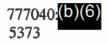

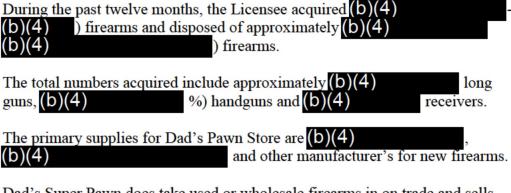

Dad's Super Pawn does take used or wholesale firearms in on trade and sells these wholesale or used firearms as part of its business. Approximately (b)(4) of the store inventory is composed of used or wholesale firearms.

Firearms sales are not conducted at gun shows at this time. Regulations for the sale of firearms at gun shows were discussed with Mr. Riley.

Dad's Super Pawn is active with regard to internet purchases from the website www.gunbroker.com for individuals, and accepts these transfers from licensed FFL dealers as well as individuals. Dad's Super Pawn "does not" currently utilize the internet for individual firearm sales, but does utilize the internet for advertising purposes. Website is http://www.dadssuperpawn.com.

Dad's Super Pawn has no current government contracts and no other ATF licenses are affiliated with the business premise.

All firearms are currently being stored on the business premises including some of Mr. J. Kevin Riley's personal firearms. All personal firearms were tagged and marked "Personal- Not for Sale". There are no other off site storage locations for firearms.

The business premise is a store front located in the commercial business area within the city limits of Gulfport, MS located at 3125 25th Ave., Gulfport, MS 39501.

JKR, Inc. d/b/a Dad's Super Pawn has IRS EIN #: (b)(3)-26 USC 6103, MS State Tax ID #: (b)(3)-26 USC 6103, MS Pawnbrokers License #: PB/000066/2016 and City of Gulfport Privilege License #: 1789. In addition, JKR, Inc. has a valid ATF SOT#(b)(3) - 26 USC 6103.

All Licenses and Permits are valid and JKR, Inc. is in compliance with all other State and local laws

Ownership and Control:

JKR, Inc. is currently operating as a "Corporation" under the trade name Dad's Super Pawn as listed with the MS Secretary of State's website. Officers of the Corporation are listed as Mr. J. Kevin Riley. Mr. J. Kevin Riley- President currently holds 100 % majority stock ownership of the corporation (Reference Exhibit # 2- "MS Secretary of State Results").

Investigator (b)(6) informed Mr. Riley that if he ever changed his business structure to a Partnership or Limited Liability Company (LLC), that this would constitute a change of control in the company and would require him to apply for a new FFL. Mr. J. Kevin Riley "verbally" acknowledged that he understood.

Mr. J. Kevin Riley is the only "active" responsible person listed on the license within FLS. There have been no other changes to responsible persons and there is no indication of hidden ownership.

Variance:

JKR, Inc. d/b/a Dad's Super Pawn has no current "active" variance and none were requested.

2 - Recommendation

SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS:

The following violation warrants a Warning Conference:

27 CFR 478.102(a): The Licensee failed to conduct a NICS background check on a purchaser in instances. Acceptance of a non-qualifying State permit as substitute for a NICS check occurred in (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552) instances.

JUSTIFICATION FOR ALTERNATE RECOMMENDATION:

- Mr. Riley failed to conduct a NICS check on he stated that they had possession of a "valid" MS Firearms permit issued within the past ten (10) years and that he properly recorded this information on the ATF Form 4473 form. Mr. Riley further stated that he was unaware of the requirement per 27 CFR 478.102(d)(ii) that the "valid" state issued MS firearms permit had to have been issued within five (5) years of the purchase date. With regard to the other instance, this individual was a Military member and Mr. Riley stated that a background check was conducted, but that the employee filling out the form just forgot to record the NICS information on the ATF Form 4473.
- Mr. Riley immediately completed and held an internal training class for all his employees about the requirements of 27 CFR 478.102(a) and 102(d) (ii) and also the importance of recording all NICS background check information on the ATF F 4473 form. Mr. Riley stated that in the future he would have his firearms compliance manager review all ATF Form 4473's to verify compliance. Mr. Riley stated that he will comply with all regulatory requirements in the future now that he is aware of the proper procedures for executing the regulations.
- On July 29th, 2016, Investigator (b)(6) conducted a MS JUST / NICS check on each of the individual purchasers which showed no prohibiting information.
- Mr. Riley has only held this ATF license for 6 years and this was his first ever compliance inspection under this license.
- Mr. Riley was cooperative during the investigation and was responsible for turning over information to the investigator in discovering a possible internal theft of firearms by former employees of his company. This information subsequently led to a referral to an ATF agent on possible criminal activity. This investigator believes that the continued operation of this business will not pose a threat to public safety or contribute to the likelihood of violent crime, and that a warning letter would be sufficient to ensure future compliance.

