#### 1 - Introduction

# **Inspection Profile:**

On November 30, 2016 Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) travelled to the licensed premises and met in person with Michael Budzien (CA DL #(b)(6)) concerning a Type 01 (Dealer) FFL Compliance Inspection for West Coast Survival Arms. The scope of this inspection was a full-scope compliance inspection to ensure compliance with Federal firearms laws and regulations. This inspection covered the licensee's entire A&D Record and ATF Fs 4473 from December 1, 2015 through November 30, 2016.

Michael Budzien is the owner and sole proprietor of this business, which he operates under the registered trade name of *West Coast Survival Arms*, and is the only Responsible Person currently associated with this FFL.

The licensee was given advance notice of this inspection following an unsuccessful attempt to initiate an unannounced inspection. Mr. Budzien operates this business part time, and holds additional employment. The on-site inspection ended with a closing conference and the issuance of a **Report of Violations** on January 4, 2017.

N-Force and FLS queries for this FFL were conducted prior to the initiation of this inspection, and met with negative results for any special attention flags or open investigations.

No additional Federal, State or local agencies were involved in this inspection.

#### **Business Profile:**

West Coast Survival Arms is a home-based business, located in a residential area of Chula Vista, California. The licensee engages in the sale of new and used firearms to the general public, and generally operates by appointment only. The licensee also conducts occasional consignment sales and private-party transfers.

There were (137) firearms in the licensee's inventory at the time of inspection. During the 12 months prior to this inspection the licensee has acquired approximately ((b)(4)) firearms and disposed of approximately ((b)(4)).

The licensee's inventory at the time of inspection consisted of handguns, long guns and () receivers. The licensee's inventory was comprised of approximately handguns for sale and was used firearms, primarily private-party transfers.

Mr. Budzien stated that he has yet to operate at any gun shows, and does not utilize any off-site storage.

West Coast Survival Arms acquires firearms for sale from various distributors, including (b)(4) among others.

The licensee provided copies of his California State Board of Equalization Seller's Permit (**Exhibit 1**- Seller's Permit), City of Chula Vista Business License #070077 (**Exhibit 2**- City Business License) and City of Chula Vista Local Firearms Dealer License #4503 (**Exhibit 3**- Local Firearms Dealer License).

Mr. Budzien stated that no additional businesses are operated from the licensed premises, and that he holds no additional ATF licenses. Mr. Budzien further stated that he holds additional employment with *Cox Cable*, installing cable, internet and video equipment.

Mr. Budzien stated that he maintains his own website for this business at <a href="https://www.westcoastsurvivalarms.com">www.westcoastsurvivalarms.com</a>, and conducts some transfers through that site, along with <a href="https://www.gunbroker.com">www.gunbroker.com</a>.

Michael Budzien has held this FFL since January 4, 2012, and stated that he has not been involved with any other ATF licenses.

All firearms sold by Mr. Budzien are sold as retail sales, and most transactions involving used firearms are FFL transfers from other states or private-party transfers.

## **Ownership and Control:**

Michael Budzien operates West Coast Survival Arms as a sole proprietor, and remains the only Responsible Person for this FFL. A query with San Diego County showed West Coast Survival Arms to be a registered fictitious business name belonging to Mr. Budzien (Exhibit 4- Fictitious Business Name Registration Search Results). No unreported changes in control or indicators of hidden ownership were identified during this inspection. No individuals were identified as needing to be added as Responsible Persons.

No changes were identified as required to the Federal Licensing System (FLS) database.

#### Variance:

West Coast Survival Arms currently holds no approved ATF variances. No potential needs for variances were identified during this inspection.



these results to the licensee's A&D Record, which is maintained in written format. The licensee's A&D Record was in the proper format and contained fields for all required information. There were (137) total firearms on hand, which corresponded to the licensee's A&D Records, containing a total of open entries.

The following discrepancies pertaining to the licensee's A&D Record were discovered and cited on a **Report of Violations**:



Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of 27 CFR 478.125(e) for instances of failure by a licensed dealer to accurately or timely record the acquisition or disposition of a firearm.

Additional information on this violation can be found on **Worksheet 1**. Sample copies of the A&D Record pages containing these discrepancies were obtained (**Exhibit 5**-A&D Record Sample Pages Pertaining to Violation 1).

No theft or loss reports were submitted by the licensee during this inspection period, and none were submitted as a result of this inspection.

No trafficking issues, obliterated serial numbers or illegal firearms were discovered during this inspection.

