Warning Letter requested. No recall recommended. No referrals were submitted.



1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On July 19, 2016, ATF IOI (b) (6) visited the business premise of Shepherdsville Jewelry & Pawn, LLC for the purpose of conducting a Disposition Emphasis Compliance Inspection and an Amended Application Inspection on the Type 02 Federal Firearms License # 4-61-029-02-9G-05542 with an expiration date of July 1, 2019. The business is a limited liability company in which Jerry Foster is listed as owner and sole responsible person. Jerry Foster's identity was verified by Kentucky Driver's License #(b)(6) . Jerry Foster was interviewed and the on-site inspection began. The inspection period is July 19, 2015 to present. Advance notice was provided due to the change of address on the Amended Application. Jerry Foster submitted an Amended Application to change his premise/mailing address from 189 Adam Shepherd Parkway, Unit 17, Shepherdsville, Ky. 40165 to 189 Adam Shepherd Parkway, Unit 10, Shepherdsville, Ky. 40165. IOI (b) (6) contacted Shepherdsville Planning and Zoning Officer (b)(6) who stated the proposed activity was approved at the new location. The licensee stated the landlord approved of the proposed activity and provided a copy of the lease. The Amended Application was reviewed with the licensee. No changes were made. Jerry Foster stated they had to move out of the old premise by the beginning of August. Louisville II Supervisor (b) (6) approved the address change. FLS now reflects the new address of 189 Adam Shepherd Parkway, Unit 10, Shepherdsville, Ky. 40165. A separate assignment was not created for the Amended Application Inspection.

Business Profile:

Shepherdsville Jewelry & Pawn primarily conducts retail sales of firearms and pawn redemptions. The licensee estimated (b)(4) of firearm transfers are pawn redemptions and (b)(4) of firearm transfers are retail sales. The licensee stated they do not deal in consignments, conduct internet sales, conduct gunsmithing activity or sell firearms at gun shows. The business premise is a commercial storefront located in an urban area of Shepherdsville, Ky. at 189 Adam Shepherd Parkway, Unit 10. A Type 02 FFL is the appropriate license for the type of business activity conducted. The licensee currently maintains 194 firearms in inventory. This FFL acquired (b)(4) firearms during the previous year. Handguns account for (b)(4) of the business and long guns account for transfers and new firearms account for approximately of transfers. Ownership and Control:

As previously stated, the business is a limited liability company in which Jerry Foster is listed as owner and sole responsible person. Jerry Foster stated he owns 100% of the business. No changes in ownership/control reported. The KY Secretary of State database lists this LLC as active and in good standing. (See Exhibit 1- LLC Information) No hidden ownership is suspected.

Variance:

No variance requests were submitted as a result of this inspection.

2 - Recommendation

The current inspection disclosed 10 violations of the Gun Control Act which warrants a recommendation of Warning Letter due to the licensee accepting a non-qualifying state permit as a substitute for the NICS check in one instance. Warning Letter requested. No recall recommended. No referrals were submitted.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

The licensee maintains a computerized A & D record which is in the correct format. The licensee stated they have been conducting an inventory for comparison to the A & D record on an annual basis. There was a tag system set up which would reference a particular firearm in the physical inventory with the A & D records. The licensee stated the acquisitions and dispositions are typically entered into the bound book at the time of the transaction. The licensee's procedures with regards to the inventory and A & D

record need to show improvement as there were eight errors disclosed during the current inspection.

At the time of the inspection, there were 194 firearms in physical inventory and there were firearms on hand according to the licensee's A & D records. A 100% inventory was conducted on the firearms.

Firearms located on commercial invoices and pawn tickets were compared to the A & D record. No discrepancies disclosed.

ATF F 4473s during the inspection period were compared to the A & D record. No discrepancies disclosed.

The error rate for failing to timely and/or correctly record acquisitions is 2.2%. The error rate for failing to timely and/or correctly record dispositions is 0%.

After the final reconciliation, the following violations of 27 CFR 478.125(e) regarding the inventory and A & D record were reported on the Report of Violations: Licensee incorrectly recorded a firearm acquisition in the A & D record in instances. Licensee failed to record a firearm acquisition in the A & D record in instances. 5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

Each salesclerk is responsible for the proper completion of ATF Forms 4473 at the time of the transaction. The licensee verifies the ID of the purchaser, enters the licensee information and signs the form. There were errors disclosed during the current inspection which were related to the identification section. There were errors related to the certification section. The licensee currently maintains their ATF F 4473s in chronological order. The licensee maintains the denials separately. The licensee failed to maintain ATF F 4473s during the inspection period. Overall, the error rate for proper completion of the ATF F 4473 was 13.2% during the inspection period. The licensee's procedures with regards to the ATF F 4473 need to show improvement. There are instances where a firearm is shipped to a licensee outside the business on behalf of a customer. In these instances, the licensee obtains a certified copy of the recipient dealer's FFL and a file copy is maintained.

The review period covered one year (July 19, 2015 to present). All transfers for this period (317 ATF F 4473s) were reviewed. There were deficiencies noted on These violations included the following:
