All violations were fully explained to you or your designated responsible person by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) Industry Operations Investigator(s). #### 1 - Introduction

#### Inspection Profile:

On November 15, 2016, Industry Operations Investigators (b)(6) (b)(6) and (b)(6) initiated a firearms compliance inspection at the licensee's above-listed premises. Owner Ryzard "Richard" Hofman (IADL (b)(6), exp. 03/10/24) and his wife Elwira Hofman (IADL (b)(6), exp. 05/15/24) were identified, interviewed and assisted with the inspection. On the afternoon of November 14, 2016, the licensee was contacted to ensure responsible person availability. The inspection period was set from November 1, 2015 to present. This inspection was requested by ATF Headquarters due to the licensee being in the Top 100 in the country for Trace Requests.

#### **Business Profile:**

The licensee operates a commercial gun shop in urban Polk County, Iowa. The licensee sells new and used firearms, firearms accessories and suppressors. The licensee acquired approximately (b)(4) firearms and disposed of (b)(4) firearms in the last twelve months. All firearms are retail. Used firearms account for approximately 30 percent of the licensee's business. No business is conducted at gun shows. No other business on the premises. No other ATF licenses held by the licensee. This is the licensee's first compliance inspection. The licensee is a central Iowa representative for (b)(4) Firearms and approximately (b)(4) of sales are (b)(4) -branded items. Primary suppliers include (b)(4) t, and the general public. The licensee conducts business as a transfer dealer for firearms purchased over the internet. The licensee received this license in July, 2012.

#### **Ownership and Control:**

This license is operated as a limited liability company. See UI: 779080-2012-0535-B1B for corporate documentation. No changes in ownership discovered and no indications of hidden ownership encountered. No changes in RPs – all are correctly listed in FLS.

#### Variance:

The licensee does not currently possess any variances.

#### 2 - Recommendation

Viols WL ONLY and NO Recall Inspection

#### 3 - Inspection History

A review of the Area Office File reveals this is the first on-site inspection for the licensee. An application inspection was conducted under UI: 779080-2012-0535-B1B on June 12, 2012 which resulted in the issuance of this license.

#### 4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

A full inventory was conducted on November 15-16, 2016. At the time of inspection, the licensee had 591 (400 GCA, 191 NFA) firearms in inventory. There were approximately **Worksheet #1** and **Violation 1**. Due to the amount of entries needing reconciliation, the licensee was given one month for reconciliation. Investigators returned to the premise on December 12, 2016. The licensee was unable to account for **Worksheet 1** firearm and reported in missing on December 12, 2016. See **Exhibit 1** for the ATF Form 3310.11 (Theft/Loss Report) for this firearm.

Another ATF Form 3310.11 was completed on December 16, 2016. The theft of a firearm occurred that day. See **Exhibit 2**.

The A&D record is in the proper format as the licensee maintains a handwritten record. See **Exhibit 3** for example pages. The licensee will begin using an electronic A&D record around January 1, 2017. Entries into the written A&D record appear to be timely. The licensee admits they fell behind in maintaining the disposition side of the bound book, yet with the adoption of an electronic record, this poor record keeping practice should cease. At the time of sale, the firearm is removed from inventory and logged out electronically. It was due to this remedy that the licensee was only cited for disposition instances occurring in the sixty days prior to the start of the inspection.

No firearms with obliterated serial numbers were located in inventory. The licensee is not suspected of trafficking in firearms.

## 5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

At the time of inspection, approximately ATF Forms 4473 were completed over the previous twelve (12) months. Forms are filed by transferor transaction serial number. Forms on file for the past year were reviewed with special emphasis on the most recent six months of transfers. Discrepancies (discussed below) are noted on **Worksheet 2** and the **Report of Violations**. No transfers to law enforcement agencies conducted. Transfers to other licensees appear to be properly conducted.

The FFL Audit Log (submitted as **Exhibit 4**) shows 49 NICS checks performed by the licensee from September 1, 2016 to November 5, 2016. Nine (9) NTNs were verified with the Audit Log. No discrepancies discovered.

In the majority of transfers, purchasers possess a NICS exemption document. In instances, the licensee accepted an invalid NICS exemption document. In instance, the licensee did not document a NICS check. See Violation 2, Worksheet 2 and Exhibit 5. Regarding the instance where the licensee did not document a NICS

check, the licensee reviewed their video recording of the premises and found the footage which demonstrates a NICS check was performed yet the results were not written or attached on the Form 4473.

#### 6 - Multiple Sales

Per the VCAB Report (submitted as **Exhibit 6**), the licensee has multiple sale transaction involving firearms. The licensee maintained a file of Multiple Sale Forms; Investigators requested the licensee begin attaching the Multiple Sale Form to the applicable Form 4473. No unreported multiple sales discovered during the inspection.

## 7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

A total of individuals selected as suspicious purchasers. These individuals and the firearms they purchased queried through NCIC/NLETS and E-Trace. No hits on either the firearms or the individuals.

