## 1 - Introduction

### Inspection Profile:

IOI (b) (6) conducted this DE firearms compliance inspection on Red Arrow Inc., t/a *Red Arrow Firearms*, located at 4683 James Madison Highway, in the town of Fork Union, VA.

This inspection covered the inspection period of 12/28/14 through 12/28/15. The onsite inspection began on 12/28/15 and ended on 12/30/15. This is the first compliance inspection on this licensee. Vice President Katherine Campbell was identified by verification of her Virginia driver's license. Advance notice was not given, per ATF guidelines. A closing conference was conducted on 12/30/15 with the FFL.

### Business Profile:

The business premises are located in the Fork Union Masonic Lodge, located directly across Route 6 from Fork Union Military Academy. *Red Arrow Firearms* is a company that is operated by husband-wife team Donald and Katherine Campbell. Their business is based on Mr. Campbell's avid bow hunting skills. These skills are demonstrated in their "hunting reality" TV show on the Outdoors channel on national television; this TV show is called "*Red Arrow TV*". The primary sponsor of their TV show is Diamondback Firearms. Donald Campbell travels nationwide for the TV show primarily the last half of the year. Katherine Campbell does the marketing, advertising, accounting and paperwork for the business. She also makes all his travel arrangements for the TV show.

The business sells firearms and hunting accessories. Licensee acquired (b) (4) firearms during the last 12 months, consisting of (b) (4) handguns and (b) (4) long guns. Licensee disposed of (b) (4) firearms, consisting of (b) (4) handguns and (b) (4) long gun.

The FFL special orders firearms for friends and makes sales "by word of mouth". They retain a firearms inventory of less than twenty firearms. The primary firearm supplier is Diamondback Firearms. Firearms are sold new and at retail. Licensee does not participate in gun shows. No business is conducted via the internet. There is no other business conducted on the premises, nor are there any other ATF licenses held by this licensee. There are no off-site storage locations. The business is properly zoned with Fluvanna County.

IOI (b) (6) verified that the business holds a Type 01 ATF Federal Firearms License that expires on 7/1/17. Licensee was issued on 6/29/14. IOI (b) (6)

*Red Arrow Firearms, Inc.* is a corporation in good standing that was formed in the State of Virginia on 5/19/14.

The only Responsible Persons and Officers for the corporation are: President: Donald Campbell; Vice-President: Katherine Campbell and Secretary: Michael Kuhn. Stock is divided between Donald and Katherine Campbell as Donald – (b)(4) and Katherine (b)(4). There were no indications of hidden ownership.

There was one change to the Responsible Persons information – **See Section 2 - Recommendations** for further information.

There are no variances on file for this licensee and none were requested during this inspection.

## **2 - Recommendation**

## **4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory**

FFL had (b)(3) Pub Law 112-25 log book for its firearms inventory. The record book appeared in the proper format, however, there were discrepancies in the required information being accurate and entries timely made. A full firearms inventory count was conducted on 12/28/15. There were (b)(3) Pub Law 112-25 firearms in the inventory. The A & D book had (b)(3) (b)(3) open dispositions. All firearms in inventory were traced through the licensee's A & D books. During the inventory count, there were (b)(3) Pub Law 112-25 late dispositions discovered in this comparison. IOI (b)(6) described this A & D book discrepancy under **Violations, Section 14, item #1 and Report of Violations (ATF F5030.5), item #1.**

There were no theft/loss reports submitted during the inspection period or as a result of this inspection. There were no indications of trafficking, firearms with obliterated serial numbers or illegal firearms observed during the inspection.

Ms Campbell stated that she immediately records all firearms acquisitions and dispositions into their log book. She stated that she does not take a firearms inventory because of the small amount of firearms they have in stock. IOI (b) (6) suggested to the FFL that they take at least a semi-annual firearms inventory comparing the firearm to its book entry.

## 5 - ATF Forms 4473 – NICS & Other Dispositions

The ATF Forms 4473 are filed chronologically. A total of (b)(3)Pub Law 112-55 12 ATF Forms 4473 were executed during the inspection period of 12/28/14 – 12/28/15. IOI (b) (6) examined all the Forms 4473 during the inspection period. There were discrepancies discovered in this examination. There was (b)(3)Pub Law 112-55 purchaser to whom a firearm was transferred with no corresponding F4473 being completed or background check performed for this transfer. IOI (b) (6) described these ATF Forms 4473 discrepancies under Violations, Section 14, ite 3 and Report of Violations, items #s 2-3. Also, see Worksheet #2 (ATF Form 4473 Review Worksheet)

There were no denied firearm sales during the inspection period. There were no gun show sales or sales to law enforcement officers noted during this inspection. During the inspection period, licensee conducted (b)(3)Pub Law 112-55 125 firearm transfers to (b)(3)Pub Law 112-55 125 other FFLs; all transfers were conducted properly.

