensee was associated firearm trace requests, of which were within the 12-month inspection with period. The licensee successfully responded to the trace requests within the inspection period. Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b) (6) obtained transaction information unsuccessful traces with a Disposition Code on which occurred outside the inspection period. It appears the traces were unsuccessful due to discrepancies between the serial number of the firearm recorded by the Licensee and the serial number supplied by the supplier of the firearm. On August 11, 2016, IOI (b)(6) forwarded the trace information to the National Tracing Center via email (b) (6) @atf.gov). The Licensee acquired approximately (b)(4) used firearms and disposed of approximately (b)(4) used firearms during the inspection period. IOI (b)(6) conducted NCIC and e-Trace queries on a sample of 24 secondary market firearms disclosing no stolen or trace reports. IOI(b)(6) disclosed suspicious firearm reported as a suspect firearm under criminal enforcement case number 760545-15-0024. IOI(b)(6) reviewed the criminal enforcement case information and determined there was no new information to refer to the case agent. IOI (b)(6) conducted NCIC and e-Trace queries on an additional sample of 58 firearms disclosing no stolen firearms or suspicious firearm reports. IOI(0)(6) disclosed firearm trace report which is included in Referral of Information, Number 2016-0037.


9 - <u>NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer</u>

The licensee is a registered (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103, (b)(6)

The licensee does not conduct activities as a Manufacturer, Importer or Collector at this time.

10 – <u>Referrals</u>

Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) identified prohibited persons whereby the Licensee transferred firearms to each person after receiving a denied response from the NICS system. IOI (b)(6) identified a prohibited person whereby the Licensee transferred a firearm to a person after no response was received from the NICS system within the 3-business days. IOI (b)(6) also prepared a suspicious transaction referral of information on (b)(7)(E)

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) generated the Referrals of Information which were forwarded to the ATF Atlanta Field Intelligence Group (FIG) for further action.

Referral Number 2016-0028: On December 26, 2015, ^{(D(3))} 112 PL 65 125 STAT 652 ATF Form 4473 (transaction #16-0001) to purchase **(b)(3)** 112 PL 55 125 STAT 552 . **(b)(6)** recorded a "NO" response to question 11.c., "Have you ever been convicted in any court of a felony , or any other crime, for which the judge could have imprisoned you for more than one year, even if you received a shorter sentence including probation?" On December 26, 2015, the Licensee contacted the NICS system and NICS provided a "delayed" response to the Licensee with a Missing Disposition Information (MDI) date of December 31, 2015. On December 31, 2015, NICS contacted the Licensee via telephone and advised them the transaction was denied (NICS transaction number **(b)(3)** 112 PL 55 125 STAT 552 (0)(9)(112 PL 55 125 STAT 552). The Licensee transferred the denied response on the ATF Form 4473. ON January 2, 2016, the Licensee transferred the handgun to **(b)(6)**.



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
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

11 - Other

The Licensee prominently displayed the Youth Handgun Safety Act poster and made the written Notices available at the sales counter. The Licensee is aware of the

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requirement to make secure gun locks and/or safety devices available to the consumer, as well as, for all handgun transactions to non-licensees.

The Licensee is associated with two other Federal Firearms Licensees (FFL) -Stockbridge Sales Company, d/b/a Emergency Pawn Shop, Conyers, GA. (FFL: 1-58-09079) and Ed's Public Safety, Inc., Stockbridge, GA (FFL: 1-58-12396). Ed's Public Safety, Inc. received its FFL on August 3, 2016. Grady Edwin (Ed) Turner is the CEO/CFO/Secretary of both FFL businesses. Mr. Turner stated that the purpose of the new FFL is to separate Ed's Public Safety's wholesale sale of firearms to dealers and government/law enforcement agencies from the retail sale of firearms and the pawnbroker dealings with the general public.

12 - Closing Actions

On July 19, 2016, Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) held a closing conference with the Licensee represented by Ed Turner, CEO/responsible person, Lisa Patrick, Controller/responsible person, (b) (6), Pawn Manager, (b) (6), General Manager, and five of the sales associates to review and discuss the results of the inspection. IOI (b)(6) reviewed the violations cited on the Report of Violations and the corrective action to be taken. Mr. Turner signed the Report of Violations acknowledging this review and receipt of the report. IOI (b)(6) reviewed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations with Mr. Turner who subsequently signed the reference guide. (Exhibit 9)

When using the e-Check NICS system, recommend the Licensee print the NICS response and attach it to the ATF Form 4473 particularly when the Licensee chooses to transfer the firearm when no response is provided within the three (3) business days.

Licensee's Response: The Licensee (Ed Turner) stated that he has triple checks in place and does not know what else he can do. Mr. Turner stated, "We're going to make mistakes." The Licensee stated that the Pawn Master system notifies the user of a multiple handgun transaction, but these were missed.