Information on purchasers ((b)(6) given to ATF Special Agent (b)(6) for further review. See Exhibit 7 for Forms 4473 on these purchasers.

## 8 - Trace Activity

Per the VCAB Report (submitted as **Exhibit 6**), firearms has been traced to the licensee over the past 12 months. The licensee was able to provide disposition information to all traces.

Over the past twelve months, the licensee acquired approximately<sup>(b)(4)</sup> used firearms and disposed of  $^{(b)(4)}$  used firearms. (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

The licensee was

witnessed completing this information for submission to ATF while Investigators were on-site.

#### 9 - <u>NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer</u>

JT Guns & Supply LLC is a current Special Occupational Taxpayer. (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103 ) NFA weapons were listed on the National Firearm Registration and Transfer Record (NFRTR). IOI (b)(6) compared the information contained in the NFRTR with the NFA weapons in inventory, identifying discrepancies. silencer was discovered in inventory that was not listed on the NFRTR. The licensee had an (b)(3) - 26 USC 6103

approved NFA transfer forms were compared to the NFRTR with no additional discrepancies identified. All NFA inventory was properly marked and recorded in the A&D record.

#### 10 - <u>Referrals</u>

No referrals generated.

#### 11 - <u>Other</u>

The Youth Handgun Safety Act notice was posted and visible at the premises. The pamphlets were available on the front counter. The licensee provides secure gun storage or a safety device for the transfer of all handguns to non-licensees.

#### 12 - Closing Actions

On January 12, 2017 Inv. (b)(6) conducted a closing conference with the licensee. Both Richard Hofman and his wife, Elwira, were present. Violations were identified and a Report of Violations was issued to the licensee. Federal Firearms regulations were reviewed and a signed acknowledgment has been inserted into NSPECT and is submitted as **Exhibit 10**.

## 13 - Violations

1. 27 CFR 478.125(e)

**Nature of Violation:** Failure to accurately maintain an Acquisition and Disposition record.

In approximately (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

**Licensee's Response:** Mr. Hofman stated, "We lost the gun. We don't know how." Regarding the timeliness of entries in the A&D record, the licensee has changed to an electronic A&D record. This coupled with an electronic ATF Form 4473 is allowing the licensee's A&D record to be immediately amended to reflect the sale or transfer of a firearm. Mr. Hofman stated, "The electronic book is so much better."

<u>Corrective Action</u>: A&D record corrected immediately. Licensee completed ATF Form 3310.11 to report one firearm missing.

#### 2. 27 CFR 478.102

Nature of Violation: Failure to accept a valid NICS exemption document.

In the list instance, the licensee accepted an Iowa Peace Officer ID which was not issued within the last five years (b)(6). In one (1) instance, the licensee accepted a retired Iowa Peace Officer ID which is not a valid NICS exemption document (b)(6). In instance, the licensee accepted an expired NICS exemption document ).

Failure to document a background check.

In instance, the licensee failed to record a background check or NICS exemption document

**Licensee's Response:** The licensee acknowledged the violation. Mr. Hofman stated, "We don't believe our son wrote down the number for the one background check where nothing was written. We found it on the videotape where we conducted it and I gave the buyer a thumbs up."

<u>Corrective Action</u>: For future transactions, slow down while completing the ATF Form 4473 and accurately record all required information relating to NICS exemption documents.

#### 3. 27 CFR 478.99(a)

Nature of Violation: Failure to follow state law.

In approximately instance, the licensee failed to follow Illinois state law relating to the transfer of a long gun (000-112000).

Licensee's Response: The licensee acknowledged the violation.

<u>Corrective Action</u>: For future transactions, ensure out-of-state transfers abide by receiving State laws.

#### 4. 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1)

**<u>Nature of Violation</u>**: Failure to ensure the transferee/buyer accurately completes the Form 4473.

In approximately instances, the licensee failed to ensure the buyer accurately completed the ATF Form 4473 (b)(6).

**Licensee's Response:** The licensee acknowledged the violation. Mr. Hofman stated their electronic 4473 system now scans the buyer's driver's license and this section of the Form 4473 is completed automatically.

**<u>Corrective Action</u>**: Ensure the ATF Form 4473 is completed accurately and correctly by the buyer.

# 5. **27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(i)**

**<u>Nature of Violation</u>**: Failure to verify the identity of the transferee by examining the identification document presented and noting on the Form 4473 the additional documentation provided.

In approximately instance, the licensee failed to document the additional identification documentation in Item 20b

**Licensee's Response:** The licensee acknowledged the violation.

<u>Corrective Action</u>: Ensure the buyer accurately and completely identifies themselves prior to the transfer of a firearm.

## 6. **27 CFR 478.124(c)(5)**

**Nature of Violation:** Failure to date the Form 4473.

In approximately instance, the licensee failed to date the Form 4473 in Item 36

Licensee's Response: The licensee acknowledged the violation.

<u>Corrective Action</u>: The licensee was instructed to ensure the ATF Form 4473 is completed per the instructions.