IOI(b)(6) traced (1) firearms through the licensee's required records from acquisition through disposition. This process entailed randomly selecting firearms from the licensee's A&D Record and comparing those entries to their corresponding ATF Fs 4473, and randomly selecting A&D Record entries for comparison to their corresponding ATF Fs 4473. No discrepancies were discovered as a result of this process.

IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) discussed with Michael Budzien his standard operating procedures relevant to his A&D Record and inventory practices. Mr. Budzien stated that all firearms acquisitions were recorded either the day of receipt or the following day, adding that he always recorded firearm dispositions at the time of transfer. Mr. Budzien added that, although he did not have a system for conducting regular inventories, he reviewed the A&D Record daily for accuracy and completeness. IOI (b)(6) observed that some acquisition dates in the licensee's A&D Record seemed to be out of order. IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) discussed this discrepancy with Mr. Budzien, and recommended closer scrutiny.

## 5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

The licensee had ATF Fs 4473 on file for this inspection period, all of which were examined by either IOI (b)(6) or IOI (b)(6).

The following discrepancies pertaining to the licensee's ATF Fs 4473 were discovered and cited on a **Report of Violations**:

On ATF Fs 4473 (b)(3) Pub law 112-55 125 Stat. 552 the purchaser incompletely or inaccurately completed Item 1 (*Transferee's Full Name*). These errors included leaving blank the *Middle Name* and providing only an initial in *Middle Name* when the purchaser was determined to have a full middle name.

- ) the purchaser left blank Items 11b (Are you under On (a) ATF F 4473 ( indictment or information in any court for a felony, or any other crime, for which the judge could imprison you for more than one year?), 11c (Have you ever been convicted in any court of a felony, or any other crime, for which the judge could have imprisoned you for more than one year, even if you received a shorter sentence including probation?), 11d (Are you a fugitive from justice?), 11e (Are you an unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana or any depressant, stimulant, narcotic drug, or any other controlled substance?), 11f (Have you ever been adjudicated mentally defective OR have you ever been committed to a mental institution?), 11g (Have you ever been discharged from the Armed Forces under dishonorable conditions?), 11h (Are you subject to a court order restraining you from harassing, stalking, or threatening your child or an intimate partner or child of such partner?), 11i (Have you ever been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence?), 11j (Have you ever renounced your United States citizenship?) and 11k (Are you an alien illegally in the United States?). On ( additional ATF F 4473 ( On (a) additional ATF F 4473 ) the purchaser left blank Item 11j. On additional ATF F 4473 ( ) the purchaser left blank Item 11k.
- On (N) ATF Fs 4473 (N) ATF Fs 4473 (N) The purchaser incompletely or inaccurately completed Item 14 (What is your country of citizenship?), including leaving blank Item 14 and providing an incorrect response of "Permanent Resident".
- On ( ) ATF F 4473 ( ) the purchaser left blank Item 15 (*If you are not a citizen of the United States, what is your U.S.-Issued alien number or admission number?*) after having indicated that they were not a Unites States citizen.
- On (a) ATF Fs 4473 (b)(3) Pub law 112-55 125 Stat. 552) the purchaser left blank Item 17 (Certification Date).

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1) for failure to require purchasers to properly complete the required information on an ATF F 4473 prior to the over-the-counter transfer of a firearm, as per the instructions and headings on the form.

Sample copies of the above listed ATF Fs 4473 were obtained (**Exhibit 6-** Sample Copies of ATF Fs 4473 Pertaining to Violation 2).

On ATF Fs 4473 (b)(3) Pub law 112-55 125 Stat. 552 the purchaser marked "No" in response to Item 11a (*Are you the actual transferee/buyer of the firearm(s) listed on this form?*) and the licensee proceeded to transfer the firearm to the individual. On additional ATF F 4473 (b) the purchaser left blank Item 11a.

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of **27 CFR 478.21(a)** for failure to require purchasers to properly complete the required information on an ATF F 4473 prior to the over-the-counter transfer of a firearm, as per the instructions and headings on the form, as well as making over-the-counter transfers of firearms to individuals who indicated on ATF Fs 4473 that they were not the actual transferees or buyers of the firearms being transferred.

On (1) ATF F 4473 (Identification) the licensee left blank the Expiration Date of Identification in Item 20 (Identification).

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(i) for failure to properly and accurately furnish all required information on an ATF F 4473, as per the instructions and headings on the form.

A copy of the above ATF F 4473 was obtained (**Exhibit 8-** Copy of ATF F 4473 Pertaining to Violation 4).

#### **Section C-**

On (a) ATF F 4473 (a) the purchaser left blank Item 25 (*Recertification Date*). On (b) additional ATF F 4473 (a) an incorrect date had been provided in Item 25.

