The compliance investigation disclosed a total of seven (7) violations for which only one violation, 27 CFR 478.126a, warrants and administrative action, specifically involving a warning conference (WC). However, under current policy, revocation of the Federal Firearms License (FFL) would be justified for a licensee who has previously been the subject of a WC within the last five years (2011) and the current inspection warrants anothe WC for a repeated similar violation. During the inspection, it was discovered that Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc., failed to file multiple sales reports when legally required to in or more instances, in this case, in this case, in this case, in the commendation of DIO Held WC ILO Revocation is being recommended due to the following: There was a total of five repeat violations; however, the violation of 27 CFR 478.126a is the only violation that warrants an administrative action. The FFL is a high volume dealer who had a 78% increase in the number of multiple sales that occurred from the last investigation, and the number of instances the FFL failed to report the sales only increased by (failed to report in 2011). Lastly, through an added feature to the business computer system, the FFL has already instituted a new Standard Operating Plan to ensure tighter checks & balance and future compliance.


Inspection Profile:

On January 12, 2015, Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) led a Recall Firearms Compliance Inspection on Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL), Ed's Pawn Shop, D/b/a Ed's Public Safety. The inspection was conducted in accordance with Firearms Compliance Inspection Guidelines, and the instructions provided on the ATF Form 5700.14, Assignment and Report.

The Area Supervisor, in accordance with current office procedures, provided advanced notification to the ATF Atlanta Field Division, Criminal Enforcement (CE) Supervisors.

A query of the Federal Licensing System (FLS) disclosed that Ed's Pawn Shop has a Special Attention Flag (SAF) for being under a "Demand Letter 2". (A "Demand Letter 2" is sent to FFLs who have had fifteen or more firearms traced to them the previous year with a "time-to-crime" of three years or less. The affected FFLs are required to submit limited information regarding "used" firearms that they acquired the previous year. The FFL is required to submit this information quarterly, and until informed otherwise.)

A Query of NForce was negative for any possible open ATF criminal investigations.



Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. buys used service weapons from law enforcement agencies and provides these agencies credit to buy new service firearms to include NFA firearms. Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. will also buy police department seized weapons and provide these departments credit for new firearms and equipment. As a service for these law enforcement agencies, Ed's Pawn Shop Inc. destroys any unserviceable weapons (unsafe or altered serial numbers) received from law enforcement agencies through the seizure and condemnation process.

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. uses computerized acquisition and disposition (A&D) records A&D. The A&D record was found to be in the proper format. The licensee was found to be maintaining their computerized A&D records in accordance with the criteria provided in ATF Ruling 2013-5. (The A&D record was downloaded to a flash drive provided to the FFL by IOI (b)(6) Each open A&D entry was compared to the physical inventory. At the end of each day of inspection the flash drive was returned to a store manager to remain in their possession until the next day when it was retrieved by IOI (b)(6) At no time did the A&D record leave the business premises. At the end of the inspection the flash drive was erased by the licensee and was returned to IOI (b)(6)

A full physical inventory of all firearms was conducted by the ATF inspection team. Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. had a total of 3,117 firearms in physical inventory. There were open disposition entries in the A&D book. It was disclosed that there were open dispositions in the A&D record for which there was no firearm in inventory. (Ref. Worksheet 1). These unrecorded dispositions were immediately reconciled by the licensee and recorded in the A&D record. No firearms were reported as "Missing". The licensee was cited for a violation of 27 CFR 478.125(e), failure to record the disposition of firearms in the Acquisition and Disposition record (A&D). (Ref. ROV # 1, Worksheet 1, Exhibits 1-5).

Fifty dispositions were traced to the ATF Form 4473, no discrepancies were disclosed.

The licensee did not report any firearm thefts or losses during the period of inspection.

No trafficking issues relating to acquisition and disposition of firearms were disclosed.

No unregistered NFA firearms or firearms with obliterated serial numbers were found in inventory.

The standard operating procedures were evaluated through interviews, observation and examination of the records. There are five to ten employees handling the day to day operations, such as making all acquisition and disposition entries in the computerized A&D record and conducting firearms transactions. All firearms acquired are entered into the A&D computerized records by the end of the day that they are received. The computer system will automatically generate inventory tags with special identifiers (G= Used and GI= New) for all acquired firearms. The tag will also have a UPC bar code to track the firearm. The *Pawn Master* program automatically updates the firearm

dispositions into the computerized A&D record as the transaction is being conducted. The physical serial number of each firearm transferred is compared against the A&D entry, the inventory tag, the ATF Form 4473 and the sales receipt before the firearm is handed to the purchaser.

