



1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On 01/31/2017, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) conducted an on-site full Type-07 Manufacturer of Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices compliance inspection of Viking Armament, Inc. Investigator (b)(6) interviewed Michael G. Neil, owner, who positively identified himself with his Colorado Driver's License number (b)(6). No other Federal, State, or local agencies were present during the inspection.

The inspection period covered 01/31/2016, through 01/30/2017. Advanced notification was not given prior to the inspection.

Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) queried Michael F. Neil and Michael G. Neil in the ATF NForce database in order to determine if they are currently a part of a criminal investigation, which did not return any hits.

Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) queried Michael F. Neil and Michael G. Neil in the FLS database in order to determine if they are associated with any other ATF licenses or permits that have received, or are currently receiving administrative action or revocation, which did not receive any hits.

Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) conducted an NCIC query on Michael F. Neil and Michael G. Neil. There was a hit on Michael F Neil for an incident in 2016. The severity of the incident was unknown. Investigator (b)(6) called the Henry County Sheriff's office in Tennessee. They stated they do not have Michael F Neil on record for any offenses.

Business Profile:

Mr. Neil currently possesses an ATF Type-07 Manufacturer of Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices Federal Firearms License (FFL). The business is located in an industrial area in Grand Junction, Colorado. Mr. Neil stated that he conducts transfers and sells firearms, including NFA firearms. Mr. Neil also manufactures firearms, mainly rifles. Mr. Neil does not participate in gun shows. Mr. Neil does not conduct Internet sales. Mr. Neil does not sell firearms on consignment. Mr. Neil does not deal in black powder. Mr. Neil's primary suppliers are (b) (4)

The licensee's Acquisition and Disposition (A&D) book indicates Mr. Neil acquired approximately (b)(4) firearms during the inspection period and disposed of approximately (b)(4) firearms during the inspection period.

Mr. Neil does not conduct any other business from the premises. Mr. Neil does not utilize any off-site storage locations. Mr. Neil does not hold any other ATF licenses or permits. Mr. Neil has held an ATF Type-07 FFL since 2014.

Ownership and Control:

Viking Armament, Inc., is a corporation owned by Michael Gene Neil and his Father Michael Floyd Neil. Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) queried the Colorado Secretary of State's website and found that Viking Armament, Inc., is in good standing [Exhibit 1].

Viking Armament, Inc., leases the storefront space from (b)(6) [Exhibit 2].

During the inspection, Mr. Neil did not request the addition or deletion of any Responsible Persons.

There have been no unreported changes in ownership. Hidden ownership was not suspected, and Mr. Neil did not make any statements that would suggest hidden ownership is present.

The licensee currently holds an ATF approved marking variance [Exhibit 3].

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

Based on a review of the licensee's A&D book, the licensee showed open entries of firearms. Investigator (b)(6) completed a 100 percent inventory. The licensee had open entries and 34 firearms in physical inventory, resulting in inventory discrepancies.

The licensee's A&D book was in the proper format and contained all the required information. However all entries were not timely and/or correctly made.

In instances, the licensee had a firearm that showed open in the A&D Book, but was not in physical inventory. The dispositions were reconciled with ATF Form 4473s. The licensee failed to timely log the firearm out of the A&D book [Exhibit 14 and Worksheet 1].

The licensee made all of the necessary corrections to the A&D book for the above cited instances.

There were no theft/loss reports submitted by Michael Neil during the inspection period. No theft/loss reports were submitted as a result of the inspection.

Investigator (b)(6) compared ATF Forms 4473 to the corresponding A&D book entries and did not disclose any discrepancies. Investigator (b)(6) did not discover any trafficking issues relating to the licensee's A&D book. Investigator (b)(6) did not discover any obliterated serial numbers or illegal firearms.

The licensee was cited for the following violation:

ROV #1 – 27 CFR 478.21(a) – Failure to obtain and/or furnish all information required on each ATF Form 4473 as indicated by the headings on the form and the instructions on or pertaining to it forms) [ATF Form 5030.5, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 8].

ROV #2 – 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1) – Failure to obtain a properly completed ATF Form 4473, Section A, prior to making an over-the-counter transfer of a firearm to a non-licensee (a forms) [see ATF Form 5030.5, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 9].

ROV #3 – 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(i) – Failure to verify the identity of the transferee and note on the ATF Form 4473 the type of identification used (a) forms) [ATF Form 5030.5, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 10].

