All violations were fully explained to you by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) Industry Operations Investigator. 1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On May 15, 2017, Industry Operations Investigators (b)(6)

(b)(6) initiated a firearms recall compliance inspection at the licensee's above-listed premises. President Brad Wendt, employees (b)(6) and (b)(6) were identified, interviewed and assisted with the inspection. On the afternoon of May 11, 2017, the licensee was contacted to ensure responsible person availability. The inspection period was set from May 1, 2016 to May 14, 2017.

Business Profile:

The licensee operates a commercial gun shop in rural Cass County, Iowa. The licensee sells new and used firearms and firearms accessories. The licensee acquired (b)(4) firearms and disposed of (b)(4) firearms in the last twelve months. All firearms are retail. Used firearms account for less than percent of the licensee's business. No business is conducted at gun shows. A lumberyard is also at the licensed premise. One other ATF license held by the licensee in Adair, Iowa (5-42-01-01902). The licensee conducts business as a transfer dealer for firearms purchased over the internet through www.gunbroker.com, www.bwoutfitters.com and as a regional distributor for (b)(4)

Ownership and Control:

This license is incorporated. No changes in ownership discovered and no indications of hidden ownership encountered. No changes in RPs – all are correctly listed in FLS.

Variance:

The licensee does not currently possess any variances.

3 - Inspection History

A review of the Area Office File reveals the following inspection history:

Inspection Results: Viols WC with WL and Recall **Cited Violations:**

- 1. 27 CFR 478.125(e) Failure to accurately record required information in the A&D Book. The licensee had incorrectly recorded the manufacturer/importer in instances and incorrectly recorded the S/N in four (4) instances.
- 2. 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(i) Failure to record identification document that confirms current residence address. The licensee failed to completely record identification documentation in approximately (b)(3)-112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552.
- 3. 27 CFR 478.131(a)(2) Failure to correctly and completely record information on firearms transactions not subject to NICS check.

 The licensee failed to accurately record information recorded on the state firearms purchase permit in instances.
- 4. 27 CFR 478.102(a) Failure to complete a background check on firearms sales or deliveries. The licensee failed to complete a background check in instance. The licensee accepted a non-qualifying state peace officer permit in instances.
- 5. 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1) Failure to collect complete and accurate information on ATF F 4473. The licensee failed to obtain the correct information from the transferee in individuals who stated they were prohibited at the time of transfer but were not.
- 6. 27 CFR 478.21(a) Failure to completely and accurately complete ATF F. 4473. In instances the licensee failed to accurately record information required on the ATF F 4473 including type of firearm in Item 18 and number of firearms involved in the transaction in Item 30a.
- 7. 27 CFR 478.124(c)(4) Failure to identify the firearm transferred. In instances the licensee failed to record the Manufacturer/Importer, Model, Serial Number, Type and Caliber/Gauge.
- 8. 27 CFR 124(c)(5) Failure to record the correct or complete firearms transfer date. In complete firearm transfer date.
- 9. 27 CFR 478.129(b) Failure to ATF F 4473s in which a sale or transfer did not take place separately from transactions in which sales and deliveries took place. In approximately instances, the licensee failed to separately file 4473s in which a delivery or transfer did not take place.
- 10. 27 CFR 478.100(a)(1) Conducting business away from licensed premises. In instance, the licensee completed a 4473 away from the premises which was not a qualifying event.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

A sampling inventory of 741 firearms was conducted on May 15, 2017. See **Exhibit 1** for DIO approval of sampling of 700. At the time of inspection, the licensee had 3,100 firearms in inventory. There were open entries in the Acquisition and Disposition record. No theft loss forms were completed during the inspection period nor as a result of this inspection.