Quarterly firearms inventories are conducted. The inventories are conducted on a Sunday when the store is closed and firearm transactions are not occurring. The inventory is conducted by scanning the bar code on each firearms identification tag. The Pawn Master program will then compare the data scanned with the information recorded in the A&D record and then generate a discrepancy report. All discrepancies are then immediately reconciled.

All handguns are in a locked gun cabinet and the long guns are behind the counter on gun racks. Surplus firearm stock is kept in a large vault in the back of the store. The business security includes cameras, additional barred gate in front of main door, and an alarm system monitored by Stockbridge Police Department.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. had ATF Forms 4473 on file for the inspection period. The licensee was found to be filing their ATF Forms 4473 sequentially and chronologically. The ATF Form 4473 transaction serial numbers are sequential for that year and then start over when a new year begins. All ATF Forms 4473 for the inspection period were reviewed. Errors/discrepancies were disclosed on forms. Copies were obtained of the respective ATF Forms 4473 as documentation of the violations. (Copies were obtained by taking photographs of the respective ATF Forms using ATF issued I-phones. The forms were not removed from the premises.)

The review of the ATF Forms 4473 on file disclosed the following violations:







Fifty ATF Forms 4473 were traced to the A&D records. No discrepancies were disclosed.

According to the audit log the licensee had 446 NICS "Non-Denied" transactions for the period October 31, 2014 to December 30, 2014. All but twelve of the NICS transaction numbers (NTN) could be traced to an ATF Forms 4473. The licensee also enters the NTN into their computerized A&D records. A query of their A&D records did not disclose the twelve NTN's. It was noted that all of the twelve NTN's were issued around high volume times such as Christmas and Thanksgiving (Black Friday).

(b) (6) Pawn Manager, stated that during these times they were calling their NICS checks into the NICS center. Recently, Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. started doing their NICS queries online. (b) (6) stated that many times NICS would transfer the call for further research, and they would end up being on hold for a very long period of time. (b) (6) stated that on many occasions the call would be dropped and they would have to call back and attempt to contact customer service but would be routed to

further stated that they would end up calling back and a recorded message. starting the process over and end up getting a new NTN number which would be recorded on the ATF Form 4473. Industry Operations Investigator (b) (6) contacted , ATF NICS Liaison in regard to the matter. (b) (6) stated that he had discussed the situation with FBI NICs representatives and they stated that this was very possible during their high volume times. They stated that the licensee should have advised customer service that they had an NTN issued but their call had been dropped while waiting for further research. (b) (6) stated that in these instances the FFL should have recorded both numbers on the ATF Form 4473. After discussing the situation with Acting Supervisor (b) (6) and ATF Counsel, (b) (6), it was determined that the licensee would not be cited as there was no evidence of a violation. The licensee was thoroughly educated to use the NTN number issued and not conduct more than one NICS query on the same individual or this would be considered an abuse of the NICS system. They were advised to always contact customer service if a problem arose after an NTN was issued. The licensee is currently using NICS Online and these issues should not happen again.

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. had 528 NICS "Denied" transactions for the period November 30, 1998 to December 30, 2014. Thirty-five of the "Denied" transactions occurred during the inspection period. No discrepancies were disclosed during the review. The "Denied" transactions were found to be retained for the past five years and filed separately in chronological order.

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. makes a large number of firearm transfers to other licensee's. These transfers were found to have been conducted properly. The licensee attaches a copy of the invoice to a blank ATF Form 4473 that is serialized. This allows for the documentation for the transaction to be easily found and accessed when referenced from the A&D records.

The licensee was also found to have made numerous sales to individual law enforcement officers for official duty purposes as well as to large police departments during the period of inspection. These law enforcement transfers were found to be accurately conducted and documented.

One trafficking issue related to firearm purchasers was disclosed involving a possible straw purchaser. A Referral of Information, #2015-0013, was generated and forwarded to ATF Atlanta VI (Intel) for intelligence purposes (See Referral Section).

The standard operating procedures were evaluated through interviews, observation and examination of the records. Once a buyer is ready to purchase a firearm, the store clerk asks the purchaser for their Georgia firearms carry permit first and then their Georgia driver's license. The transferee's identification is examined and if the transferee's identification is valid, then the buyer will complete an ATF Form 4473 prior to any other activity taking place. If the buyer does not have a valid Georgia firearms carry permit, a background check (NICS) is initiated upon completion of ATF Form 4473. If the NICS check results are favorable or if the transferee has a valid Georgia Firearms permit, Section B and D of the form are completed by store clerk handling the transaction. The clerk attaches copies of the identification documents and Georgia firearms carry permit (if applicable) to the ATF Form 4473. After the transaction is completed a second clerk will review the ATF Form 4473. At the end of each day, a store clerk will review all the forms completed during the day. Each person reviewing the ATF Forms 4473 will initial the form. If an error is disclosed prior to the transaction being completed the customer will strike through the answer and record the correct response. IOI (b) (6) reminded the licensee that the customer must not only initial the correction but date it.

