1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On December 21st and 22nd of 2016, IO Investigators (b) (6) and (b) (6) (b) (6) conducted a compliance inspection for Type 07 licensee, Velocity Manufacturing Company, LLC. The company currently has three trade names listed in FLS: VMC, Velocity Tactics and Fort Scott Munitions. (See Exhibit #1)

Present at the inspection was company Office Manager, Steven Kalm and General Manager Robert Forester. No advance notice was given to prior to the inspection. The inspection period covered 12/21/2015 to 12/21/2016.

Investigator (b) (6) verified Kalm's identity with his (b) (6) License, (b) (6) expiration date: 9/15/2017. There were no significant findings in Etrace. There were no findings in NFORCE.

Business Profile:

The business maintains a Type 07 Manufacturer of Firearms license (5-48-03071) and a Type 08 Importer of Firearms License (5-48-03173). The business is a storefront, industrial/ warehouse type building located in downtown Fort Scott, KS, inside the City Limits of Fort Scott, KS. The business has held this Type 07 license since 2013. See UI# 779025-2017-0328-B1B for the inspection of the Type 08 license. (See Exhibit #1 and #2)

Velocity Manufacturing Company, LLC's main business is the manufacturing of ammunition. Kalm stated that the company has a patented sold copper design on the ammunition it manufactures. He stated that the patent is for the design of the tip of the ammunition because it tumbles when it hits soft tissue. Kalm stated that the solid copper design is better because it is lead free and easy to machine. Approximately (D, (A)) of the company's business is the manufacture and sale of ammunition. The company manufactures handgun and rifle caliber ammunition. They would like to expand into shot shells in the future. The other (D, (A)) of the business is firearms and accessory sales.

The beginning of 2016 the company opened a storefront firearms shop, open to

the public. They carry an inventory of approximately 400 firearms. Approximately (b)(4) of firearm sales are transfers for customers who purchased firearms online. Approximately (b)(4) is the special order of firearms. Kalm noted that the company's main suppliers are (b) (4) and gunbroker.com.

Kalm estimated that ^{(b) (4)} of the company's firearms business was handguns and ong guns. Kalm stated that although the company does take used firearms in on trade, it is not very often. He estimated only ^{(b) (4)} of firearms were used and ^{(b) (4)} new. The company attends gun shows all over the United States, usually around 5 a year, but does not sell any firearms at gun shows. They use it as an opportunity to show case their ammunition. The company also conducts gunsmith activities. Kalm state that operations included basic cleanings and repairs, mounting scopes, making parts for older guns, threading barrels and replacing bolts. Kalm stated that they were aware in the difference between gunsmithing and manufacturing.

The company uses the Type 07- Manufacturing License to manufacture ammunition but also limited manufacturing of firearms. The company has built several receivers into AR type rifles. However, only a handful have been completed.

The licensee also pays the NFA SOT to manufacture and sell NFA firearms. The company has manufactured several rifles into machine guns. However, Kalm stated that they never intend on transferring nay of these firearms, it is all for R&D purposes of their ammunition. The company also sells suppressors to individuals.

In addition to manufacturing ammunition, the limited manufacturing of firearms, the NFA sales, firearms sales, and gunsmithing, the company also sells clothing, tactical gear and other firearms related merchandise such as holsters and other accessories.

The company has their own website, www.velocitytactics.com. They advertise via radio, TV, newspaper, Facebook and word of mouth.

Future plans still exist for the possibility of opening an indoor shooting range and developing their own line of firearms. However, there are no immediate plans.

The company obtained the Type 08- Importer of Firearms License because they thought there might be a shortage of materials needed to produce the ammunition

they wanted to manufacture. They began looking outside of the Unties States for the materials and had identified sources in Europe and Asia. They obtained this license to be able to import these materials. However, the company has not had to import any materials needed to manufacture the ammunition as of yet. And therefore, has not used this license. All firearm activity has been conducted under the Type 07- Manufacturer of Firearms License (5-48-03071). However, the company still wanted to maintain the Type 08 license should they need to import materials in the future.

The license held is appropriate for the business. Licensee is in compliance with all state/local laws. There is no offsite storage of records or firearms.

