1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

Senior Investigator (b)(6) conducted a Disposition Emphasis compliance inspection of AARMAC, Inc., d/b/a Brok-Pawn, on November 28, 2016. The unannounced inspection occurred at the premises and was conducted according to the instructions on ATF Form 5700.14. The inspection covered from November 28, 2015 until November 27, 2016. Aaron McClure Hargan, vice-president of AARMAC, Inc., was interviewed during the inspection (**Exhibit 1**). Store Manager, Dennis Blackmore, was also interviewed during the inspection (**Exhibit 2**).

Business Profile:

Brok-Pawn is a small pawn shop that deals in general pawn merchandise as well as firearms. The business is licensed as a *Dealer, Including Pawnbroker, in Firearms* (Type 02) and is located in a commercial area at 2900 E. Race St., Searcy, AR (**Exhibit 3**). In the last 12 months, (b)(4) firearms were acquired and (b)(4) were disposed. The estimated percentage of business is as follows:

The licensee does not display or transfer firearms at gun shows. Additionally, the business was in compliance with all known State and local licenses/permits. All required records are kept on the licensed premises, and no off-site storage is utilized for firearms. New firearms are primarily acquired from (b)(4), Inc., a separate company owned by Everett McKinly Brokaw, the president of AARMAC, Inc., d/b/a Brok-Pawn, the subject licensee. AARMAC, Inc. has been licensed since 2014.

Ownership and Control:

AARMAC is an Arkansas corporation in good standing with the State (**Exhibit 4**). The *Dealer, Including Pawnbroker, in Firearms* license (Type 02) is correctly issued. Everett McKinly Brokaw (**Exhibit 5**), president, and Aaron McClure Hargan, vice-president, own the corporation equally. Both are

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responsible people on the license. In addition, Franklin Pierce Narramore (**Exhibit 6**), manager, is also a responsible person. No additional responsible people were identified as a result of this inspection. Background (NCIC) checks on Messrs. Brokaw, Hargan and Narramore revealed no prohibiting data. The licensee is engaged in the business, and no hidden ownership was disclosed. The Federal Licensing System (FLS) should be updated to show the residential address of responsible person, Aaron McClure Hargan, to be: (b)(6)

Variance:

The licensee has no approved variances and does not require any at this time.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

The licensee had 45 firearms in inventory at the time of the inspection. The hard copy acquisition & disposition (A&D) record listed (b)(6) firearms in stock. A full inventory was conducted. No discrepancies were revealed. Twenty firearms were traced through the required records with no trafficking issues indicated. The required information was contained in the A&D records, and entries were timely made. Store manager, Dennis Blackmore, is charged with maintaining the A&D records. Mr. Blackmore stated that he tries to update it each day but always in a few days. In addition, Mr. Blackmore stated that an inventory is taken monthly.

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5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

There were [REDACTED] ATF Forms 4473 for the review period, and all were reviewed. The following discrepancies were revealed (**Violations 1-4 & Worksheet 2: ATF Form 4473 Review**):

- In [REDACTED] instances, the ethnicity of the transferee (#10a) was blank. In [REDACTED] instances, certification question #11a was answered “No”. In [REDACTED] instance, the recertification signature and date (#24 & #25) was blank.
- In [REDACTED] instance, a PO Box was listed as the residential address (#2); a copy of the driver’s license with a physical address was attached. In [REDACTED] instances, the county of the transferee (#2) was blank. In [REDACTED] instance, the state of residence (#13) was blank.
- In [REDACTED] instances, the residential address of the transferee was not verified with the identification document recorded (#20b).
- In [REDACTED] instance, the final response from NICS (#21d) was blank (**Exhibit 7**).

The ATF Forms 4473 on file were maintained numerically. The denials or ATF Forms 4473 that were not associated with a firearm transfer were stored separately and in chronological order. There were 28 NICS checks in the previous sixty days according to the FFL NICS Audit Log received prior to the inspection that were verified. No transfers to law enforcement on letterhead had occurred during the inspection period. Transfers to other licensees were properly recorded. The transferee without a final response (#21d) was queried in NCIC with no prohibiting data revealed. Mr. Blackmore stated that there was no standard procedure of checking the ATF Forms 4473. Senior Investigator (b)(6) suggested having a second employee take a look at the ATF Forms 4473 while the transferee was still present. If that was not possible, it was suggested to review the ATF Forms at least on a weekly basis.

6 - Multiple Sales

One multiple sales of handguns (involving [REDACTED] handguns) had been filed during the inspection period according to the Violent Crime Analysis Branch Master Query. [REDACTED] unreported multiple handgun sales (involving [REDACTED] handguns) were discovered (**Violation 5 & Worksheet 2: ATF Form 4473 Review**). [REDACTED] had ATF Forms 3310.4 attached to the corresponding ATF Forms 4473, but ATF had no record of receiving them. All [REDACTED] multiple sales were reported as required during the inspection (**Exhibits 8-11**).

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

No suspicious/prohibited purchasers were identified.

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8 - Trace Activity

There have been no traces to this licensee during the inspection period according to the Violent Crime Analysis Branch Master Query. A large portion of the firearm acquired are secondary market firearms from individuals. Investigator (b)(6) queried 10 of these firearms in NCIC with no hits. As an Arkansas pawnbroker, the business is required to report all pawned items to law enforcement through Leads Online. All indications seem to suggest that the business is compliant in doing so.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The licensee does not import, collect, or manufacture firearms; nor does the licensee pay Special Occupation Tax (SOT) as a dealer in Title II (NFA) firearms.

10 - Referrals

No referrals were made as a result of this compliance inspection.

11 - Other

The licensee had secure gun storage/safety devices available and was displaying the Youth Handgun Safety Act poster and pamphlets.

Five Arkansas Concealed Carry Permit holders were queried in the Arkansas State Police Database with no discrepancies revealed.

12 - Closing Actions

Senior Investigator (b)(6) held a closing conference with Aaron McClure Hargan, vice-president of AARMAC, Inc., d/b/a Brok-Pawn, on December 1, 2016. The violations discovered and corrective actions were reviewed in depth. The Report of Violations (ROV) was signed by Mr. Hargan. Regulatory requirements and general information were also discussed. The Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations was also signed by Mr. Hargan, indicating he had received a copy, that it was reviewed, and all questions were answered regarding the information therein contained (**Exhibit 12**).