For errors discovered after the transaction is completed, the FFL was advised of the correct procedure to make a copy of the original and to make corrections to the copy and attach the copy to the original. The licensee was advised by IOI (b)(6) that they could only make changes to items in section B and D of the ATF Form 4473. The FFL was made aware that the purchaser was not required to come back to the store to make corrections, and it was completely voluntary for them to return to the store. The licensee was also advised not to visit the purchaser's residence to have the ATF Form 4473 corrected. The licensee's computer program will "Flag" any multiple sale of a firearm (handgun or long gun) to the same customer within five days. The employee will complete a multiple sale form immediately for a multiple handgun transaction and submit the form to ATF. At the end of the night, the manager will verify that all multiple sales were submitted. The license will begin to create a report of all firearm sales for the last five days to double check that no multiple sales of handguns to the same purchaser were missed.


6 – Multiple Sales

The Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB) FFL Master Query report was obtained for the three year period covering December 31, 2011 to December 31, 2014. The report revealed that the licensee had multiple sales involving firearms. It was determined that multiple handgun purchases occurred in the last twelve months involving handguns. According to e-trace Ed's pawn shop has submitted a total of multiple sales to ATF in total.



This would bring Ed's Pawn Shop's total number of multiple sales for the last twelve months to multiples involving handguns. The licensee was faxing their multiple sale reports to ATF. It could not be determined if the ATF Forms 3310.4 were not reported on the VCAB report as a result of error on ATF's part or the FFL's. Therefore, the licensee was not cited per DAD email dated September 18, 2014. Copies of these multiple sale forms were e-mailed to the National Tracing Center (NTC) (Ref. Exhibit 126). The licensee was educated on the process of submitting ATF Forms 3310.4 by email in order for a confirmation e-mail to be obtained from ATF NTC and attached to the ATF Form 4473. This would alleviate any problems with faxing the forms. The licensee will submit all future ATF Forms 3310.4 via e-mail. The licensee immediately completed unrecorded multiple handgun and submitted ATF Forms 3310.4 for the transactions. All corrected ATF Forms 3310.4's were submitted via e-mail to the NTC.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

The ATF Forms 4473 were reviewed by purchaser's names and addresses to determine if the purchasers were potential traffickers or straw purchasers or may be engaging in the business without an FFL. The ATF Forms 4473 were also reviewed for high crime firearms.







Under current policy, revocation of the Federal Firearms License would be justified for a licensee who has previously been the subject of a warning conference (WC) within the last five years and the current inspection warrants another WC for a repeated similar violation.

During this inspection, it was disclosed that Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc., failed to file multiple sales reports when legally required to in or more instances (instances). This is a repeat violation which would require another WC. Although, the licensee had other repeat violations during the current inspection, the violations would only rise to the level of a Warning Letter (W/L).

Mr. Turner is initiating a new Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) as a result of this violation. A new report will be generated from his computerized A&D record every night showing all firearms transferred in the last five days. This will allow the managers on duty to determine if more than one handgun was transferred to the same individual within the past five business days. This report will be in addition to their current "Pawn Master" computer program that "flags" at the time of transfer any firearm sale to the same individual in the last five days. Mr. Turner has stated that as an incentive to make sure his employees follow these SOP's, he may initiate an employee suspension or termination program to set an example for the consequences of committing this violation. Mr. Turner had all of his employees attend the closing conference with IOI (b)(6) of February 17, 2015. He stated that he thought his employees might understand the importance of accurately completing and timely submitting the required ATF forms if they heard it from an ATF IOI directly.

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. had a large volume of firearm transactions during the period of inspection ((b)(4) acquisitions, (b)(4) dispositions) There were 3,117 firearms in inventory and ATF Forms 4473 on file for the period of inspection. Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. had traces in the last 12 month. All of these traces were successful. The licensee has an extremely good relationship with local, State and Federal police officers and agencies. The licensee also has a good productive relationship with ATF criminal enforcement.

Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. has the Youth Handgun Safety Poster and the Youth Handgun Safety notices on hand. The licensee understands that a trigger lock must be provided to each transferee of a handgun if the handgun does not already have a trigger lock. No school zone was found to be within a 1000 foot vicinity of the licensee's business premises. No other findings were disclosed during the inspection.

