

1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On Wednesday, August 19, 2015, Industry Operations Investigators (IOIs) (b) (6) initiated an unannounced firearms compliance inspection at the licensed premises of Rick's Gun and Pawn LLC located at 536 Rowlandsville Rd., Conowingo, MD 21918. During the inspection, the IOI's interviewed Ms. Winona Hancock, Secretary/Treasurer and Mr. Richard Smith, President. Ms. Hancock and Mr. Smith both provided a valid Maryland Driver's Licenses for identification. Mr. Smith was only available for the closing conference. The inspection period was August 19, 2014 to August 19, 2015. On Friday, August 28, 2015, IOI's (b) (6) held a closing conference with Ms. Hancock and Mr. Smith. Also present during the inspection was(b) (6) Ms. Hancock's (D) (6) spends his leisure time at the store with (b) (6) He is currently in the IOI (b) (6) (b) (6) (b) (6) was present for one day to assist with conducting the inventory. Area

Supervisor, (b) (6) was present for one day to ussist with conducting the inventory. Area assist IOIs with their review of the licensee's paperwork. Advance notice of the inspection was not given to the licensee.

Business Profile:

Rick's Gun and Pawn LLC operates as a pawn broker and also conducts retail sales of jewelry, electronics, tools, musical equipment, firearms and ammunition. They sell new and used firearms.

The licensed premises is a commercially zoned standalone building that operates as a retail store and pawn shop in Cecil County, and is properly zoned for their current operations.

In the last 12 months, the licensee acquired approximatel (b) (4) firearms, and disposed of approximately (b) (4) during the same period. According to the licensee (b) (4) of the sales during this period were retail sales. Approximately (b) (4) f the firearms transferred by the licensee were used and the remaining (b) (4) were new. The licensee has not conducted business at gun shows during the inspection period, however, they do intend to participate in a local show in the month of October of 2015. Licensee maintains a website <u>www.ricksgunpawn.com</u>. The website is used to advertise the business, and does not contain photos or prices of firearms for sale. The licensee does not use this website to sell firearms, however they do occasionally sell guns using gunbroker.com. Ricks Gun and Pawn LLC obtained their original Federal Firearms License on 12/5/2006.

No unrelated business is conducted that the licensed premises, and the licensee is not associated with any other business. The licensee is in compliance with state and local law. The licensee maintains the appropriate Maryland Trader's License and Maryland Sales & Tax Use License. No firearms are stored away from the premises.

Ownership and Control:

The license is owned by Ricks Gun and Pawn, LLC. IOI (b) (6) queried the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation (SDAT) website and found the LLC to be active and in good standing under Department ID (b) (6) This is a two member charter with Mr. Richard A. Smith, serving as President and Ms. Winona D. Hancock serving as Secretary and Treasurer. Both LLC members are listed as the only responsible persons on the license. Their attorney (b) (6) is listed as resident agent for the company. There have been no unreported changes to the ownership. Hidden ownership is not suspected.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

At the time of inspection, the licensee's physical inventory consisted of 629 firearms, and the number of open dispositions in the acquisition and disposition (A&D) records was als there was a difference of the irearms. To reconcile the discrepancy, IOIs conducted a full inventory of firearms in physical inventory against all open dispositions in the licensee's records and discovered the licensee failed to record the disposition of a firearm in the Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record Book not later than the seventh day following the date of the transaction is a stances referenced below.

To reconcile the above discrepancies, the licensee recorded the dispositions on 8/19/2015. <u>Reference Violation 1 and Worksheet 1</u>.

No thefts or losses occurred during the inspection period. The licensee maintains bound paper records. The A&D records are in the proper format. The entries were found to be accurate however, not timely made as referenced in above violation. IOIs did not trace any firearms through the required records. No firearms with obliterated serial numbers and no illegal firearms were discovered.

IOIs (b) (6) and (b) (6) reviewed the licensee's standard operating procedures with Ms. Hancock and Mr. Smith. When a firearm is acquired, Ms. Hancock assigns it a log number and creates a ticket. Pawned firearms have a different ticketing system than other firearms acquired. The log books for pawn guns are separated from the log books

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for sales firearms. Once a log number is assigned, the ticket is immediately attached to the firearm, and the firearm is recorded as a new acquisition in the appropriate A&D book. Ms. Hancock then places the firearm either on display to be sold, or in the gun room for storage. When a firearm is sold or otherwise disposed, Ms. Hancock records the disposition, utilizing the ATF Form 4473, commercial record or the firearm itself, based on the type of transaction that has occurred.

