1 - Introduction

Inspection Profile:

On September 16, 2015 Industry Operations Investigators (IOI) (b) (6) and (b) (6) conducted an unannounced firearms compliance inspection on The Cop Shop. The inspection covered period of September 16, 2014 to September 16, 2015. IOI (b) (6) dentified and interviewed, President, James Samuel Walters Jr. and Office Manager (b) (6) by reviewing their current driver's licenses.

Business Profile:

The Cop Shop is located in a commercial storefront in Baltimore City, Maryland. The business premise is one level with a basement storeroom and is in compliance with Baltimore City Zoning. The Cop Shop has held a Federal Firearms License (FFL) Type 01, dealer in firearms, since February 11, 1986. The space is shared with an embroidery business operated by Mr. Walter's (b) (6) (b) (6) and Chesapeake Armory, owned by (b) (6) Chesapeake Armory operates at the premises as a gunsmith on behalf of The Cop Shop. IOIs (b) (6) nd (b) (6) have not determined at the close of the inspection whether an additional license is needed on behalf of Chesapeake Armory. IOI (b) (6) has left two (2) messages for (b) (6) mand has not yet received a response.

The Cop Shop is a dealer of firearms, ammunition, and other police supplies. The Cop Shop customer base is primarily current and retired, local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies and security firms, as well as the general public. The FFL does not hold any other ATF licenses or permits. The licensee does sell firearms regulated by the Maryland State Police and is compliant with the state requirements. The FFL holds the following state issued licenses.

- Maryland Regulated Firearms Dealers License
- Maryland Sales and Use Tax License
- State of Maryland Traders License

During the past 12 months, the licensee acquired (b) (4) irearms and disposed of (b) (4) firearms. Ownership and Control:

The Cop Shop is an incorporated entity registered with the State of Maryland (Department ID (b) (6) IOIs (b) (6) and (b) (6) ueried the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation (SDAT) website and found the company to be active and in good standing. The Resident Agent, James Samuel Walters Jr., serves as the President. There are no other corporate officers. There have not been any unreported changes and no hidden ownership is suspected. IOIs (b) (6) and (b) (6) ueried the Federal Licensing System (FLS) and the database is correct listing James Walters as the only listed responsible person.

Variance:

No variances are held by this licensee. After receiving notification of a recordkeeping violation for the maintenance of ATF Forms 4473, The licensee submitted a draft variance request to IOI(b) (6) for review prior to submission to ATF Headquarters. After IOI(b) (6) reviewed the draft and discussed the options with the licensee, the request was officially withdrawn.

4 - Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) Record - Inventory

The licensee maintains a handwritten acquisition and disposition record (A&D) as its primary record. An electronic version is maintained as a backup. The A&D record is maintained in the proper format. Generally the licensee accurately and timely maintained the A&D record. During the course of this inspection it was discovered that the licensee failed to accurately and/or timely maintain A&D record entries in instances. (Violation 4, Worksheet 1)

DIO Mike Fronczak granted IOIs(b) (6) and (b) (6) the permission to conduct a less than full physical inventory. However, upon the discovery of discrepancies IOIs were instructed to conduct a full physical inventory. 502 firearms were found in inventory. A review of the A&D record revealed (1997) open dispositions with a total of discrepancies before reconciliation. The licensee determined that (1999) open entry was opened in error. (1999) of the discrepancies were unresolved resulting in unaccounted for firearms which were reported as losses to ATF prior to the close of this inspection.

Cop Shop. (b) (6) primarily records the acquisitions and dispositions in the A&D record. Back-up records are kept on a computer which President James Walters is responsible for maintaining. The licensee assigns a sequential number to each firearm acquired. This sequential number corresponds to its respective line of entry recorded in the A&D record. The sequential number is also used as the ATF Form 4473 transaction serial number. The licensee also records the corresponding A&D page entry on the ATF Form 4473 for easy referencing when needed.

The licensee stated that they intend to conduct a regular inventory of firearms but had not yet completed one this calendar year.

5 - ATF Forms 4473 - NICS & Other Dispositions

The licensee maintains the forms first by year and month and then by firearms inventory number. The licensee was cited for not fully maintaining the ATF Forms 4473 chronologically, alphabetically, or numerically, as required by the regulations. The licensee considered submitting a variance to continue storing the ATF Forms 4473 in the current format. However, upon consultation with IOI (b) (6) the licensee decided to reorganize the forms to achieve regulatory compliance. (Violation 3)

A review of the forms disclosed the following violations:

instances the licensee failed to record the firearm information in required items 26 thru 30 on the ATF Forms 4473 for all multiple sales during the past twelve (12) months. In lieu of recording the required information on the ATF Forms 4473, the licensee recorded a reference to see the attached ATF Form 3310.4, Multiple Handgun Sales form. (Violation 5)

The licensee maintains a separate file, as required of denied ATF Form 4473. There were the second denied transactions during the inspection period. IOI (b) (6) reviewed each denied ATF Form 4473, searched for possible straw purchase conducted gun queries on the attempted firearm purchases. No results were yielded.

IOI (b) (6) requested the FFL Audit Logs for the last 60 days of the inspection period, from both the Maryland State Licensing Unit for Maryland state regulated transactions and the Crime Gun Analysis Branch for NICS transactions. Twelve (12) audit log transactions occurred during the last 60 days of the inspection period. Nine (9) of those transactions were Maryland state transactions and three (3) were FBI NICS transactions. All nine (9) of the Maryland state transactions resulted in "not disapproved". The three (3) FBI NICS transactions resulted in two (2) proceed and one (1) denied transaction. IOI (b) (6) and Area Supervisor (b) (6) erified that all firearms transactions were properly maintained by the licensee and that no possible straw purchase was identified for the denied transaction.

Other dispositions conducted by the licensee included transfers to both other licensees and law enforcement agencies. The transfers were found to be in compliance with the regulations and the licensee demonstrates knowledge of how to conduct these transfers.

IOIs(b) (6) and (b) (6) observed the internal controls that the licensee utilizes to maintain compliance with firearms regulations. President, James Walters(b) (6) Sales Associate, (b) (6) and Salesmen (b) (6) and (b) (6) and (b) (6) (b) (6) conducted firearms transactions, completed the required forms and maintained control of the inventory for the inspection period.

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(b) (6) primarily records the acquisitions and dispositions in the A&D record. Back-up records are kept on a computer which President James Walters is responsible for maintaining. James and (b) (6) Walters double-check the ATF Forms 4473 for accuracy and completeness.

The licensee assigns a sequential number to each firearm acquired. This sequential number corresponds to its respective line of entry recorded in the A&D record. The sequential number is also used as the ATF Form 4473 transaction serial number. The licensee also records the corresponding A&D page entry on the ATF Form 4473 for easy referencing when needed.

Security at the business premise consists of a monitored alarm system with four hidden call buttons in the event of a robbery, four (4) concrete reinforced steel beams as part of the from wall of the business premise, one entrance/exit, a steel cage just inside the door that is locked when the business is closed and two locked safes. Additionally, there is a metal gate on the exterior of the front entrance and glass display cases. There are also fire sensors on the premises.

6 – <u>Multiple Sales</u>

There wer set set to be the multiple sales transactions during the inspection period of September 16, 2014 to September 16, 2015. There were no unreported multiple sales found during the course of this inspection. Per regulatory requirements the licensee is attaching a copy of multiple sales form to each ATF Form 4473. However, it was discovered that the licensee was failing to fully record the multiple sales information as required onto the actual ATF Form 4473. (Report of Violations #5)

7 - Suspicious/Prohibited Purchasers

IOI(b) (6) onducted a background checks on the firearms purchasers and conducted eTrace and OpenFox gun queries on the firearms that were attempted to be purchased. No hits were found and no straw purchases are suspected.

IOI (b) (6) conducted background checks o purchasers and their firearms based on, foreign born status, distance traveled to the store, and type of firearms being purchased. No prohibiting information was found on any person queried and no gun acquired by these purchasers was found to be stolen or traced.

