Details

JUSTIFICATION: Violations – Warning Letter – No Recall

The recall inspection meets the standard for **Warning Letter** under the current Administrative Action Policy (AAP), ATF O 5370.1C (2/21/2017). The licensee was cited in Violation-2 for failing to obtain complete and accurate information for any items on the F4473, questions 12 – WL at Sec. 6.c.(3). Additional violations do not rise to the level of AA.

The inspection does not meet the standard for Warning Conference, as suggested by Spartan. Repeat Violations-1 and 5 ((478.125(e)) and 478.124(c)(5), respectively) do not meet the standards set forth at AAP at Sec. 6.d.(4)(f) to warrant a second Warning Letter. Although both were cited in 2017, neither the previous violations nor those of the current inspection would justify a Warning Letter, as the number of instances did not, and do not, rise to that standard.

A recall inspection is not warranted. The licensee showed a willingness to achieve compliance by taking steps to add one of his daughters to the license who will assist him in maintaining his records. The licensee is 78 years old and primarily conducts storefront gunsmithing activities in a rural area. He acquires and/or disposes of no more than 10 retail firearms annually. There was no direct threat to public safety and no nexus to prohibited persons. Licensee will be inspected again as part of a 5-year rotation.

Warning Letter

Details

The inspection meets the standard for Warning Conference under the current Administrative Action Policy, ATF O 5370.1C (2/21/2017) at Sec.6.d.(1). Licensee has previously been the subject of a Warning Letter, and this current inspection indicates similar repeat violations.

JUSTIFICATION FOR ALTERNATE: The violations do not appear to have posed a threat to public safety or have negatively affected public safety. The licensee has no trace history, operates in a remote, rural area, and the majority of his business is firearms repairs. He took responsibility for his actions, and was receptive to the corrective action, providing photographs of all corrective action within 24 hours of ROV being issued. Further, licensee is adding his daughter to the license as a Responsible Person, in

order to facilitate ongoing compliance with inventory management and record keeping.

Recommendation is Warning Letter with a recall inspection to be conducted within the next two years.

What is the proposed business activity?

Bill Meyer d/b/a 181 Gun Shop, operates as a sole proprietor in this retail/gunsmith business. Meyer is retired. This business is his sole source of income. No other businesses are operated from the licensed premise. Meyer has held this particular FFL since August 2002, however, he has been an FFL since 1961. He does not hold, nor does he require any additional ATF licenses.

Meyer stated that 181 Gun Shop is a "full service" gun shop, conducting firearms sales of both new (b)(4) and used (b)(4) firearms. He provides full-spectrum gunsmith services to include refinishing, repairs, rebuilds and restorations. Licensee stated that (b)(4) of his business is gunsmith services with the remaining (b)(4) being retail sales of firearms and ammunition. In addition, he facilitates dealer to dealer transfers, Internet transfers and retail sales. Licensee does not have an online presence for this business. He does not maintain any off-site storage. He does not attend gun shows.

In the past 12 months, Meyer has acquired (b)(4) firearms (b)(6) retail (b)(4) repair), and has disposed of (b)(4) firearms (b)(6) retail (b)(4) repair).

PREMISES INFORMATION

Inspection Area Description

On January 29 & 30, 2019, Industry Operations Investigator (IOI) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted a Recall inspection of Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL), Bill Bruce Meyer d/b/a 181 Gun Shop, operating out of rural Downs, Kansas. IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) met with Owner/RP Bill Meyer (KS(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)) at his licensed premises. Meyer owns the storefront property. The inspection included all licensed business activities for the period of 1/29/18, through 1/29/19. Advance notice was given due to the fact that Meyers' licensed premise is several hours away from the KC III Area Office.

Myers operates 181 Gun Shop as a sole proprietor in a full-time retail and gunsmith business operated out of a storefront on the main street of rural, Downs, Kansas.

Additional Comments

The Acquisition & Disposition (A&D) record consists of two sets of hand-written bound books. Gunsmith activities are recorded separately from the retail business. This business does not maintain computerized records. Following last compliance inspection conducted in November 2017, licensee was advised to consolidate the 14 open book records for the retail side into one book record. Licensee's (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted the consolidation of records with minimal discrepancies identified during this recall inspection. Discrepancies from record consolidation were successfully reconciled.