The A&D record is in the proper format as the licensee maintains a computerized record. The licensee provided Inv. (b)(6) with a thumb drive for a look at their current A&D record. The thumb See Exhibit 2 for example pages. Entries into the A&D record appear to be timely. No firearms with obliterated serial numbers were located in inventory. The licensee is not suspected of trafficking in firearms.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

At the time of inspection, ATF Forms 4473 were completed over the previous twelve (12) months. Forms are filed by transferor transaction serial number. Forms on file for the past year were reviewed. Discrepancies (discussed below) are noted on **Worksheet 2** and the **Report of Violations**. No transfers to law enforcement agencies conducted. Transfers to other licensees appear to be properly conducted.

The FFL Audit Log (submitted as **Exhibit 3**) shows 18 NICS checks performed by the licensee from March 16, 2017 to May 10, 2017. Five (5) NTNs were verified with the Audit Log. No discrepancies discovered.

In instance, the licensee transferred a long gun to an Illinois resident and did not wait twenty-four hours as required by Illinois State Law Violation 1, Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 4.

In instance, the licensee failed to obtain an accurate certification date by the buyer in Item 15 on the Form 4473 (C), Worksheet 2, and Exhibit 4.

In the majority of transfers, purchasers possess a NICS exemption document. The licensee was initially cited for failing to record the date of issuance of a NICS exemption document (), yet during the on-site review of the Report of Violations, the licensee provided a copy of the buyer's permit. A date of issuance is not given on the permit. Inv. (b)(6) removed this violation from the Report of Violations. See Exhibit 5. The licensee was instructed to begin attaching NICS exemption documents/permits to applicable Forms 4473 rather than maintaining a separate box of permits.

6 - Multiple Sales

Per the VCAB Report (submitted as **Exhibit 6**), the licensee has multiple sale transaction involving firearms. No unreported multiple sales discovered during the inspection.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

A total of two (2) individuals selected as suspicious purchasers. These individuals and the firearms they purchased queried through NCIC/NLETS and E-Trace. No hits on either the firearms or the individuals.

8 - Trace Activity

Per the VCAB Report (submitted as **Exhibit 6**), firearms has been traced to the licensee over the past 12 months. The licensee was able to provide disposition information to all traces.

Over the past twelve months, the licensee acquired approximately used firearms and disposed of bi(1) used firearms.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The licensee does not conduct NFA, importer, collector or manufacturer operations.

10 - Referrals

11 - Other

The Youth Handgun Safety Act notice was posted and visible at the premises. The pamphlets were available on the front counter. The licensee provides secure gun storage or a safety device for the transfer of all handguns to non-licensees.

12 - Closing Actions

On June 15, 2017 Inv. (b)(6) conducted a closing conference with the licensee. President Brad Wendt and employee (b)(6) were present. The Report of Violations was reviewed with the second violation being rescinded. Federal firearms regulations were reviewed and a signed acknowledgment has been inserted into NSPECT and is submitted as **Exhibit 10**.

13 - Violations

1. **27 CFR 478.99(b)**

<u>Nature of Violation:</u> Sale or transfer of a firearm to any person in any State where the purchase is in violation of any State law.

In instance, the licensee transferred a long gun to an Illinois resident and did not wait twenty-four hours as required by Illinois State Law.

<u>Licensee's Response:</u> Mr. Brad Wendt stated the licensee has ceased over-the-counter sales to Illinois residents.

<u>Corrective Action:</u> For future transactions, ensure transfers to out of state customers are in compliance with State and Local law.

2. **27 CFR 478.124(c)(1)**

Repeat Violation from November 4, 2014

<u>Nature of Violation:</u> Failure to obtain an accurate certification date by the transferee/buyer.

In instance, the licensee failed to obtain an accurate certification date by the buyer in Item 15 on the Form 4473 (1)(8) 11/2 PUBLIC LAW 55 12/2 STATE 502, (1)(6)

<u>Licensee's Response:</u> Mr. Wendt stated, "That will happen." He then acknowledged the violation.

<u>Corrective Action:</u> For future transactions, ensure the buyer accurately provides a certification date on the Form 4473.