3 - Inspection History

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

A full inventory was conducted. The physical count revealed that there were

The A & D books showed (b)(4) open spaces in the acquisition and disposition records.

Four-hundred and Forty-four (444) firearms accounting for 5 % of dispositions were traced through the FFL required records from Acquisition through Disposition with no criminal or adverse findings.

There were zero (0) firearms examined during inventory inspection which contained obliterated serial numbers. There was no theft or loss reported for this FFL during the inspection period.

The licensee saves all invoices for new firearm acquisitions but "fails" to log all firearms in the A & D record by close of the next business day. Firearm dispositions are "not" logged out of the A & D record within seven (7) business days from the date of transfer. There were no trafficking issues disclosed during review of the A & D record.

The A & D record was accurate and in the proper format, but was not being maintained as required by regulations. A review of the A & D record revealed the following discrepancies:

- The Licensee failed to record the "Acquisition" of firearms within the time frame required per ATF regulations (Exhibit # 3).
- The Licensee failed to record the "Disposition" of within the time frame required per ATF regulations (Exhibit # 4).
- There was (D(S)-112 Public Law SS 125 Stat SS2 entry within the A & D Record (Exhibit # 3).
- There were incorrect serial numbers within the A & D Record (Exhibit #3).

CORRECTED IMMEDIATELY. Investigator (b)(6) instructed the FFL to Properly record the acquisition and disposition of all firearms within seven (7) business days of receipt or completion of an ATF Form 4473 and completion of transfer. Investigator (b)(6) also instructed the FFL to Report all theft or loss of Inventory to the local Police and ATF within 48 hours of discovery.

A City of Gulfport MS Police Report (Report#: 16-018885) and an ATF Form 3310.11 "FFL Firearms Inventory Theft / Loss Report" (Report#: "Properties of the Police were completed on August 2nd, 2016 for all missing firearms and sent to the NTC by the FFL.

All firearms previously "not acquired" were entered into the A & D record. All firearm dispositions previously "not reported" were located on paperwork and logged out of the A & D record. All "incorrect" Serial numbers were corrected within the A & D record (Reference Violation #1, Exhibit #3 and Exhibit #4, & Worksheet #1).

5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

There were (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552) forms on file for the review period.

The 20 % sampling of the forms was requested by Investigator (b)(6) on July 13th, 2016 and approved by Director of Industry Operations (DIO) Matthew Wren on July 14th, 2016.

The Licensee did have the proper filing system in place for all ATF Form 4473's. The forms were filed in numerical order utilizing a unique serial number on each form.

All denied and no transfer forms are kept in a separate file per ATF regulations.

The licensee stated they have an ATF Form 4473 review system in place for all firearms transactions prior to the customer and the firearm leaving the business premise.

A review of (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552 forms on file for the review period revealed the following discrepancies:

27 CFR 478.102(a)- On forms, the licensee failed to conduct a NICS criminal background check on a purchaser prior to the transfer of a firearm. (Reference Violation #2, Exhibit #5, & Worksheet #2).

27 CFR 478.124(c)(3)(iv)- On forms, the Licensee failed to record required NICS Information on the ATF Form 4473 form prior to the transfer of a firearm (Reference Violation #3, Exhibit #6, & Worksheet #2).

Transfers to other licensees were recorded and documented correctly within the A & D book and copies of licenses for all FFL transfers are on file.

(b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552) NICS transaction numbers were verified by comparing them to the FFL NICS audit log. There were no discrepancies with the audit log.

