This letter is a follow-up to the warning conference held with you on August 18, 2016. During this conference, the violations cited during the inspection covering the period 5/26/15 to 5/26/16 and the necessary corrective action to prevent the violation(s) from reoccurring were discussed.

You were given the opportunity to comment on the violations and what specific action you have taken to ensure that the violations will not reoccur. With respect to the violations cited below, we are providing a summary of your response to each violation.

You are reminded that future violations, repeat or otherwise, could be viewed as willful and may result in the revocation of your license. You may anticipate further inspections to ensure your compliance.

#### **Inspection Profile:**

On May 26, 2016, Industry Operations Investigators (IOI) (b)(6) and (b)(6) commenced a compliance inspection of A&J Arms Inc. (A&J Arms) based on a special request assignment (referral) received for Jerry Ganz (FFL 6-13-33227). The Jerry Ganz referral generated a full compliance inspection of A&J Arms. Refer to U.I. #765060-2016-0126.

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) met with the owner of A&J Arms, Arden Frazin. Mr. Frazin identified himself with a New York State Driver's License and New York State Pistol Permit.

The inspection period was May 26, 2015 to May 25, 2016.

#### **Business Profile:**

A&J Arms holds a Manufacturer of Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices license. The business is operated from a commercial storefront located in an urban area of Rockland County. A&J Arms acquired approximately firearms and disposed of approximately firearms in the last 12 months.

A&J Arms is in the business of buying new and used long guns and hand guns and selling to the public, law enforcement and at gun shows in the New York area. A&J Arms uses the manufacturing license to occasionally convert firearms to make them New York compliant. Mr. Frazin stated that he did not manufacture or convert any firearms during the inspection period.

#### 4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) received a special request assignment (referral) from the Hartford Area Office to obtain information on firearms sold at out of state gun shows by Jerry Ganz (FFL 6-13-33227). On May 25, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) visited Mr. Ganz business premises located at 176 Route 304, Bardonia, New York. The premises was found to be empty and no forwarding information provided. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) and (b)(6) and (b)(6) and (b)(6) then went to Jerry Ganz's residence located at 14 Palisades Court, Pomona, New York. Mr. Ganz was not available at the time; therefore an appointment was scheduled. On May 26, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) met Mr. Ganz at his residence. Mr. Ganz stated that he is no longer in business and his original license was mailed to the Federal Firearms Licensing Center. Mr. Ganz stated that the majority of his records were destroyed in a flood and that his remaining records and firearms inventory are with A&J Arms located at 304 Route 304, Bardonia, New York. Refer to U.I. #765060-2016-0126.

The Jerry Ganz referral generated a full compliance inspection of A&J Arms.

On May 26, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) generated a full compliance inspection of A&J Arms. A&J Arms and Jerry Ganz were collocated at the same business premises, 176 Route 304, Bardonia, New York. In September 2015, A&J Arms relocated to 304 Route 304, Bardonia, New York.

Two of the A/D books were firearms acquired by Jerry Ganz in 2014 and up to June 2015. Mr. Frazin stated that he continued to use Jerry Ganz's A/D books since he acquired the inventory from Jerry Ganz and there were still open entries in the A/D books.

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) conducted an inventory of the open entries in Jerry Ganz's A/D books. There were open entries in Jerry Ganz's A/D books entitled Book #1 and Book #2. Intercontinues of the firearms were acquired by Jerry Ganz and Intercontinues of the firearms were acquired by Jerry Ganz and Intercontinues of the firearms were acquired by A&J Arms from July 1, 2015 to the end of the book dated November 2, 2015. As a result of the inspection there were information firearms missing in inventory which were acquired by Jerry Ganz. Refer to U.I. #765060-2016-0126.

A total of firearms were transferred from Jerry Ganz's A/D books to A&J Arms A/D books.

On June 1, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) commenced a full inventory of A&J Arms. A&J Arms had a total of firearms in his two A/D books and an additional firearms transferred from Jerry Ganz's A/D books. A total of 421 firearms were in inventory. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) examined the firearms and compared them to the A/D books. There were three firearms that the licensee failed to record the disposition in the A/D books. An ATF Inventory Theft/Loss Report was filed for missing/lost firearm (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552 Reference Exhibit 1 – ATF Inventory Theft/Loss Report.

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) did not generate any referrals.