Corrective Action: Licensee completed and submitted the ATF Forms 3310.4 during the inspection. Industry Operations Investigator (b)(6) queried e-Trace and verified the receipt of the multiple sale reports. (Reference: Worksheet 2-4473(2012 edition), Exhibit 6)





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Licensee's Response: The Licensee (Ed Turner) stated that he has triple checks in place and does not know what else he can do. Mr. Turner stated, "We're going to make mistakes." Mr. Turner stated that their standard operating procedures (SOP) for denials is to mark the ATF Form 4473 with "DENIED" in red ink. That SOP was not followed because the transaction occurred during their annual sales event, consequently, the reviewer missed the denial because it was not in red. Mr. Turner could not explain the other denial. Mr. Turner stated that their new SOP is to print the NICS e-Check results on any transactions where no resolution was provided within three (3) days by the NICS system and attach the printout to the ATF Form 4473.

Corrective Action: In the future, the Licensee shall not transfer a firearm to any person after the NICS system informs the Licensee that the transaction is Denied. Additionally, when using the e-Check NICS system, recommend the Licensee print the NICS response and attach it to the ATF Form 4473 particularly when the Licensee chooses to transfer the firearm when no response is provided within three (3) business days.



During a recent compliance inspection at your firearms business covering the period of June 6, 2015 to June 6, 2016, you were cited for violations of 27 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 478. The violations were discussed with you during the inspection. A copy of the Report of Violation, Form 5030.5, issued at the time of the inspection is enclosed.

You should be aware that any willful violations of the Gun Control Act may result in revocation of your Federal firearms license. As a result of the recently cited violations, it is important that we have a meeting with you to discuss the violations found. The conference will be held on December 22, 2016, at 10:00 AM at 2600 Century Parkway, NE, Atlanta, GA 30345. The agenda for the meeting will include a discussion of the reasons for the violations, a review of the legal requirements, and a discussion of steps to be taken by you to ensure future compliance. Although we do not believe it necessary, legal counsel may assist you at your own expense if you so choose. Please bring a compliance plan with your documentation verifying the corrective actions you have taken or will implement to ensure future compliance.

The records you are required to maintain and the business operations you conduct are important to law enforcement in our continuing efforts to reduce violent crime and protect the public. It is essential that you comply with all Federal laws and regulations that govern your firearms business to aid in this effort to combat violent crime. 

Dear Mr. Turner:

This letter is a follow-up to the warning conference held with you on December 22, 2016 at the Atlanta Field Division Office located at 2600 Century Parkway, Atlanta, GA 30345. During this conference, the violations cited during the inspection covering the period June 6, 2015 through June 6, 2016, and the necessary corrective action to prevent the violations from recurring were discussed.

You were given the opportunity to comment on the violations and what specific action you have taken to ensure that the violations will not recur.

<u>Regarding Violations # 1, 2, 3 & 4</u> where you failed to obtain complete and accurate information on the ATF Forms 4473 in accordance with the instructions on the form, where certain items on the forms were blank or incorrect. You stated that you have implemented a fourth review of the ATF Forms 4473, and will ensure the employees thoroughly conduct all reviews of the forms, in particular the second review, which occurs before the purchaser leaves the store.

<u>Regarding Violation #5</u> where you failed to conduct a background check and accepted an expired Georgia permit, which is a non-qualifying State permit, as substitute for NICS check in one instance. You stated that the employee responsible for the sale missed noticing that the permit was expired. You stated that you will ensure the policy is followed to not accept non-qualifying State permits as a substitute for NICS checks.

<u>Regarding Violation # 6</u> where you failed to prepare and file multiple sales reports when legally required in the instances. You stated that your computer software is designed to flag and/or notify the employee of the need to complete a multiple sale report for a particular transaction.

You also stated that you've spoken with the software producer concerning the notifications, and can run a report of all multiple sales from your computer software system. In going forward, employees will be cognizant of the notifications and complete the multiple sale report as required.

Regarding Violation #7 where you failed to prevent the transfer of a handgun or receiver to an out-of-State resident in the instances, involving military customers. You stated that you have a large military customer base and try to accommodate all of their requests, upon receipt of the required permanent change of station orders (PCS). You stated that your team of workers have found a few errors with the PCS and are trying to remain aware of the different original documents issued by each military branch that indicates a person has been assigned permanently to the State of Georgia, and the sale is permissible.

Regarding Violation # 8 where you failed to prevent the transfer of a firearm to a prohibited person knowing or having reason to believe that the transferee is a prohibited person, after receiving a denied response by the NICS system in instances. You stated that your employee failed to follow the procedure of notating on the front of the form, in red ink, the word "DENIED," and, as a result, the firearms were transferred. You will ensure that your employees follow the procedures to stamp the forms denied, review the forms thoroughly before the transfer, and audibly and verbally articulate to themselves the type of transaction they are handling when recording on the form, such as proceed, or denied. This manner of operation will assist with preventing prohibited transfers of firearms.

The violations for which you were cited could adversely impact law enforcement's ability to reduce violent crime and protect the public. You are reminded that future violations, repeat or otherwise, could be viewed as willful and may result in the revocation of your license. You may anticipate further inspections to ensure your compliance.