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of **27 CFR 478.21(a)** for failure to require purchasers to properly complete the required information on an ATF F 4473 prior to the over-the-counter transfer of a firearm, as per the instructions and headings on the form.

A copy of the above ATF F 4473 was obtained (**Exhibit 7-** Sample Copies of ATF Fs 4473 Pertaining to Violation 3).

#### Section D-

On (a) ATF Fs 4473 (b) Pub law 112-55-125 Stat. 552) the licensee left blank Item 26 (Manufacturer and/or Importer).

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(4) for failure to properly and accurately furnish all required information on an ATF F 4473, as required per the instructions and headings on the form.

Copies of the above listed ATF Fs 4473 were obtained (**Exhibit 9-** Sample Copies of ATF Fs 4473 Pertaining to Violation 5).

On (a) ATF F 4473 (b) the licensee left blank Item 33 (*Transferor's/Seller's Name*).

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of **27 CFR 478.21(a)** for failure to properly and accurately furnish all required information on an ATF F 4473, as required per the instructions and headings on the form.

Sample copies of the above listed ATF Fs 4473 were obtained (**Exhibit 7-** Sample Copies of ATF Fs 4473 Pertaining to Violation 3).

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of 27 CFR 478.124(c)(5) for failure to properly and accurately furnish all required information on an ATF F 4473, as required per the instructions and headings on the form.

There were ( ) DROS transaction numbers with proceed responses reported on the licensees DROS Audit Log for this inspection period. A sample consisting of all transactions from the licensee's busiest month, June 2016, was selected for verification. All ( ) DROS transaction numbers within this period were verified as accurately appearing on the licensee's ATF Fs 4473.

There were ( ) DROS transaction numbers with denied responses reported on the licensee's DROS Audit Log since the issuance of this FFL. All ( ) of these DROS transaction numbers were verified as accurately appearing on the licensee's ATF Fs 4473 for denied transactions.

IOI(b)(6) and IOI(b)(6) noted that the licensee appropriately maintains ATF Fs 4473 sequentially by transaction number, with DROS denials and voided forms maintained separately.

No law enforcement transfers were found to have been conducted by the licensee during this inspection period. Mr. Budzien stated that he is aware of the proper way to conduct law enforcement transfers.

The licensee conducts and records licensee-to-licensee transfers appropriately.

Multiple weaknesses pertaining to the licensee's dispositions and ATF F 4473 completion were identified and discussed with Mr. Budzien during this inspection. Mr. Budzien stated that he did not have any specific measures in place to check ATF Fs 4473 for accuracy and completeness, instead sporadically reviewing forms when time allowed. Mr. Budzien added that he often became distracted when assisting multiple customers at once, as he was the only person involved with this business. Throughout this compliance inspection, particularly during the closing conference, IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) discussed with Mr. Budzien the importance of ensuring the accurate completion of ATF Fs 4473 for all transfers to non-licensees and offered suggestions to the licensee on how to do so. The measures suggested to Mr. Budzien by IOI (b)(6) and IOI (b)(6) included checking forms for accuracy and completeness once at the

time of completion by the purchaser, once during the ten-day waiting period, and once more at the time of transfer or when logging the firearm disposition.

#### 6 - Multiple Sales

Queries in *e-Trace*, combined with a review of the VCAB Report, showed *West Coast Survival Arms* as having reported no multiple sales of handguns and no multiple sale of certain rifles during this inspection period. The following discrepancies pertaining to unreported multiple sales were discovered and cited on a **Report of Violations**:

Reporting multiple sales or other disposition of pistols and revolvers- On instances and involving ( ) total firearms, the licensee failed to file the appropriate reports of multiple sales or disposition when transferring two or more handguns to an unlicensed person at the same time or within five consecutive business days.



In each of these instances, the licensee failed to submit the required Report of Multiple Sale.

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of **27 CFR 478.126a** for failure to submit an ATF F 3310.4 (*Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers*) when disposing of multiple handguns to an unlicensed individual within five consecutive business days.

Copies of all above listed ATF Fs 4473 were obtained. Sample copies are included with this report (**Exhibit 11**- Sample Copies of ATF Fs 4473 Pertaining to Violation 7).

Licensing- On instances and involving (in) total firearms, the licensee failed to file the appropriate reports of multiple sales or disposition when transferring two or more semi-automatic rifles larger than .22 caliber with the ability to accept a detachable magazine to the same unlicensed person at the same time or within five consecutive business days.

# (b)(3) Pub law 112-55 125 Stat. 552

In each of these instances, the licensee failed to submit the required Report of Multiple Sale, as he is required to do per Demand Letter 3.