## 11 - <u>Other</u>

On May 25, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) received a referral from the Hartford Area Office to obtain information on firearms sold at out of state gun shows by Jerry Ganz (U.I. #765060-2016-0126). IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) visited the business premises of Jerry Ganz located at 176 Route 304, Bardonia, New York and found the premises to be empty. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) then visited Mr. Ganz at his residence located at 14 Palisades Court, Mount Ivy, New York 10910. Mr. Ganz was not available; therefore an appointment was scheduled for the following day.

On May 26, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) met with Mr. Ganz at his residence. Mr. Ganz stated that he is no longer in business and his original Federal Firearms License (#6-13-087-01-7D-33227) was mailed to ATF in April or May of 2015. Mr. Ganz stated that he does not have any of the required records prior to May 2014 because they were destroyed in a flood. Mr. Ganz stated that A&J Arms acquired his inventory of firearms. Mr. Ganz was a responsible person of A&J Arms. Mr. Frazin removed Jerry Ganz as responsible person on February 25, 2016. Refer to U.I. #765060-2016-0126.

## 12 - Closing Actions

On June 21, 2016, IOI (b)(6) conducted a closing conference and issued a Report of Violations Arden Frazin of A&J Arms Inc. IOI (b)(6) explained to Mr. Frazin the

#### 4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) received a special request assignment (referral) from the Hartford Area Office to obtain information on firearms sold at out of state gun shows by Jerry Ganz (FFL 6-13-33227). On May 25, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) visited Mr. Ganz business premises located at 176 Route 304, Bardonia, New York. The premises was found to be empty and no forwarding information provided. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) then went to Jerry Ganz's residence located at (b)(6)

(b)(6) Mr. Ganz was not available at the time; therefore an appointment was scheduled. On May 26, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) met Mr. Ganz at his residence. Mr. Ganz stated that he is no longer in business and his original license was mailed to the Federal Firearms Licensing Center. Mr. Ganz stated that the majority of his records were destroyed in a flood and that his remaining records and firearms inventory are with A&J Arms located at 304 Route 304, Bardonia, New York. Refer to U.I. #765060-2016-0126.

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A total of firearms were transferred from Jerry Ganz's A/D books to A&J Arms A/D books.

On June 1, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) commenced a full inventory of A&J Arms. A&J Arms had a total of 313 firearms in his two A/D books and an additional firearms transferred from Jerry Ganz's A/D books. A total of 421 firearms were in inventory. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) examined the firearms and compared them to the A/D books. There were firearms that the licensee failed to record the disposition in the A/D books. An ATF Inventory Theft/Loss Report was filed for missing/lost firearm: (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552. Reference Exhibit 1 – ATF Inventory Theft/Loss Report.

## 27 CFR 478.125(e) - Violation #1

• Licensee failed to record the disposition of firearms in the Acquisition/Disposition book.

## 5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) conducted a full examination of the Firearms Transaction Records (4473 forms) on file for the inspection period. The licensee had (b)(6) and (b)(6) examined all of the 4473 forms on file for the period. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) examined all of the 4473 forms on file for the period. The licensee maintains their 4473 forms in chronological order.

The NICS Audit Log was reviewed and covered the period April 7, 2016 to June 6, 2016. Per the NICS Audit Log there were 129 proceed NICS transactions conducted during the period. There were 7 denied transactions on file for the period. IOI (b)(6) and (b)(6) compared the NICS transactions to the 4473 forms and did not identify any discrepancies.

A Report of Violations was issued for the following:

## 27 CFR 478.21(a) - Violation #2

- Licensee failed to require the purchaser to complete Question 11a on the 4473 form on occasion.
- Licensee failed to record the information under Questions 31, 32, 33 and 35 on occasions.

## 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1) - Violation #3

• Licensee failed to require the purchaser to complete Question 17 on the 4473 form on occasion.

27 CFR 478.124(c)(5) - Violation #4

• Licensee failed to complete Questions 34 and 36 on the 4473 form on occasions.

## 6 - Multiple Sales

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) examined in multiple sales involving in firearms during the inspection period. There were multiple sales involving in firearms reported on the Crime Gun Analysis Branch Master Query. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) discovered that the licensee failed to execute the Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers on in occasions involving in firearms. The Report of Multiple Sale form was prepared and faxed to the National Tracing Center.

A Report of Violations was issued for the following:

27 CFR 478.126a - Violation #5

• Licensee failed to execute the Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers on ccasions involving firearms.

## 7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) did not identify any suspicious/prohibited purchasers.

## 8 - Trace Activity

There were no traces reported on the Crime Gun Analysis Branch Master Query during the inspection period.

