1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

Senior Industry Operations Investigators (b)(6) and (b)(6) conducted an unannounced manufacturer compliance inspection at Wildman Arms June 6-8, 2016. The inspection was conducted according to the instructions on ATF Form 5700.14 and covered the timeframe June 6, 2015 – June 5, 2016.

, salesman, Hunter Douglas, president, and John Douglas, vice president, were interviewed and assisted with the inspection.

Business Profile:

Wildman Arms operates a retail firearms business and manufactures a small number of firearms. The business uses a variety of distributors as suppliers of firearms. The manufactured firearms are typically Short Barrel Rifles (SBR). The *Manufacturer of Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices* (Type 07) license is appropriate for the licensee's activities. No other additional license/permits from ATF are required at this time.

Wildman Arms pays Special Occupational Tax as a manufacturer of Class 3 firearms. The licensee acquired approximately (b)(4) firearms in the last 12 months and disposed of approximately (b)(4) firearms. Approximately (b)(4) of the firearms handled by the business are new. Approximately (b)(4) of the firearm transfers involve long guns, (b)(4) involve handguns, and (b)(4) involve NFA firearms. The licensee manufactures less than 10 firearms on average in a year.

The licensee participates in gun shows and conducts internet transfers. The business is in compliance with all known State and local licenses/permits. All required records are kept on the licensed premises, and no off-site storage is utilized for firearms.

The business recently moved to a new location and plans another move in the next 12 months.

Ownership and Control:

Wildman Arms and Outfitters, Inc. is an Arkansas Corporation. A check of the Arkansas Secretary of State's Business and Commercial Services webpage indicates that the business is in good standing (**Exhibit 1**). There have been no unreported changes in the ownership or structure of the business. Hunter

Douglas is the president of the corporation and owns 50% of the stock. His brother, John Douglas, is the vice president and owns 50% of the stock. Denise Douglas, Hunter's wife, is the treasurer of the corporation but does not own any stock in the corporation. Currently, they are the only three responsible persons on the license and no additional responsible people were identified as a result of this inspection. OpenFox queries on the three responsible persons revealed no prohibiting data. The licensee is engaged in the business, and no hidden ownership was disclosed.

Variance:

The licensee holds no approved variances with ATF.

This is the first firearms compliance inspection of the licensee.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

The licensee had 664 firearms in inventory and open entries in the bound book. A complete inventory verification was conducted which disclosed the following discrepancies (Worksheet 1: Inventory and A&D Review):

- There were repair firearms that had been acquired but not logged in the bound books (Violation 1).
- There were firearms transferred to other licensees that were not logged out (Violation 2).
- There were firearms transferred to individuals that were not logged out (Violation 3).
- There were duplicate entries (Violation 3).

Following reconciliation, all firearms were accounted for. The licensee made all required corrective entries in the bound books. Entries in the book are in the proper format and include all required information. There were no theft/loss reports filed during the inspection period, and none were filed as a result of this report. traced five firearms through the records with no further discrepancies disclosed. According to Hunter Douglas, (b) is now in charge of insuring that all firearms are timely logged in and out of the bound books. They hope this increases their internal controls regarding accuracy of the book.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

There were 910 ATF Forms 4473 on file for the inspection period. All were reviewed during the inspection and the following discrepancies were disclosed (Worksheet 2: ATF Form 4473 Review):

With regard to the omissions in Items 11c, 11g, and 11k – the purchasers were queried through NCIC with no prohibiting information disclosed.

ATF Forms 4473 are maintained in chronological order. Denials (or ATF Forms 4473 that were not associated with a firearm transfer) were being filed separately and in chronological order. Verification of the FFL NICS audit log resulted in no discrepancies. With regard to internal controls, (b) (6) will now review each Form 4473 at the end of the week to ensure there are no omissions or discrepancies. John Douglas stated that each employee who reviews Forms with the customers will be counseled regarding errors that were found.

6 - Multiple Sales

The licensee failed to report multiple handgun sales involving firearms during the inspection period (Violation 9). The licensee completed 19 multiple sales correctly. During the inspection, the licensee completed ATF Forms 3310.4 for the unreported multiple handgun sales and submitted the forms to the ATF National Tracing Center. Copies of the submitted forms are attached as Exhibit 3.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

No traffickers, straw purchasers, prohibited persons, or any other suspicious purchasers were identified as a result of this inspection.

8 - Trace Activity

The licensee was the subject of one firearms trace during the last 12 months which was successfully completed.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

Wildman Arms is a firearms manufacturer and is required to keep manufacturing records. The manufacturing records are being kept in accordance with regulations. SIOI requested copies of the Annual Firearms Manufacturing and Exportation Report (AFMER) for the licensee from the Firearms and Explosives Services Division. The licensee timely submitted AFMERs for the years 2012 and 2014; however, the 2013 form was not found. The licensee filed an AFMER for 2013 subsequent to the inspection. The 2015 AFMER has also been filed.

A reconciliation of the NFA inventory with the list of registered firearms listed in the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record (NFRTR) revealed no discrepancies. Of the firearms in inventory, are registered firearms. Wildman Arms is current regarding payment of Special Occupational Tax and is in compliance with the regulations regarding the receipt and transfers of NFA firearms.

10 - Referrals

There were no referrals of information generated based on information disclosed during this inspection.

11 - Other

Initiation of the inspection was delayed until after the licensee moved to this current location. There were no other noteworthy findings associated with the inspection.