6 - Multiple Sales

There were (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552) multiple sales involving handguns reported to the Violent Crimes Analysis Branch (VCAB) by this licensee according to the Trace History Report received from the VCAB dated July 1st, 2016.

During the review of (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 5528) forms from the review period for this licensee, no unreported multiple sales were disclosed.

Investigator (b)(6) reminded the FFL that it is a requirement to report the sale of two or more handguns or revolvers within five business days to ATF by completing an ATF Form 3310.4 and either mail it or fax it in to the ATF National Tracing Center by close of the business day.

Investigator (b)(6) reminded the Licensee to fax or send the second copy of the Multiple sale form to local LEO officials. Mr. J. Kevin Riley "verbally" acknowledged that he understood these requirements per 27 CFR 478.126a.

There were Three-hundred and seventy-six (376) used firearms in inventory. A fifty percent (50 %) secondary market analysis was conducted by Investigator (b)(6) on July 24th, 2016 for One-hundred and ninety-six (196) used or wholesale firearms in inventory.

Serial numbers for these secondary market firearms were queried in the NCIC / MS JUST system by Investigator (b)(6) with no negative results indicated.

9 - NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer

The Licensee "does not" conduct firearms or ammunition manufacturing activity at this time. In addition, the licensee has never held an FFL as a "Collector" of curio's and relic firearms.

In addition to being licensed as a Type 02 "Pawnbroker", JKR, Inc. d/b/a Dad's Super Pawn handles and conducts transfers and sales of NFA Registerable Firearms. All Three-hundred and twenty-seven (327) NFA Firearms in inventory were examined during the inspection and there were no discrepancies found with the NFRTR.

All required NFA Forms were on file for the review period with a copy of the ATF Form 3 and ATF Form 4 on file for each corresponding NFA transaction.

Regulations under 27 CFR 479 for the manufacture, sale and transfer of firearms under the National Firearms Act (NFA) were reviewed by Investigator (b)(6) and Mr. J. Kevin Riley-Responsible Person was instructed on the Form 1 through Form 5 record keeping requirements with regard to NFA firearm transactions.