Ownership and Control:

Velocity Manufacturing Company, LLC is a Limited Liability Company formed in Kansas in 2012 and is properly listed with the State of Kansas. The company is currently in good standing with the Kansas Secretary of State. (See Exhibit #3)

Roger Kraft of Roger E. Kraft Living Trust was the owner and only member of the company, but Kraft recently formed WK Holding Company as the "parent company" of Velocity Manufacturing Company, LLC. Kraft is still the controlling owner of WK Holding Company, INC. Per conversation with ATF Area Supervisor (b) (6) the company should keep the same FFL number change of control was not shifted. (See Exhibit #4)

Current responsible persons on the license include, CEO/ owner Roger Kraft, President Ryan Kraft, Tester/ Developer Gary Buntain, and Manager Jesse Crum. However; there are multiple responsible persons that should be listed on the license that have not been added. In November of 2016, (b) (6) Compliance Coordinator emailed (b) (6) to add the following people as responsible persons to this Type 07 license; Office Employee (b) (6) Vice President Gregory Fess, General Manager Robert Forester, and Office Manager Steven Kalm. According to FLS, these people had yet to been added and should be added as responsible persons to the license. (See Exhibit #1 and #5)

There were no other responsible persons identified during the inspection. There was no hidden ownership detected. Day to day operations of the business are run by Ryan Kraft, Robert Forester, and Steven Kalm.

A sample of ATF F 4473s (approximately 20) on file for the inspection period were traced through the licensee's records to the A&D book. The were no discrepancies found.

The business has acquired approximately (b)(4) (repair, retail and manufacture) and disposed of approximately firearms within the inspection period. All entries were timely and accurately entered.

Steven Kalm and Chris Carver are the main ones who log firearms in and out of the A&D book. They try to have a second person review all entries. Kalm noted that the company normally takes a quarterly inventory. The business has a surveillance system with camera monitoring.

There were no reports of thefts or losses for the past year. There were no trafficking issues found while reviewing the A&D book. Also, there were no firearms with obliterated serial numbers or illegal firearms found.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

There were ATF Form 4473's on file for the inspection period. ATF F 4473s are kept numerically by transaction serial number.

While reviewing ATF F 4473s, Investigators found that the licensee failed to accurately identify and record a valid identification document of the transferee on the ATF F 4473. On instance the licensee accepted an expired driver's license. And on other instances the licensee did not obtain government issued supplemental identification when the address on the identification document did not match the address recorded in box 2 of the ATF F 4473. (4473 (4473 (4473)) (30) (112) (112) (4473)

Investigators also found that the licensee failed to conduct a NICS check on the transferee prior to the transfer of a firearm. On instance, the licensee accepted an expired Kansas Conceal Carry Permit in lieu of a NICS check. However, the conceal carry permit was not valid as it was expired. See Violation #6, Worksheets, and Exhibit #8)

All employees complete the 4473s and NICS checks. However, Kalm stated that they

try to always have a second person review the form before the firearm leaves the store.

There were no transfers to law enforcement for official duty. FFLs were on file for transfers to other FFLs. There were minimum NTNs on the ATF FFL Audit Log compared to ATF F 4473s for the inspection period. There were no discrepancies. There were no denied transactions for the inspection period on the FFL Audit Log. However, there was one denied form on file. (See Exhibit #9)

6 - Multiple Sales

Per VCAB, there was multiple sale reported for the inspection period. The form was on file in the licensee's records. There were no unreported multiple sales. (See Exhibit #10)

7 - <u>Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers</u>

There were no suspicious/ prohibited purchasers found for the inspection period.

8 - Trace Activity

Per VCAB, there were no trace requests for the inspection period. There were no other NCIC/ TECS checks completed. (See Exhibit #10)

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The company obtained the manufacturer of firearms license with the main intent to manufacture of ammunition. The company has a patented sold copper design on the ammunition it manufactures. Approximately $\binom{(b)}{4}$ of the company's business is the manufacture and sale of ammunition. The company manufactures handgun and rifle caliber ammunition. Investigator (b) (6) asked if the company manufactured armor piercing ammunition. Forester stated that they did not.

The company uses the Type 07- Manufacturing License to manufacture ammunition but also limited manufacturing of firearms. The company has built several receivers into AR type rifles. However, only a handful have been completed. When the licensee manufactures a firearm, they receive a completed receiver and log it in their A&D book from the supplier. They then log the firearm out to themselves, and log it back in on the next available entry as what the firearm has been manufactured into, receiving it from themselves. All recordkeeping was correct.

The company has been submitting the Annual Firearms Manufacturing and Exportation

Report every April. There were no discrepancies found while reviewing this report to the licensee's records. (See Exhibit #11)

The licensee also pays the NFA SOT to manufacture and sell NFA firearms. The company has manufactured several rifles into machine guns. However, Kalm stated that they never intend on transferring any of these firearms, it is all for R&D purposes of their ammunition. The company also sells suppressors to individuals. Investigators compared all NFA firearms in inventory to the ATF NFA registry. There were no discrepancies. The company is keeping all ATF F 2's, 3's, and 4's on file for all NFA firearms. (See Exhibit #12)

There were several manufactured firearms in inventory. Most of those firearms were appropriately marked with the company's name, city and state. However, there was one firearm that the licensee manufactured a firearm receiver into a machine gun and did not mark the firearm with the company's trade name and city and state.