ROV #4 – 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(iv) – Failure to comply with the requirements of Sec.478.102 and record on the ATF Form 4473 the date on which the licensee contacted CBI, as well as any responses or identification number provided by the system (Figure 1) [ATF Form 5030.5, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 11].

ROV #5 – 27 CFR 478.124(c)(5) – Failure to sign and/or date the ATF Form 4473 when the licensee does not know or have reasonable cause to believe that the transferee is disqualified by law from receiving the firearm (property forms) [ATF Form 5030.5, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 12].

Investigator (b)(6) suggested that Mr. Neil make contact with the customers in order to return to the premises to make the necessary corrections on a copy of the ATF Form 4473. Investigator (b)(6) suggested that Mr. Neil make the necessary corrections on the licensee's part of the ATF Form 4473 on a copy of the form.

6 - Multiple Sales

Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) obtained an FFL Master Query which showed that the licensee did not submit any multiple sales for the inspection period.

While reviewing the ATF Forms 4473, Investigator (b)(6) found the licensee had conducted a multiple sale and failed to complete a multiple sale or other disposition ATF Form 3310.4.

The licensee was cited for the following:

ROV #6 – 27 CFR 478.126(a) – Failure to prepare and submit a report of multiple sales or other disposition (ATF Form 3310.4) whenever the licensee sells or otherwise disposes or, two or pistols, or revolvers, or any combination of pistols or revolvers totaling two or more to an unlicensed person at one time or during any five consecutive business days form). [ATF Form 5030.5, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 13].

The licensee filled out a multiple sale form and submitted it to the appropriate agencies for the above cited instance.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

During the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) did not identify any suspicious or prohibited purchasers. No violations were discovered.

8 - Trace Activity

Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) obtained a FFL Master Query which did not show any traces to the licensee during the inspection period. Based on a review of the FFL Master Query, there were not any unsuccessful traces.

A secondary market analysis was not conducted as the licensee does not deal in used firearms.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The licensee does not import or collect firearms.

The licensee currently holds an active SOT stamp in order to deal NFA firearms. Prior to the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) obtained a National Firearm Registration and Transfer Record (NFRTR), which showed NFA firearms registered to the licensee [Exhibit 4]. Investigator (b)(6) compared the firearms listed on the NFRTR, the licensee had 18 NFA firearms at his shop.

Eleven of the NFA firearms were returned to the distributor due to warranty issues. Mr. Neil provided an email with the distributors contact information [Exhibit 5].

Name: Viking Armament, Inc.

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Investigator (b)(6) called (b) (4) and spoke to object to spoke to She confirmed all Eleven NFA firearms were returned to them due to warranty issues.

Twenty of the NFA firearms had not shipped from the distributor because Mr. Neil had not paid for them yet. Mr. Neil provided invoices for the items that had not shipped from the distributor. **[Exhibit 6]**.

Investigator (b)(6) found that the licensee is maintaining all of the required forms pertaining to the transfer of NFA firearms. No discrepancies were found.

Mr. Neil manufactured approximately 101 firearms during the inspection period. All firearms manufactured were rifles. Mr. Neil manufactures firearms on an order basis. There were approximately 25 receivers with Viking Armament's information on the premises. Investigator (b)(6) confirmed the receivers manufactured by the licensee were marked according to 27 CFR 478.92, 479.102, and ATF Rulings 2009-5, 2012-1, and 2013-3.

IOI (b)(6) verified that the licensee submitted ATF Form 5300.11, Annual Firearms Manufacturing and Exportation Report (AFMER) as called for under the regulations.

10 - Referrals

No referrals were generated as a result of the inspection.

11 - Other

During the inspection, Investigator (b)(6) obtained an email address for Mr. Neil: Mike@vikingarmament.com

12 - Closing Actions

On 02/01/2017, Investigator (b)(6) held a closing conference with Mr. Neil. Investigator (b)(6) issued the licensee a Report of Violations (ROV) and reviewed each violation and corrective action thoroughly with Mr. Neil, and afforded him the opportunity to ask questions. Investigator (b)(6) asked Mr. Neil to sign the ROV and he was provided a copy for the licensee's records.

Investigator (b)(6) reviewed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations with Mr. Neil and afforded him the opportunity to ask questions. Investigator (b)(6) asked Mr. Neil to sign the acknowledgement and he was provided a copy for the licensee's records [Exhibit 7].

Corrective Action: The licensee will immediately correct the disposition entries that are missing information. The licensee will immediately record the disposition information for the four firearms open in the A & D book that are not in physical inventory.