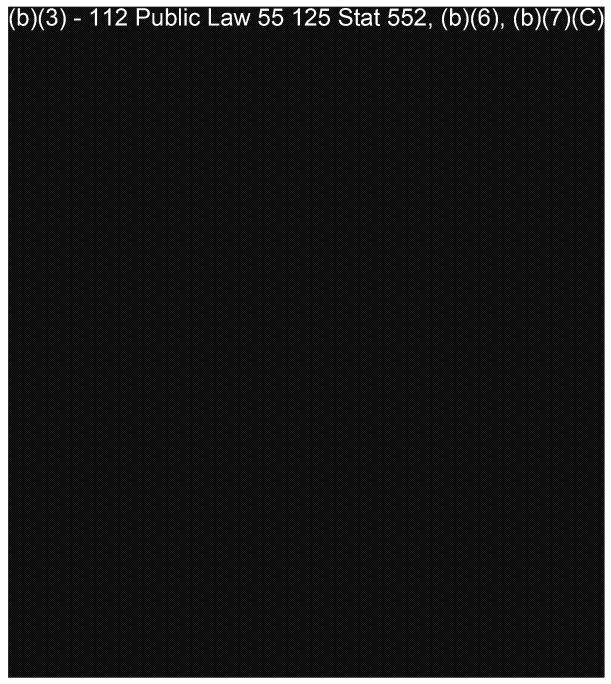

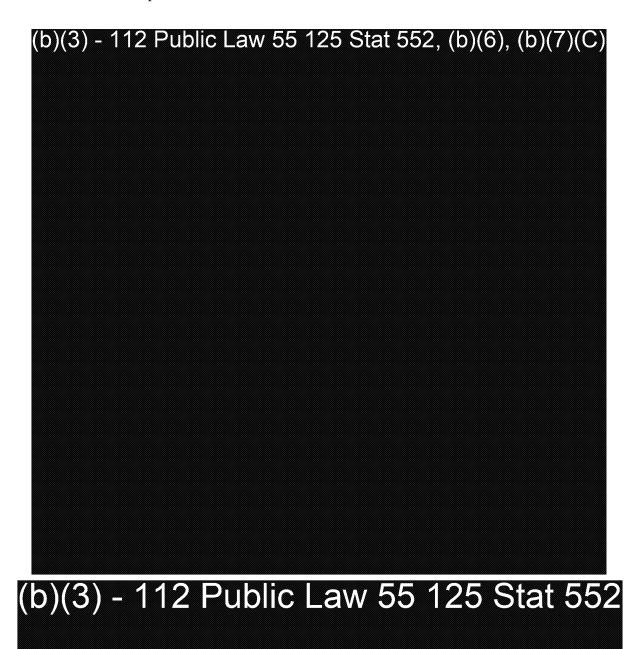

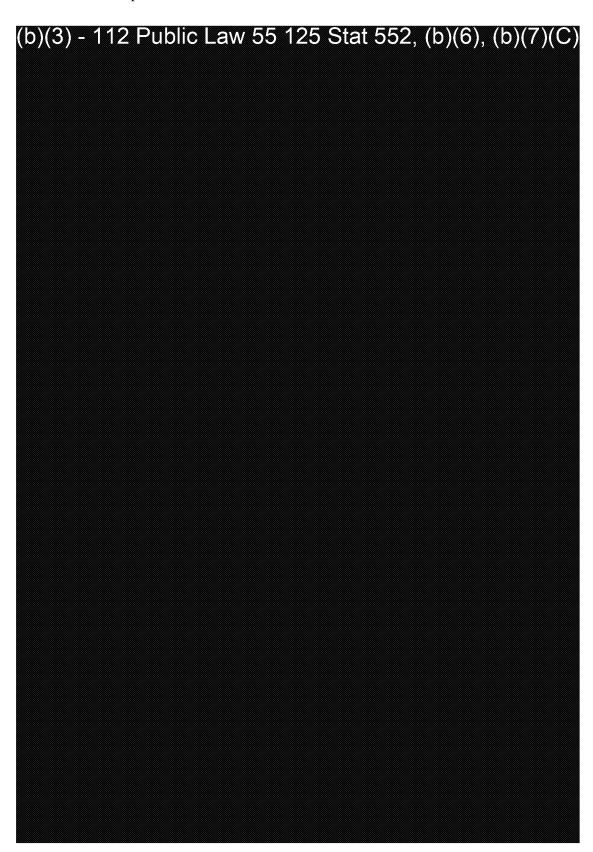

11 - Other

JKR, Inc. d/b/a Dad's Super Pawn did have the ATF I 5300.1 Youth Handgun Safety Act Poster for display in his business. IOI instructed Mr. Riley– Responsible Person to provide Youth Handgun Safety Act Notices, ATF I 5300.2 for all handgun transfers.

Secure gun storage and safety devices will be available to customers and all firearms in inventory will be in a secure location at all times.

Investigator (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552, (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted MSJUST NCIC checks on One (1) responsible person, Two (2) store employees, Two (2) former store employees (See Referral 2016-0040), Fifteen (15) individuals with delayed responses, Three (3) suspicious purchasers, Eleven (11) individual purchasers with no prior NICS check (27 CFR 102(a) violation) and Nineteen (19) MS Firearms permit holders for a total of Fifty-three (53) individual NICS / MSJUST checks.

Prohibiting information was disclosed on One (1) individual purchaser with an initial "Delayed" response from NICS-(b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552, (b)(6) as a possible prohibited person in possession of a firearm (Reference Section 10- Referral #: 2016-0044).

The business premises of Dad's Super Pawn are "not" located within One-thousand (1000) feet of a school zone and he is in compliance with the Gun Free School Zone law as stated in 18 U.S.C. 922 (q) (1).

JKR, Inc. d/b/a Dad's Super Pawn was provided ATF P 5380.1 "Loss Prevention for Firearms Retailers" and advised as to the importance of Loss Prevention controls and measures for his firearms business.

On August 2nd, 2016, a closing conference was held with the Licensee and the rules and regulations for firearms were reviewed.

An overview of standard operating procedures with regard to firearms records and transactions were provided by Investigator (b)(6)

Investigator (b)(6) reviewed the instructions as to the proper completion and filing of the required ATF Form 4473's. In addition, Mr. J. Kevin Riley-Responsible Person was instructed on the record keeping requirements per 27 CFR 478.125(e) with regard to all firearm transactions.