No firearms with obliterated serial numbers or other illegal (unregistered NFA items) firearms were identified. There were no reports of thefts or losses during the past 12 months. No evidence of firearms trafficking was detected.

Licensee claimed sole responsibility for maintaining records for firearms transactions. Licensee does not conduct inventories on a regular basis and inventory management is minimal. IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) advised Meyer and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) that they should institute scheduled gun to book inventories to verify that the serial number entered in the A&D Record matches the serial number on the firearms in inventory.

IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted a 100% review of the (b)(6) ATF F 4473's on file for the inspection period. The forms are filed in a filing cabinet in the shop. Meyer was advised that he should be filing the forms either chronologically by date of transaction or chronologically by form serial number as per the instructions on the form. No sales to law enforcement officers occurred during the inspection period. No trafficking issues pertaining to purchasers were identified.

The FFL Audit Log provided by NICS contained data from the past 60 days Licensee had zero NICS Transaction Numbers (NTN) on the FFL Audit Report. There were 2 historical denied transactions. Licensee is aware that these forms are to be filed separately from transactions where a transfer occurred.

A review of the Violent Crime Analysis Branch FFL Master Query report (VCAB) did not reveal any unreported multiple sales during the inspection period for this licensee. Licensee is aware that if two or more handguns are sold or transferred to the same person within five consecutive business days, he is required to complete and submit ATF Form 3310.4, Report of Multiple Handgun Sales, to the proper authorities.

IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) reviewed the ATF Forms 4473, and the licensee's A&D book for suspicious firearm purchases. The focus was for multiple crime gun purchases, out of character purchases, structured purchases, and potential straw purchases. IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) also reviewed purchases looking for multiple purchasers from the same address, or purchasers from significant distances. No remarkable information was developed, no prohibited persons, straw purchasers, or firearm traffickers were identified.

No trace activity for this licensee.

Ten (10) firearms were queried through NCIC and eTrace with no adverse information discovered.

The licensee does not engage in any activities as a Importer, Collector, NFA dealer or Manufacturer. IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) did advise licensee regarding ATF's definition of gunsmithing vs manufacturing. He indicated he understood the regulations pertaining to activities for gunsmithing, under the Type 01 (Dealer) license, that he is authorized to perform.

No referrals were generated from this inspection.

Licensee is aware that the Youth Handgun Safety Act pamphlet and a secure safety device must be provided with all handgun transfers. Federal Firearms License and Youth Handgun Safety Act poster are displayed as required.

Investigator (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) conducted queries on Bill Bruce Meyer via the NCIC/NLETS. No significant findings. Further, queries regarding Meyer via FLS, NFORCE and e-Trace, were all negative.

IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) thoroughly reviewed Federal Firearms laws and regulations utilizing the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations with licensee and his daughter. IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) advised licensee that he should consider adding his daughter as a Responsible Person to this license since she will be helping him in the shop on a weekly basis with records management and inventory control. Meyer acknowledged his understanding of the regulations by signing the form. He was advised to retain a copy for his records. Licensee was provided with ATF P 5300.15, ATF Licensee Quick Reference and Best Practices Guide; ATF P 3317.2, Safety and Security Information for Federal Firearms Licensees; ATF Form 3310.11, Federal Firearm Licensee Theft/Loss Report; ATF P 5380.1, Loss Prevention for Firearms Retailers; ATF P 5380.2 How to Conduct a Firearms Inventory; and the ATF website address.

Both (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and his daughter, were encouraged to visit the ATF website to utilize such features as FFL Ez-Check, the online learning theatre, and the Distribution Center order form.

IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) answered questions posed by licensee. He was encouraged to contact IOI (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) or the local ATF office in the future should questions arise.

[REDACTED] was also present for the closing conference. Licensee will ensure compliance with all Federal regulations pertaining to firearms transactions. Meyer signed the ROV and was instructed to retain a copy for his records.
