1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

Ms. Darsi Andrea Miller, President/CEO, and Ms. Ardis E. Gant, Senior Vice President, of LC Action Police Supply Ltd., were identified by their respective California Driver Licenses (b)(6), expires 09/16/17 & (b)(6), expires 01/20/17). They were both interviewed at the licensed premises by Industry Operations Investigators (b)(6) and (b)(6) without other agency participation, though the California Department of Justice did happen to arrive later the same day to commence an independent inspection of the licensee. The inspection period was from 09/01/14 – 08/23/15, commencing on 08/24/15 without advance notice. The assignment was issued to conduct a Disposition Emphasis Compliance Inspection of this Type 01 – Dealer in Firearms Licensee and was accomplished in accordance with the Industry Operations Manual.

Business Profile:

The licensee is a high volume, wholesale/retail dealer of firearms and accessories to law enforcement agencies and personnel, which are conducted at a centralized location in San Jose. Their clientele base is far-flung as (b)(4)

They advertise through a website which results in internet sales. During the last 12 months they acquired (b)(4) and disposed of (b)(4) firearms. Both new and used firearms are obtained and sold, with a (b)(4), and of those (b)(4) being handguns. Their primary suppliers are (b)(4). They do not participate at gun shows. No other businesses are conducted at the licensed premises nor is there involvement with outside business ventures. The license, held since 02/28/97, is appropriate for the activities conducted and no other ATF Licenses or Permits are required. All State and local licenses/permit are current. Off-site storage locations are not utilized.

Ownership and Control:

The licensee is a California Limited Corporation, with Mesdames Miller and Gant as the only officers/stockholders. Since the last inspection a change had occurred within the corporation with the passing of Mr. John J. Ralph, Financial Partner, which was reported to ATF on 04/28/14. His passing did not affect the ownership and/or control of the corporate entity nor did it reveal any hidden ownership. No other individuals are involved with or have vested interest in the

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

Recently hired Special Agent (b)(6) joined IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) with the inventory audit and A&D Record Books review which found 987 firearms on-hand, but (b)(3) - 112 P.01 open book entries. A reconciliation was conducted which revealed (b)(3) - 11 dispositions (1.4%) that had not been recorded. These missing entries were completed during the inspection. No thefts or losses were submitted during the inspection period. The A&D Record Books were found to be in the proper format, with all information being accurate, and most entries timely made, except as previously noted. No firearms were traced through the licensee's records. No trafficking issues were identified, or firearms found with obliterated serial numbers, nor illegally obtained firearms. The licensee's Standard Operating Procedures were reviewed and discussed regarding the missing disposition entries. It was found that the majority of the missing entries (72%) were multi-firearm sales made to law enforcement agencies by way of purchase orders. It was suggested that all purchase orders completed and filed each month be reviewed at the start of the following month to verify that all of the firearms sold were closed in the A&D Record Books. As to the ATF Forms 4473, they also are filed monthly, so it was suggested that a final review be made to verify that each form was also closed in the record books. The licensee was cited and issued a Report of Violations, ATF EF 5030.5, for Repeat Violations of 27 CFR 478.125(e).

5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) conducted a review of the ATF Forms 4473 executed and on-file. An examination made for completeness and accuracy of (b)(3) - 112 P.01 forms disclosed (b)(3) - 1 forms (0.3%) having one or more discrepancies. Completed forms are filed by the transfer date and denied/cancelled forms are filed separately. All waiting period transfer exemption sales of official duty firearms to law enforcement personnel were found properly documented and recorded. No trafficking issues were discovered. Verification was also made of 871 Gun Audit Log entries. The licensee's Standard Operating Procedures were discussed and found needing more reviews by additional personnel in order to verify that all ATF Forms 4473 are complete and accurate. The licensee was cited and issued a Report of Violations, ATF EF 5030.5, for Repeat Violations of 27 CFR 478.21(a); .124(c)(1); .124(c)(3)(iv); & .124(c)(5).

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6 – Multiple Sales

A request of the Violent Crime Analysis Branch for a Firearms Trace History (FTH) Report disclosed that the licensee was associated with (b)(3) - 11 multiple sale transactions involving (b)(3) - 11 firearms. The review of ATF Forms 4473 verified the preparation and submission of Multiple Sales of Handgun Reports and Multiple Sales of Certain Rifle Reports. The review did reveal (b)(3) - 112 P multiple handgun sales and (b)(3) - 11 multiple certain rifle sales involving (b)(3) - 11 firearms that were not recorded or reported. These missing reports were completed and submitted during the inspection. It was suggested to the licensee that an "M" be placed atop the ATF Form 4473 to identify to multiple sales to reviewers. The licensee was cited and issued a Report of Violations, ATF EF 5030.5, for violations of 27 CFR 478.126a and 18 USC 923(g)(5)(A).