Investigator (b) (6) discussed with Forester and Kalm the company's obligation to contact Tax and Trade Bureau for excise tax that may be required and his obligation to contact the Department of Defense and Trade Control to see about possible registration requirements. Forester stated that they had already been in contact and that they do pay excise tax on all ammunition and they are registered with the DDTC and have the appropriate ITAR. (See Exhibit #13)

Although the company has the Type 08- Importer of Firearms license (5-48-03173), they have not used it. They have not imported any firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition parts. See UI# 779025-2017-0323-B1B for that report.

10 - Referrals

There were no referrals made.

11 - Other

Licensee had the Youth Handgun Safety Act Poster and their FFL posted. Licensee does not sell exploding targets.

The licensee also holds a Type 20- Manufacturer of Explosives License, 5-KS-20-00910. See UI# 779025-2017-0101-B2A for that inspection report.

Forester indicated an understanding of the Gun Control Act's (GCA) recordkeeping and business conduct requirements. Forester completed and signed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations. 27 CFR 478.123(a) 1.

Licensee's Response: Licensee stated that the repair firearm was an employee's firearm and they didn't realize they had to log employee firearms in the A&D book.

Licensee stated that the firearm they manufactured into a machine gun must have slipped by them because they have correctly recorded other firearms they have manufactured. They stated that it was an old employee that was keeping records then.

2. **27 CFR 478.123(b)**

Nature of Violation: Failure to accurately and timely record dispositions of firearms to other FFLs in the A&D book. On instances the licensee transferred firearms to another FFL and did not log the firearm out in the A&D book. (^{(b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552})

On the potential of the licensee manufactured a firearm receiver into a machine gun but did not log the firearm out to themselves for manufacture and then back in as an acquisition from themselves as now a machine gun. $(^{(b)(3) - 112 \text{ Public Law 55 125 Star 552}})$

Corrective Action: Licensee is to update and correct the A&D book.

Licensee's Response: Licensee didn't know why these had not been logged out. They stated that they take an inventory but they do it to their computer system and not the A&D book. They stated from now on they will take the inventory to their A&D book so these errors would be caught.

3. **27 CFR 478.124(d)**

Nature of Violation: Failure to accurately and timely record dispositions of firearms to individuals in the A&D book. On instances the licensee transferred firearms to an individual and did not log the firearm out in the A&D book.

O **bibli** b ther instance, the licensee recorded a double entry- an entry in the sale A&D and the same firearm in the repair A&D and did not void the double entry.

Corrective Action: Licensee is to update and correct the A&D book.

Licensee's Response: Licensee again didn't know why these had not been logged out. They stated that they take an inventory but they do it to their computer system and not the A&D book. They stated from now on they will take the inventory to their A&D book so these errors would be caught.

4. 27 CFR 478.92(a)(1)

Nature of Violation: Failure of licensee to identify and mark a firearm they manufactured by engraving, casting, stamping, or otherwise placing their name as the manufacture and city and state where they manufacture and maintain place of business.

On instance the licensee manufactured a firearm receiver into a machine gun and did not mark the <u>firearm with</u> the company's trade name and city and state.

Corrective Action: Licensee is to mark the firearm with their trade name and city and state.

Licensee's Response: Licensee stated that they did not know why this firearm did not get marked and that they have marked all other firearms that they have manufactured. Licensee stated that it was a different person in charge when this firearm was manufactured.

5. 27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(i)

Nature of Violation: Failure of licensee to accurately identify and record a valid identification document of the transferee on the ATF F 4473.

On instance the licensee accepted an expired driver's license. And on bother instances the licensee did not obtain government issued supplemental identification when the address on the identification document did not match the address recorded in box of the ATF F 4473.

Corrective Action: Licensee is to ensure that a valid identification document of the transferee is accurately and entirely completed prior to the transfer of a firearm.

Licensee's Response: Licensee stated that they always make sure that the identification document is valid but were confused on acceptable supplemental identification.

6. **27 CFR 478.102(a)**

Nature of Violation: Failure to conduct a NICS check on the transferee prior to the transfer of a firearm. On instance, the licensee accepted an expired Kansas Conceal Carry Permit in lieu of a NICS check. However, the conceal carry permit was not valid as it was expired.

Corrective Action: Licensee is to ensure NICS is contacted for every transaction to an individual. The only exception is if the individual has a qualifying and valid state permit.

Licensee's Response: Licensee was shocked that they had accepted the conceal carry and stated that they knew better.