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8 – <u>Trace Activity</u>

There were set to be successful traces to the licensee and no unsuccessful traces during the investigation period of September 16, 2014 to September 16, 2015. During the past 12 months, the licensee acquired set licensee acquired set licensee used. The licensee disposed firearms during the past 12 months. Approximately set licensee disposed firearms were new and set licensee.

9 - <u>NFA/Importer/Collector/Manufacturer</u>

Prior to conducting the inspection, IOI(b) (6) ontacted the NFA Branch to determine if the FFL has any registered NFA wea he NFA Branch determined that there are no firearms registered to this licensee. The licensee does not conduct NFA, Importer, Collector, or Manufacturer activities.

10 - Referrals

No referrals were made during the course of this inspection.

11 - <u>Other</u>

The licensee meets the requirements of secure gun storage and the Youth Handgun Safety Act Notice by providing gun locks on all handgun sales.

12 - Closing Actions

On October 9, 2015 IOIs (b) (6) conducted a closing conference with the licensee. Mr. James Walters, President, and (b) (6) Office Manager, were present for the conference.

On October 9, 2015 IOI (b) (6) issued a Report of Violations and reviewed it with the Mr. and (b) (6) Valters. Mr. Walters signed the form and was provided with a copy.

On October 9, 2015 IOI (b) (6) reviewed the federal firearms laws and regulations utilizing the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations worksheet. IOI (b) (6) explained the protocol for recording background check dates for Maryland State Police checks, correct data to record when accepting active duty military members' identification, and accurately recording information on ATF Form 4473 for multiple sales. Mr. Walters signed and dated the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations worksheet certifying his understanding of the regulations that were explained to him. IOI (b) (6) also signed the form and provided Mr. Walters with a copy of the acknowledgment sheet. (Exhibit 1)

Additional material was not provided. However, the licensee was encouraged to use the ATF.gov website to stay abreast of federal regulatory changes and industry updates.

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Licensee's response:

The licensee states that he was unaware of the requirement to record dual addresses (both current physical address and base address cited on PCS Orders) for active duty military members.

Corrective action:

In the future, licensee will ensure the receipt of a fully completed ATF Form 4473 prior to the completion of background checks and transfer of firearms. The licensee will document all necessary information when accepting a military identification (i.d) of active duty military members. Additionally, it was explained to the licensee that active duty military members who live off base must list both their physical address as well as the base address listed on their PCS Orders under item 2 on the ATF Form 4473. IOI(b) (6) also provided the licensee with written guidance on conducting transfers to active duty military members who utilize military i.d cards as the photo identification requirement for ATF Form 4473 completion. **Reference: Worksheet 2 (2012 edition)**

Nature of violation:

I States the licensee failed to record the receipt of PCS orders for active duty military member transferees on ATF Form 4473 item 20(b), alternate documentation.



Licensee's response:

The licensee did not respond to this violation.

Corrective action:

In the future, licensee will ensure the receipt of a fully completed ATF Form 4473 prior to the completion of a background check and transfer of firearms. The licensee

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will document receipt and review of military i.d. and PCS orders of active duty military members.

Licensee's response:

The licensee cited large volume of sales as the reason for incorrect and unrecorded acquisition and disposition entries. However, The licensee seemed surprised that inventory was unaccounted for and apologized for the oversight. The licensee also detailed the circumstances regarding the record of an acquisition that was never acquired. The licensee recorded initial firearms information of a customer inquiring about a possible transfer. However, the customer never went through with the transfer and the licensee failed to remove the entry from the A&D record.

Corrective action:

Through the review of commercial invoices, ATF Forms 4473, and sales receipts, the licensee was able to amend the A&D record to reflect the information necessary to complete the A&D entries. Going forward the licensee will ensure that all acquisitions and dispositions are accurately recorded when acquired and disposed of, as required by the regulations. Additionally, the licensee is advised to complete at least one minimum annual inspection of firearms inventory. The licensee has notified local law enforcement of missing inventory, and complete and filed an ATF Form 3310.11, Theft Loss Report.

The licensee will ensure that all required information is accurately and completely recorded on the ATF Form 4473 prior to the transfer of firearms. **Reference: Report of Violations (ROV) #5**