Ms. Hancock stated a full inventory is conducted at least once a year in which 100% of the stores' firearms are accounted for through accounting and reconciliation. This is generally done every January or February. Mr. Smith does not generally spend time in the store and relies on Ms. Hancock to run the daily operations.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

The licensee completed approximatel approximatel ATF Forms 4473 during the inspection period. IOIs(b) (6) and(b) (6) eviewed 100% of the forms with the assistance of Area Supervisor(b) (6) The licensee maintains the forms chronologically by the type of background check conducted (i.e. by NICS transactions for sales and transfers of long guns, pawn redemptions, and consignment returns or by MD State Police run background checks for sales and transfers of handguns and other regulated firearms). Because their filing system falls outside of the guidelines prescribed by ATF, they obtained a variance from ATF to be able to continue this filing system. (See Variance subsection above) This examination yielded the following results:

- The licensee failed to ensure proper completion of ATF Form 4473, prior to making an over-the-counter transfer of a firearm to a nonlicensee. This occurred instances. Reference Violation 2, Worksheet 2 and Exhibit C.

Forms indicating denials were reviewed by IOI (b) (6) and found to be filed properly. In the past year transactions were denied by NICS or the Maryland State Police. These forms all list the firearm(s) (which the customer was attempting to purchase) and their corresponding A&D Record number. IOI (b) (6) compared these forms to the A&D Record to determine if the firearm was sold in a straw purchase. Indicators of a connection include the following:

- The amount of time between the denial and when the gun was sold.
- The proximity of the addresses between the parties involved in the denial and the sale.
- Name similarity of the parties involved.
- Trace data

IOI(**b**) (**6**) found evidence of a straw purchase. Her findings were documented in section 7-Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers below.

The licensee sold firearms to police officers for official use in the inspection period. In each instance, the licensee obtained a certification letter on department letterhead signed by a person in authority within the agency. Area Supervisor(b) (6) and IOI (b) (6) reviewed the certification letters and each of them met the requirements of 27 CFR 478.134.

Prior to conducting the inspection, IOI (b) (6) received the NICS and Maryland State Police (MPS), background check numbers for the past year utilized in transactions by the licensee. NICS and MSP provided IOI (b) (6) wit as so in an action numbers associated with a "proceed" and "not disapproved" responses. The information was compared to the licensee's paperwork and no discrepancies were disclosed.

IOIs (b) (6) and (b) (6) reviewed the licensee's standard operating procedures relative to ATF Form 4473 completion and other dispositions with Ms. Hancock. She conducts all aspects of the business by herself. According to Ms. Hancock, when a customer wishes to purchase a firearm, she will have the potential purchaser complete an ATF Form 4473 (and Maryland State paperwork when applicable) and review their photo identification. She photocopies all identification provided and attaches the copy to the 4473. She then completes the remainder of the form including documenting the identification and background information. Prior to filing the forms, Ms. Hancock reviews the 4473 a second time for accuracy to insure no answers are incorrect, show prohibited status or omitted. Upon completion of the transaction, the paperwork is filed chronologically by Ms. Hancock in accordance to their approved variance. If a Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers (ATF Form 3310.4) is required, Ms. Hancock completes the form and submits a copy to the National Tracing

Center, the CLEO and retains a copy with the 4473. Once a transaction has occurred, the paperwork is immediately filed by Ms. Hancock. She will conduct a final review of the form to insure completion and accuracy. If the purchaser made a mistake on the paperwork, she will call them back to have them correct a copy of the form, in accordance with the instructions of the form. Ms. Hancock logs all firearms out of the A&D Record that are sold or otherwise disposed of.


Ms. Hancock stated that she is aware of how to look out for straw purchase indicators. If a straw purchase is suspected, paperwork is not initiated and the customer is instructed to leave the store. There was the store instance that occurred during the inspection period in which the licensee allowed a family member to pick up a firearm after the original customer was denied. The transaction was discovered by IOI(b)(6) and discussed in section 7 below.

6 - Multiple Sales

During the inspection period, the licensee reported is ultiple handgun sales involving handguns according to the information they reported to ATF Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB). The IOIs(b) (6) and Area Supervisor (b) (6) compared the information obtained from the ATF Violent Crime Analysis Branch (VCAB) to the licensee's forms for the inspection period and determined that no unreported multiple handgun sales occurred during this period.