12 - Closing Actions

On February 17, 2015 IOI (b)(6) held a closing conference with licensee, Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. to review and discuss the results of the inspection. (Because the conference occurred outside of the licensee's business hours in order for all employees to attend, IOI(b)(6) had Mr. Turner sign a "Consent to Inspect Outside Business Hours" document.) In attendance at the conference representing the licensee, Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc., were Mr. Turner, Ms. Patrick, (b) (6), and (b) (6) as well as eight employees (sales associates). The violations recorded on the ATF Form 5030.5, Report of Violations (attached) were discussed with all of the employees of Ed's Pawn Shop, Inc. that were in attendance. The Acknowledgement of Federal Firearm Regulations was reviewed with Mr. Turner. Emphasis was placed on the accurate and timely completion of the ATF Forms 3310.4. Mr. Turner signed the acknowledgement and stated that he had no further questions or topics he wanted to discuss (**Ref. Exhibit 130**). Mr. Turner stated that he will be adding more standard operating procedures so that the violations do not reoccur. Mr. Turner stated that all ATF Forms 3310.4's will be e-mailed to ATF in the future. The licensee stated that he had no further questions.

No reference material was provided to the licensee. IOI (b)(6) advised Mr. Turner that he could order the new 2014 Federal Firearms Regulations Reference Guide, ATF P 5300.4 from the ATF Distribution Center or Online. IOI (b)(6) provided Mr. Turner his business card in the event Mr. Turner or his employees have any questions.

Mr. Turner stated that it is usually caught when an inventory discrepancy report is printed out by the Pawn Master program. 


EXHIBIT 126- Copies of ATF F's 3310.4 that were found to be attached to the ATF F 4473 but not listed on the VCAB FFL History Query

The violations were discussed with you during the inspection. A copy of the Report of Violations, Form 5030.5, issued at the time of the inspection is enclosed.

You should be aware that any willful violations of the Gun Control Act may result in revocation of your Federal firearms license. As a result of the recently cited violations, it is important that we have a meeting with you to discuss the violations found. The conference will be held on August 10, 2015, at 1:00 pm, at 2600 Century Parkway NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30345. The agenda for the meeting will include a discussion of the reasons for the violations, a review of the legal requirements, and a discussion of steps to be taken by you to ensure future compliance. Although we do not believe it necessary, legal counsel may assist you at your own expense if you so choose. Please bring with you documentation verifying the corrective action you have taken.

The records you are required to maintain and the business operations you conduct are important to law enforcement in our continuing efforts to reduce violent crime and protect the public. It is essential that you comply with all Federal laws and regulations that govern your firearms business to aid in this effort to combat violent crime.

We will conduct a follow-up inspection in the future. Any violations, either repeat or otherwise, could be viewed as willful and may result in the revocation of your license.

This letter is a follow-up to the warning conference held with you on August 10, 2015 at the Atlanta Field Division's Office located at 2600 Century Parkway, NE Atlanta, Georgia 30345. During this conference, the violations cited during the inspection covering the period January 12, 2014 to January 12, 2015, and the necessary corrective action to prevent the violations from recurring were discussed.

You were given the opportunity to comment on the violations and what specific action you have taken to ensure that the violations will not recur.

Regarding Violations # 1 where you failed to record the disposition of firearms in the Acquisition & Disposition record book. You stated that the errors were due to the employees' failure to complete the recording of transfer of the gun in your computer system, after the end of a holding period to delay the sale of the gun. You stated that all of your employees have been reminded to click the computer button to reflect the transfer of a gun once the disposition of the firearm has taken place.

Regarding Violations # 2, 4, 5 and 7 where you failed to obtain complete and accurate information on the ATF Forms 4473 in accordance with the instructions on the form. You stated that there will be several reviews of the forms. In particular, two reviews of the forms will take place before the transfer of the gun from the store; a third review of the forms will take place at the end of the day, and a fourth review of the forms will take place on a monthly basis.

Regarding Violation #3 where you failed to obtain sufficient identification to properly verify the transferee's identity and residence address, as the identification document used to establish the place or residence of the transferee was not recorded on the ATF Form 4473 in instances. You stated that you make copies of all the identifying information and keep them filed away; however, you will ensure the employees are documenting the required information on the ATF Forms 4473 as required.

Regarding Violation # 6 where you failed to timely submit a report of multiple sale, ATF 3310.4, no later than the close of business on the day that the multiple sale or other disposition occurred in instances. You stated that your computer software has been assessed to detect a multiple sale and to ensure a form is generated and submitted via email to ATF by your employees.

The violations for which you were cited could adversely impact law enforcement's ability to reduce violent crime and protect the public. You are reminded that future violations, repeat or otherwise, could be viewed as willful and may result in the revocation of your license. You may anticipate further inspections to ensure your compliance.