7 – Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

No suspicious/prohibited purchasers were found, no trafficking revealed, no straw purchasing noted, or referrals made as a result of the inspection

8 – Trace Activity

The FTH Report also disclosed that the licensee was associated with (b)(3) - firearm trace requests, including (b)(3) - 11 duplicates, (b)(3) - not completed to an individual purchaser, and (b)(3) - 11 interstate Theft Consignee Report involving (b)(3) - firearms, all of which were recovered. A secondary market analysis was not conducted.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The licensee does not import, collect, or manufacturer, but does deal in NFA Weapons. The licensee purchases NFA Weapons that are dropped-shipped by the manufacturer to purchasing law enforcement agencies, but never to individuals. (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103

The licensee displays and makes available the Youth Handgun Safety Act poster and brochure, as well as having secure gun storage and safety devices on-hand.

12 - Closing Actions

A closing conference was held on 09/11/15 between Mesdames Miller & Gant and IOI (b)(6) regarding the results of the inspection, the various discrepancies found, and the corrective actions to be taken. Regarding the on-hand inventory, they were instructed to conduct multiple reviews to verify that all dispositions are timely recorded. As to the ATF Forms 4473, they were instructed to conduct thorough multiple reviews of all forms to reduce or eliminate the discrepancies found and were encouraged to utilize the State-mandated, 10-day waiting period for all firearm transfers in order to scrutinize each and every form for completeness and accuracy, and to add additional reviewers.

At the conclusion of the conference, Mesdames Miller and Gant were provided with a current list of TF addresses/telephone numbers. The Acknowledgement of Federal Firearm Regulations pertaining to the Federal Firearms Reference Guide was also given to them. The acknowledgement and guide were reviewed and discussed, during which informational handouts and various form were provided, as well as questions answered. Ms. Miller then signed and dated the acknowledgement and as given a copy for their information, records, and future reference.

Nature of Violation: Forms Prescribed – failure to furnish all of the information called for in each form. A review of the ATF Forms 4473 executed during the period of inspection disclosed that the licensee failed to ensure that (b)(3) - 19 forms were properly prepared:

Item #11a (Are you the actual transferee/buyer of the firearm(s) listed on this form?) – (b)(3) - 19 “No” answer; Item #18 (Type of firearm(s) to be transferred) – (b)(3) - 19 incorrect; & Item #25 (Recertification Date) – (b)(3) - 12 incorrect.

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Licensee's Response: Ms. Miller stated that the oversight and errors were the result of one person having to do too much, but that she will require a second reviewer in order to have more complete and thorough reviews of forms.

Corrective Action: The licensee was instructed to review every ATF Form 4473 for completeness and accuracy, to conduct thorough multiple reviews of all forms, and to have additions and/or corrections made prior to the transfer of firearms. After the transfer, any additions and/or corrections must be made on a copy of the form and attached to the original.

Nature of Violation: Firearms Transaction Record – failure to secure a properly completed form. A review of the ATF Forms 4473 executed during the period of inspection disclosed that the licensee did not ensure that purchasers properly prepared (b)(3)-12473 forms:

Item #11j (Prohibitive Question asking, “Have you ever renounced your United States citizenship?”) – (b)(3)-11j unanswered; Item #13 (What is your State of residence?) – (b)(3)-13 incorrect; & Item #17 (Certification Date) – (b)(3)-17 incorrect.

Licensee's Response: Ms. Miller could not explain why these errors were not caught during reviews, especially the one dealing with a possible prohibitive question.

Corrective Action: The licensee was once again instructed to review every ATF Form 4473 for completeness and accuracy, to conduct thorough multiple reviews of all forms, and to have additions and/or corrections made prior to the transfer of firearms. After the transfer, any additions and/or corrections must be made on a copy of the form and attached to the original.

Licensee's Response: Ms. Miller could not explain why the errors and omissions were not caught either initially or when double checked.

Corrective Action: The licensee was once more instructed to review every ATF Form 4473 for completeness and accuracy, to conduct thorough multiple reviews of all forms, and to have additions and/or corrections made prior to the transfer of firearms. After the transfer, any additions and/or corrections must be made on a copy of the form and attached to the original.

After the transfer, any additions and/or corrections must be made on a copy of the form and attached to the original.