IOI (b) (6) conducted NICS verification by comparing five (5) NICS approval numbers, as provided by the Virginia State Police (VASP). The time frame of 11/13/15 – 12/9/15 was examined; no discrepancies were noted.

The Forms 4473 are completed by Ms. Campbell. She also does a second review of the forms. The forms are then filed in chronological order.

## 6 – Multiple Sales

There was (b)(3)Pub Law 112-55 multiple sale made during the inspection period involving (b)(3)Pub Law 112-55 125 § 552 pistols. This multiple sale was properly reported.

## 7 – Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

IOI (b) (6) examined the licensee's records to determine if there was any presence of trafficking or straw purchase indicators. No individual purchasers were identified as traffickers, straw purchasers, suspicious or prohibited persons during her examination of the FFL's records. No referrals were made during this inspection.

## 8 – Trace Activity

The trace history report revealed no traces associated with this licensee. Licensee only deals with new firearms, so no secondary market was conducted with this FFL.

Licensee does not deal in NFA weapons. He is not an importer, collector, nor manufacturer of firearms.

## **10 - Referrals**

No referrals were generated from this inspection.

## **11 - Other**

There was no intelligence information received on this FFL from ATF sources for this inspection. The FFL was compliant with the YHSA; the poster was displayed and FFL was handing out the YHSA pamphlets to all customers to whom they disposed a handgun.

During this inspection, Katherine Campbell stated to IOI (b) (6) that they want to move their business premises approximately one mile east of the current business premises. This location is 5264 James Madison Highway in Fork Union, VA, their former residence. IOI (b) (6) told her that she would have to check with zoning to see if operating their firearms business from this new location met Fluvanna County zoning ordinances. On 12/28/15, IOI (b) (6) e-mailed (b) (6), Zoning Officer with Fluvanna County about zoning for the new location. (b) (6) stated that the zoning at the proposed new business premises is currently zoned R-1. The FFL would have to get this location rezoned to B-1 to allow for retail sales. On 12/30/15, IOI (b) (6) conducted the closing conference with Ms. Campbell. IOI (b) (6) told Ms. Campbell the zoning information she received from (b) (6). Ms. Campbell told IOI (b) (6) that she had already contacted (b) (6). He stated the process of rezoning could take up to three months' time. IOI (b) (6) told Ms. Campbell that they could not operate from the proposed business premises until zoning approved of the new location. Once zoning approved the new location, IOI (b) (6) told Ms. Campbell that they would have to apply for an amended firearms license from ATF to receive the new FFL license reflecting the change of address on the license in order to operate at the new location. Ms. Campbell stated to IOI (b) (6) that she understood this and will apply to get the proposed business premises rezoned immediately. IOI (b) (6) gave Ms Campbell an Application for an Amended Federal Firearms License (ATF F5300.38) to complete once zoning is cleared with the county. IOI (b) (6) told Ms Campbell to contact her with any questions she may have on this process.

## **12 - Closing Actions**

The closing conference was held on 12/30/15. Vice President Katherine Campbell was present for this meeting. ATF laws and regulations were explained and reviewed with her.

IOI (b) (6) did not leave an information packet with the FFL. IOI (b) (6) asked to see the information packet left with the FFL during the application inspection conducted by her in June 2014. They had all the information from the previous inspection that IOI (b) (6) was prepared to leave them during this inspection. IOI (b) (6) did discuss and explain the information packet with the FFL.

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Items discussed during the closing conference included the inspection findings and a review of the proper completion of the ATF Form 4473. Topics reviewed included the reporting of firearm thefts to ATF and the theft form, proper completion of the ATF Form 4473 and the Acquisition and Disposition Bound Book, multiple handgun and straw purchase sales, Youth Handgun Safety Act, secure gun storage, Child Safety Lock Act guidelines, regulations regarding firearm possession within a school zone and ATF right of entry.

The *Acknowledgement of ATF Rules and Regulations Worksheet* was reviewed and executed. See Exhibit 1

**Nature of Violation:** The licensee, by and through its agents and employees, failed to timely and/or accurately record the disposition of (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552 firearms. There were (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552 late dispositions discovered in this inspection. They were the following: (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

**Licensee's Response:** FFL stated that she thought she had put all the required information into the log book. FFL said that these late dispositions were completely overlooked by her.

**Licensee's Response:** Katherine Campbell stated that her husband Donald received some firearms into his personal collection and somehow this corporate firearm got mixed in with his personal collection. He sold the firearm to (b)(6) thinking he didn't have to complete an ATF F4473 or complete a background check for this firearm transfer.