The signature of Mr. J. Kevin Riley–Responsible Person was obtained on the "Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations" (Reference Exhibit # 7"Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations" dated August 2nd, 2016).

13 - Violations

1. 27 CFR 478.125(e)

Nature of violation:

The Licensee failed to properly maintain the Acquisition and Disposition records per ATF Regulations.

- After Inventory reconciliation, firearms were missing from inventory.

 (Reference Exhibit #3- "Copy of ATF Form 3310.11 FFL Firearms Inventory Theft

 / Loss Report dated August 2nd, 2016 / Copies of Firearms A & D pages")
- The Licensee failed to record the "Acquisition" of firearms within the time frame required per ATF regulations (See Exhibit # 3).
- The Licensee failed to record the "Disposition" of the Copies of A & D pages / Copies of ATF Form 4473's for sales and dispositions / Copies of FFL Transfers").
- There was double entry within the A & D Record (See Exhibit # 3).
- There were incorrect serial numbers within the A & D Record (See Exhibit #3).

Licensee's Response:

The Licensee stated that he did not know how these errors occurred within his A & D book and that he was not aware he had missing firearms. Licensee further stated that the large portion of these errors occurred due to negligence of his employees.

Corrective Action:

Investigator (b)(6) instructed the FFL to properly record the acquisition and disposition of all firearms within seven (7) business days of receipt or completion of an ATF Form 4473 and completion of the transfer. Investigator (b)(6) also instructed the FFL to Report all theft or loss of Inventory to the local Police and ATF within 48 hours of discovery.

CORRECTED IMMEDIATELY. A City of Gulfport MS Police Report #: 16-018885 and an ATF Form 3310.11 "FFL Firearms Inventory Theft / Loss Report" were completed on August 2nd, 2016 and submitted via fax to the NTC by the FFL. All firearms previously "not acquired" were entered into the A & D record. All firearms dispositions previously "not reported" were located and logged out of the A & D record. All "incorrect" serial numbers were corrected within the A & D record.

2. **27 CFR 478.102(a)**

Nature of violation:

The Licensee failed to conduct a NICS criminal background check on a purchaser prior to the transfer of a firearm.

- On form, the licensee failed to conduct a NICS criminal background check prior to the transfer of a firearm (Reference Exhibit # (b)(3) 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552
- On forms, the FFL allowed a purchaser to utilize a State issued firearms permit issued more than five (5) years earlier as a valid NICS exemption for the purchase of a firearm (Reference Exhibit # 5-(b)(3) 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

Licensee's Response:

The licensee stated that he just forgot to record the NICS information on the form with regard to one (1) of the forms. With regard to the other ten (10) forms, the FFL stated that he had obtained a "valid" state issued MS Firearms Permit and recorded the information on the ATF Form 4473 and was unaware of the requirement per ATF regulations that the permit must have been issued within the past five (5) years prior to the purchase of the firearm to be valid per 27 CFR 478.102(d) (ii).

Corrective Action:

Investigator (b)(6) instructed the FFL to always conduct a NICS criminal background check on each individual purchaser prior to the transfer of a firearm. Investigator (b)(6) instructed the FFL that any State issued Firearms Permit utilized for an NICS exemption to the criminal background check must have been issued not more than five (5) years earlier by the state where the transfer is to take place.

On July 29th, 2016, Investigator (b)(6) conducted a MS JUST / NICS check on each individual purchaser which showed no prohibiting information.

The FFL now has a review system in place to verify that a NICS criminal background check was conducted on the purchaser prior to the transfer of a firearm. The FFL now has a review system in place to verify that all State issued firearms permit utilized as a NICS exemption to the criminal background checks were issued prior to five (5) years ago and that this information is properly recorded on the ATF Form 4473 prior to the transfer of a firearm.

The licensee failed to record required NICS information on ATF Form 4473 prior to the transfer of a firearm.

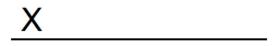
The FFL stated that he just missed seeing these errors on the forms during the form review and would do a better job at reviewing the form for any errors prior to transfer of the firearm.