A random sample of secondary market firearms were run through OpenFox. No derogatory information was discovered.

## 9 - <u>NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer</u>

The licensee does not sell NFA weapons, import or collect firearms. A&J Arms has not manufactured any firearms since they obtained their license in April 2015. IOI (b)(6) reviewed the Annual Firearms Manufacturing and Exportation Report filed by the licensee on March 10, 2016.

## 10 - Referrals

IOIs(b)(6) and (b)(6) did not generate any referrals.

## 11 - <u>Other</u>

On May 25, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) received a referral from the Hartford Area Office to obtain information on firearms sold at out of state gun shows by Jerry Ganz (U.I. #765060-2016-0126). IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) visited the business premises of Jerry Ganz located at 176 Route 304, Bardonia, New York and found the premises to be empty. IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) then visited Mr. Ganz at his residence located at 14 Palisades Court, Mount Ivy, New York 10910. Mr. Ganz was not available; therefore an appointment was scheduled for the following day.

On May 26, 2016, IOIs (b)(6) and (b)(6) met with Mr. Ganz at his residence. Mr. Ganz stated that he is no longer in business and his original Federal Firearms License (#6-13-087-01-7D-33227) was mailed to ATF in April or May of 2015. Mr. Ganz stated that he does not have any of the required records prior to May 2014 because they were destroyed in a flood. Mr. Ganz stated that A&J Arms acquired his inventory of firearms. Mr. Ganz was a responsible person of A&J Arms. Mr. Frazin removed Jerry Ganz as responsible person on February 25, 2016. Refer to U.I. #765060-2016-0126.

## 12 - Closing Actions

On June 21, 2016, IOI (b)(6) conducted a closing conference and issued a Report of Violations Arden Frazin of A&J Arms Inc. IOI (b)(6) explained to Mr. Frazin the

importance of maintaining the required ATF records; i.e. maintaining the Acquisition/Disposition book, completing the 4473 forms, conducting NICS checks, completing and submitting the Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers and the ATF Inventory Theft/Loss report.

Mr. Frazin signed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations and a copy was provided. Refer to Exhibit 4 - Report of Violations and Exhibit 5 - Acknowledgement of Regulations.

#### 13 - Violations

#### 1. 27 CFR 478.125(e)

#### Nature of Violation:

• Licensee failed to record the disposition of firearms in the Acquisition/Disposition book.

#### Licensee's Response:

Licensee stated that he believes someone stole the missing firearm because he does not recall selling or transferring the firearm.

#### **Corrective Action:**

An ATF Inventory Theft/Loss Report was submitted for firearm that could not be located: (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

#### 2. 27 CFR 478.21(a)

#### Nature of Violation:

- Licensee failed to require the purchaser to complete Question 11a on the 4473 form on occasion.
- Licensee failed to record the information under Questions 31, 32, 33 and 35 on occasions.

#### Licensee's Response:

Licensee stated that he was probably busy that day and failed to include the information. Mr. Franzin stated that he will ensure that the Firearms Transaction Record is completed in the future. Corrective Action:

The licensee was instructed on how to complete the Firearms Transaction Record. The licensee made a copy of the Firearms Transaction Record and completed Questions 31, 32, 33 and 35.

3. 27 CFR 478.125(c)(1)

Nature of Violation:

• Licensee failed to require the purchaser to complete Question 17 on the 4473 form on occasion.

Licensee's Response:

The licensee stated that he did not realize the date was missing. Mr. Frazin stated that he will comply in the future.

Corrective Action: The licensee was instructed on how to complete the Firearms Transaction Record.

## 4. 27 CFR 478.124(c)(5)

Nature of Violation:

Licensee failed to complete Questions 34 and 36 on the 4473 form on occasions.

Licensee's Response:

The licensee stated that he was probably busy in the store that day and failed to complete Questions 34 and 36. Mr. Frazin stated that he will ensure that the Firearms Transaction Record is completed in the future.

Corrective Action: Licensee made a difference of the Firearms Transaction Record and signed and dated Questions 34 and 36.

# 5. 27 CFR 478.126(a)

Nature of Violation:

• Licensee failed to execute the Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers on ccasions involving firearms.

#### Licensee's Response:

The licensee stated that he is positive he completed the ATF F 3310.4 forms for the transactions, but failed to maintain a copy. Mr. Frazin stated that he will ensure that the forms are completed in the future.

#### **Corrective Action:**

On June 14, 2016, Mr. Frazin completed the ATF F 3310.4 and faxed the form to ATF.