Accordingly, the licensee was cited in violation of **Title 18 USC 923(g)(5)(A)** for failure to submit an ATF F 3310.12 (*Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Certain Rifles*) when disposing of multiple rifles meeting the requisite characteristics outlined in Demand Letter 3 to an unlicensed individual within five consecutive business days.

# 7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

No suspicious or prohibited purchasers were identified as a result of this inspection.

#### 8 - Trace Activity

A records search was conducted by the ATF Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB) for trace activity and showed *West Coast Survival Arms* as having been associated with successfully completed firearm trace request during this inspection period. The VCAB Report further indicated that the licensee has no unresolved or pending traces.

#### 9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

West Coast Survival Arms does not maintain an SOT or deal in NFA items, nor do they engage in any importer, collector or manufacturer activities. No unauthorized NFA firearms, importations or manufacturing activity were discovered as a result of this inspection.

#### 10 - Referrals

No referrals were generated as a result of this inspection.

## 11 - Other

Information on the Arms Export Control Act relating to the import and export of firearms, firearms parts, ammunition and ammunition components was provided to Michael Budzien, and he stated he understood.

IOI (b)(6) noted that the licensee's FFL and Youth Handgun Safety Act poster were properly displayed.

12 - Closing Actions

IOI(b)(6) and IOI(b)(6) held a closing conference with the licensee on January 4, 2017. IOI(b)(6) reviewed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations (Exhibit 13- Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations) with Michael Budzien, who signed the acknowledgement and stated that he understood. Additional statements made by Mr. Budzien pertaining to the violations cited are listed below in Narrative Section 13 (Violations).

Mr. Budzien stated that he had not attended any recent ATF-held seminars for Federal Firearms Licensees.

and mistakenly logging a firearm out (\*\*) when it remained in the licensee's inventory.

Mr. Budzien stated that he understood the nature of this violation as well as the corrective action, adding that he will review the A&D Record more regularly and more closely.



The licensee shall not transfer a firearm to an individual who fails to properly and accurately complete all required information on an ATF F 4473.

Additionally, the licensee shall amend copies of all above listed ATF Fs 4473 containing violations in Section D. These copies are to be attached to the original forms.

instances of failure by a licensed dealer to properly report a multiple handgun sale when transferring two or more handguns to an unlicensed individual at the same time or within five consecutive business days by filing an ATF F 3310.4 (*Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers*).



# (b)(3) Pub law 112-55 125 Stat. 552

In each of these instances, the licensee failed to submit the required Report of Multiple Sale.

#### **Licensee Response:**

Mr. Budzien stated that he understood the nature of this violation as well as the corrective action. Mr. Budzien further stated that he had been under the misconception that multiple handgun reports were required only for transactions involving five or more handguns.

IOI(b)(6) provided Mr. Budzien with a handout showing the e-mail address to which he could submit these forms electronically, and he stated he understood.

#### **Corrective Action:**

The licensee shall immediately complete and submit an ATF F 3310.4 (*Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers*) for each of these unreported multiple sale transactions. In all future instances when transferring two or more handguns to an unlicensed person within five consecutive business days, the licensee shall submit an ATF F 3310.4 not later than the close of business on the day that the multiple sale or other disposition occurs.

# 8. Title 18 USC 923(g)(5)(A) Licensing

#### Nature of Violation:

instances of failure by a licensed dealer to properly report a multiple sale of certain rifles when transferring two or more semi-automatic rifles larger than .22 caliber with the ability to accept a detachable magazine to an unlicensed person at the same time or within five consecutive business days by filing an ATF F 3310.12 (Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Certain Rifles).

# (b)(3) Pub law 112-55 125 Stat. 552

In each of these instances, the licensee failed to submit the required Report of Multiple Sale, as he is required to do per Demand Letter 3.

#### Licensee Response:

Mr. Budzien stated that he understood the nature of this violation as well as the corrective action. Mr. Budzien further stated that he had been under the misconception

that multiple sale reports were required only for transactions involving five or more firearms meeting the requirements.

IOI(b)(6) provided Mr. Budzien with a handout showing the e-mail address to which he could submit these forms electronically, and he stated he understood.

#### **Corrective Action:**

The licensee shall immediately complete and submit an ATF F 3310.12 (*Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Certain Rifles*) for each of these unreported multiple sale transactions. In all future instances when transferring two or more rifles meeting the requisite characteristics set forth in Demand Letter 3, the licensee shall submit an ATF F 3310.12 not later than the close of business on the day that the multiple sale or other disposition occurs.