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

With the assistance of Area Supervisor (b) (6) and IOI (b) (6) IOI (b) (6) selected firearm purchasers for criminal history queries. No prohibiting criminal information was disclosed. Review of the ATF Forms 4473 on file (including the denied forms) for the inspection period and review of the A&D record disclose suspicious transaction discussed below.



internal policies to ensure that they are not associated with possible straw transactions. He suggested refusing associates from acquiring firearms that the original transferee was prohibited from acquiring based on denied NICS results. He further suggested

creating a document where the transferee could sign to certify that they understand the legal ramifications that could result from being associated with a straw transaction. No referral was generated since the firearms were in the possession of the pawn shop at the time of the closing conference. The licensee was reminded that transferring firearms to associates of denied purchasers can be viewed as a crime, and to be very careful in determining the potential of a straw transaction.

8 - Trace Activity

In the last 12 months, the licensee was associated with the licensee. In each instance the firearm was successfully traced through the licensee. None of the traces were unsuccessful, (b)(3) - 112 Public Law 55 125 Stat 552

The licensee acquired approximate sed firearms during the inspection period, and sold approximate IOI (b) (6) querie sed firearms in the NCIC database through Open Fox, yielding negative results.

9 - <u>NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer</u>

The licensee does not deal in NFA firearms. The licensee does not import or manufacture firearms, and is not a collector of curios and relics.

10 - <u>Referrals</u>

No referrals were generated as a result of this inspection.

11 - Other

Though the licensee does not maintain a website locatable through a google search, a google search for "Rick's Gun and Pawn, Conowingo, MD" will return a webpage related to the licensee's business. The webpage, gunstores.net/ricksgunand pawn21918, appears to have been created by **(b)** (4)

(b) (4) This webpage is administered by GunStores.net and can be found via a link located on (b) (4) The webpage contains the licensee's former address (311 Conowingo Rd., Conowingo, MD 21918) and email for the licensee, however the phone number is correct. This webpage advertises specific firearms for sale, and gives the appearance that the listed firearms are being sold by Rick's Gun and Pawn. Based on the above information, it appears tha (b) (4) are considered and email information for FFLs to which they distribute firearms. The old address and email information for Rick's Gun and Pawn indicates that these webpages are not regularly updated. The licensee was not aware of this webpage on (b) (4)

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IOIs informed them of the webpage in their name. The licensee stated they will look into the matter but did not appear to be overly concerned.

12 - Closing Actions

On Friday, August 28, 2015, IOIs (b) (6) and (b) (6) conducted a closing conference with Ms. Hancock. At that time, a regulatory review was conducted, which included a review the Acknowledgement of the Federal Firearms Regulations form that was signed by IOI (b) (6) and Ms. Hancock. <u>Reference Exhibit E</u>. On that date, IOI (b) (6) issued a Report of Violations, which was also signed by both parties. At the conclusion of the closing conference, IOI (b) (6) and (b) (6) nswered questions from the licensee, then provided her with the following materials:

Failure to record the disposition of a firearm in the Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record Book not later than the seventh day following the date of the transaction. This occurred i stances, where the disposition was recorded on 8/19/2015 during the ATF inspection. Refer to the following transactions:



Nature of Violation:

Failure to verify the identity of the transferee by examining the identification document presented, and noting on the Form 4473 the type of identification used after examining the identification. This occurred in the instances.

In a instances, the licensee failed to record the information derived from official PCS Orders information in box 20b as prescribed. Reference ATF Newsletter March 2013 for clarification. Refer to the following transactions b3 Public Law 112-55 (125 Stat. 552)

In the remaining instance, the licensee accepted a government identification document that is valid in the state of Pennsylvania; however, no photograph was available on the document, and there was no combination of government issued documents to satisfy the Federal requirement that a photograph must be viewed by the licensee. In this instance, the customer was Amish and was exempt by the state from taking a photograph. Refer to

Licensee's Response:

The licensee stated that she will ensure PCS information is recorded in box 20b from now on, and will no longer accept government identification without a photograph. She said, "I thought it was okay because the state of Pennsylvania issued the Amish ID card based on his religious practices.

Corrective Action:

Corrective Action:

Record the date on which NICS is contacted as well as any response provided by the system on the form for all future transactions.

Failure to conduct a background check through NICS or the Maryland State Police prior to transacting a firearm integrated stances. In each instance, the disposition involved the same transferee who is the President and responsible person (RP) on this license. The license operates as a LLC.

Licensee's Response:

According to the licensee, she thought as President, the RP did not have to go through the NICS requirements. She obtained information from the Maryland State Police that

unincorporated business owners are exempt from NICS check and required paperwork to acquire firearms from their business inventory. The licensee was educated on the Federal requirements that require such checks be conducted, unless the licensee is a sole proprietor.

Corrective Action:

Ensure that a NICS check is conducted in accordance to the Federal requirements of the Gun Control Act (GCA), and the pertinent information is recorded on the ATF form prior to the transfer of a firearms, unless such transaction meets the exceptions to NICS check as prescribed.
